The Pitt volleyball team (22-8, 10-4 Big East) earned the NO. 3 seed in the 2006 Big East Tournament and will travel to Cincinnati, Ohio, this weekend to face sixth-seeded Marquette (15-12, 10-4 Big East) on Friday, Nov. 17, at 10 a.m., at Fifth Third Arena in first round action.

The last time Pitt faced Marquette was on Oct. 20 when the Panthers won a close 3-2 match on the road. Junior **Diana Andreyko (Pittsburgh, Pa./Baldwin)** posted a double-double and led the team with 20 kills and 13 digs. Senior **Azadeh Boroumand (Red Deer, Alberta/Thurber)** chipped in 60 assists and six blocks in the contest while sophomore **Stephanie Ross (Dayton, Ohio/Chaminade-Julienne)** posted a double-double with 10 kills and 21 digs.

The winner of the Pitt-Marquette contest advances to meet the winner of No. 2 Louisville (20-6, 13-1 Big East) and No. 7 Connecticut (19-10, 8-6 Big East) on Saturday at 1 p.m., in the semifinals.
