## at Long Beach State (21-6) vs. Cal Santa Barbara (11-18)

Friday, Nov. 23 • 10 p.m.  
Saturday, Nov. 24 • 8 p.m.

**PITTSBURGH**—Pitt's women's volleyball team closes out its 2007 regular season in the Long Beach Tournament this weekend. The Panthers face Long Beach State at 10 p.m. on Friday, Nov. 23, and Cal Santa Barbara on Saturday, Nov. 24, at 8 p.m.

Pitt (15-14) is coming off a split in their final home matches of the season. In the finale, senior Diana Andreyko (Pittsburgh, Pa./Baldwin) eclipsed the career kills record with her game-winning kill in game two of the Rutgers win. Boasting 1,822 kills to date, she surpassed Ann Marie Lucanie's 1993 record of 1,815.

Long Beach State (21-6) is coming off a shutout, 3-0, win over Cal State Fullerton. The 49ers are led by Alexis Crimes with a 4.6 kill per game average and lead the Panthers, 4-0, in the series.

Coming off a shutout win of its own, Cal Santa Barbara (11-18) is led by Dara Vargas with 1219 assists on the year. The Gauchos hold a 4-0 lead in the series against Pitt.

### LAST TIME OUT

The Panthers split their 2007 home finale with a win over Rutgers on Senior Day. Pitt closed out its home slate with a 10-2 record, including the 9-0 unbeaten streak to open the season.

### HEADED TO THE TOP

The all-time leader in career attempts with 4,864 to date, senior Diana Andreyko also became the record holder for kills with her 17th kill against Rutgers on Nov. 11. She passed Ann Marie Lucanie's (1990-93) 1,815 kills on the record list and now boasts 1,822 to enter the weekend.

Additionally, Andreyko became the fifth Panther in school history to record over 1,000 kills and 1,000 digs in her career, and is the first to accomplish that feat since 2005. She is also sixth on the all-time service aces list (119).

### MOVING UP IN THE BOOKS

Junior Jessica Moses is now fourth on the career block assists list (288) and sixth on the total block assists list (328). If she records eight block assists this weekend, she will move up on both lists, tying the third-best mark in block assists and surpassing the fifth-best mark in total blocks.

### INTENSE DEFENSE

Pitt has shutout eight of its opponents this season, including four conference teams. In addition, the Panthers have held teams to a .205 hitting percentage.

### TOUGH STUFF

Pitt has out-blocked its opponents, 277.5-228. Opponents have only managed to solo block 46 attacks on the year, while the Panthers boast 107 solo blocks.

### HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

Pitt tallied a 9-0 win streak at Fitzgerald Field House this season, which was the best since 1987 when the Panthers went 13-0 at home. During the run Pitt defeated Geroge Mason (3-1), UAB (3-1), Buffalo (3-0), Notre Dame (3-1), DePaul (3-0), Seton Hall (3-0), Villanova (3-2), Robert Morris (3-1) and Marquette (3-2).

### MILESTONE MOMENT

Head Coach Chris Beerman recorded his 250th career win in the wins over Seton Hall and Villanova last weeknd. That victory was also his 150th win with the Panthers, in the short eight years he has been at Pitt. Historically, Pitt ranks 13th with 846 program wins.

### ABOVE ALL OTHERS

Kelly Campbell led the conference in individual match highs, as she recorded 30 kills in the four-game Notre Dame contest. That was the most kills in a match since 2004 when Gini Ullery achieved that mark.

In addition Diana Andreyko and Campbell provided a one-two punch, as they are the top-two on the four-game total attempts list with 67 and 66 against ND.

As a team, Pitt is first in match highs in the league with 84 kills and 78 assists against the Fighting Irish.

### SOMETHING NEW

Junior Jessica Moses was the first Panther to record double digit blocks this season, as she posted her first double-double of the season against Georgetown with 11 kills and 10 blocks.

### SETTING THE TONE

Freshman Emily Burke is currently 10th on the all-time assists list with 966 sets in her first year as a Panther.

### CAREER NIGHT

Sophomores Michelle Rossi and Meagan Dooley both posted career stats in the Marquette match. Rossi tallied a match-high 32 digs in the contest, which ranks as the league's best defensive stand of the season. Dooley, on the otherhand, totaled 23 kills in the same match. Dooley also chipped in a .356 hitting percentage and three blocks.



## ANDREYKO AND DOOLEY EARN ALL-BIG EAST HONORS (NOV. 16)

Milwaukee, Wis. - Pitt senior Diana Andreyko and sophomore Meagan Dooley of the women's volleyball team were honored as they both earned All-Big East accolades at the annual Big East postseason banquet on Thursday night.

Garnering her fourth postseason conference accolade, Andreyko (Pittsburgh, Pa./Baldwin) was named to the 2007 All-Big East first team for the third consecutive year. She recently became the all-time kills record holder at Pitt, currently boasting 1,822 kills in her career. During the season, Andreyko has posted a team-leading 434 kills, 262 digs and 11 double-doubles. She was also Big East Player of the Week (Sept. 10), Pitt News Female Athlete of the Week (Sept. 12) and the Pitt Invitational MVP.

"Diana has earned and deserved every accolade she has received," said Head Coach Chris Beerman. "Her daily consistency, competitive drive and will-to-win is inspiring. She is one of the all-time great Pitt volleyball players."

Dooley (West Chester, Ohio/Lakota West) earned All-Big East second team honors for the second consecutive season. She leads the team in total blocks (120) and ranks fourth on Pitt's all-time solo block list with 65 to date. After being named to the All-Arkansas Invitational team, she was selected to the conference's honor roll during the first weekend of play this season. Dooley boasts a .305 hitting percentage and set a career high with 23 kills in the Marquette contest.

"Meagan played middle hitter for the first time as a collegian this season and was really dominant," commented Beerman. "I look for her to continue to improve and take her game to even higher levels in the years to come."

## PANTHERS VOLLEYBALL NEWS AND NOTES

### CLUTCH COMEBACKS

In their first Big East matchup of the season, Pitt earned a 3-1 victory of rival Notre Dame. The Panthers rallied comebacks in all three of their winning games, including the 42-40 game four win. That win was the fourth victory in five matches for the Panthers.

### SEEING DOUBLE

Five members of the Panthers' squad have earned double-doubles this season. First junior Stephanie Ross recorded one in the season opener against Georgia Tech with 12 kills and 10 digs. Since then both senior Diana Andreyko and junior Kelly Campbell have posted multiple double-doubles amongst themselves. The next double-double contributor was Nicole Taurence who totaled 35 assists and 11 digs in the George Mason match, while junior Jessica Moses added her name with 11 kills and 10 blocks against Georgetown.

### RISING TO THE CHALLENGE

Senior Diana Andreyko was named Big East Volleyball Player of the Week on Sept. 10 after she led the Panthers to their Pitt Invitational Title. During a 4-0 week, Andreyko averaged a .309 hitting percentage and boasting 70 kills. She also recorded two double-doubles against Duquesne (15k, 11d) and George Mason (20k, 11d).

### RISING TO THE CHALLENGE II

Pitt junior Kelly Campbell was named Big East Volleyball Player of the Week after an impressive performance on Sept. 24 following the Panther's 2-0 conference opener. Campbell led the Panthers with 42 kills for a 6.0 kills per game average and tallied a .355 hitting percentage. She also boasted a career- and match-high 30 kills for a .348 hitting clip and a Big East best for a four-game match. During an intense 42-40 game four, she recorded 11 kills in the win.

### ROLL CALL

Sophomore Meagan Dooley was named to the Big East Conference's weekly honor roll on Aug. 28., after competing in the squad's first weekend of competition.

Dooley led the team with 37 kills (tied), a .408 hitting percentage and nine blocks during the Arkansas Clarion Inn Invitational. Against Pepperdine, she recorded 13 kills and posted a .500 hitting clip.

### THE ONE THAT COUNTED

The Panthers reclaimed their Pitt Invitational title this season. With three wins in to days, this was the first time Pitt won its invitational since 1999, and the first time playing in the championship match since 2004.

Juniors Kelly Campbell and Jessica Moses were named to all-tournament teams the first two weeks of the season. In the first tournament of the season, Campbell was selected to the All-Clarion Inn Invitational team, while Moses was an All-Miami Best Wester Invitational member.

### ALL-TOURNAMENT TIME PART TWO

During the Pitt Invitational, senior Diana Andreyko was deemed the MVP, while juniors Kelly Campbell and Jessica Moses were added to the all-invitational team. Pitt won the tournament and had the most representatives on the all-invitational team.

### PITT ON T.V.

Pitt 's thrilling Sept. 22 contest against Notre Dame was selected as an "AVCA Match of the Week" and was televised on a tape delayed basis on Monday, Sept. 24,, as one out of a 25-match slate. The broadcast crew included Jason Knapp handling the play-by-play duties, while Standford standout Canyon Cemon.

### ON TOP OF THE GAME

Pitt was honored as one of the recipients of the GamePlan/American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) Team Academic Award presented by the AVCA for their achievements in the classroom during the 2006-07 school year. The award was presented to 303 high schools and colleges across the nation, including 55 NCAA Division I schools. Teams are required to excel in the classroom and maintain at least a 3.30 cumulative team grade-point average on a 4.0 scale and a 4.10 cumulative team GPA on a 5.0 scale during the school year.

The volleyball team was also honored with Pitt's Athletic Academic Trophy for boasting the highest team GPA of 3.415.
