MEN'S BASKETBALL (12-9, 3-6 BIG EAST)... The Friars posted a 0-2 mark last week. The Friars opened the week with an 81-74 loss in overtime at Notre Dame on January 31. Sophomore Dwain Williams (San Diego, Calif.) led the Friars with 20 points. Junior Geoff McDermott (New Rochelle, N.Y.) scored 10 points, added eight assists and grabbed eight rebounds. On February 2, the Friars were defeated by West Virginia, 77-65, at the Dunkin' Donuts Center. Junior Randall Hanke (New York, N.Y.) scored a team-high 18 points in the loss. The Friars will return to action on Tuesday, February 5 versus DePaul at the Dunkin' Donuts Center.

WOMEN'S BASKETBALL (11-10, 1-7 BIG EAST)... The Providence College women's basketball team posted a 0-2 record last week. Each of the Friars' two losses came at the hands of nationally ranked opponents. On January 30, the Friars were defeated by 20th-ranked Notre Dame, 85-54. Freshman Mi-Khida Hankins (Baltimore, Md.) tallied a team-high 15 points and junior Shantee Darrian (Trenton, N.J.) grabbed a team-high eight rebounds. On February 2, the Friars fell to No. 1/1 Connecticut, 80-54, in Storrs, Conn. Sophomore Brittany Dorsey (Detroit, Mich.) recorded 14 points for PC, while Darrian registered a team-best seven boards. The Friars will return to action on Saturday, February 9 against 12th-ranked West Virginia. The game will be played at Alumni Hall/Mullaney Gymnasium in Providence, R.I.

MEN'S HOCKEY (12-9-3, 9-5-3 HOCKEY EAST)... The 13th-ranked men's hockey team posted a 1-0-1 record last week. On Friday, February 1, the Friars defeated No. 9 Boston College, 3-2, at Kelley Rink in Chestnut Hill, Mass. It marked PC's first win at Kelley Rink since January 24, 2003. Senior Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.) and sophomore Greg Collins (Hingham, Mass.) scored in the first period to give PC a 2-0 lead. The Eagles tied the game at 2-2 in the second period, but senior Matt Taormina (Washington Township, Mich.) scored the game winner with 4:27 remaining in the third period to lift PC to its third consecutive win. In goal, senior Tyler Sims (Fort Wayne, Ind.) made 36 saves. The following night, the Friars played Merrimack to a 1-1 draw in North Andover, Mass. Freshman Kyle MacKinnon (Walnut, Calif.) gave the Friars a 1-0 first period lead, but the Warriors evened the score in the second period. PC finished with a 51-18 shot advantage over the Warriors. The Friars are back in action on Friday, February 8 when they host Vermont at Schneider Arena.

WOMEN'S ICE HOCKEY (12-11-3, 7-4-2 HOCKEY EAST)... The women's ice hockey team posted a 1-1-0 record this past week versus Hockey East foe Boston University. On Thursday, January 31 the Friars beat BU by a score of 4-3. Freshman forward Jean O'Neill led the Friar offense, as she scored a career-high two goals in the win. Kathleen Smith (Waterloo, Ontario) and Katy Beach (Cleveland, Ohio) also scored goals for the Friars. Then on Saturday, February 2 the Friars fell to the Terriers by a score of 3-1. Senior Danielle Tangredi (London, Ontario) scored the lone Friar goal. The Friars return to action next weekend with a two-game series versus Connecticut. The first game will be at UConn's Freitas Ice Forum on February 9 at 1:00 p.m.

MEN'S INDOOR TRACK... The men's indoor track team competed at the Third Annual Giegengack Invitational at Coxe Gage on the campus of Yale University on Friday, February 1 and Saturday, February 2. Junior Charles Dewey (Worcester, Mass.) and senior James Lourenco (West Warwick, R.I.) placed fourth and fifth in the 400m with Dewey running an IC4A qualifying time of 49.15 and Lourenco running a New England qualifying time of 49.86. Senior Chris McDermott (West Haven, Conn.) finished fifth overall in the 800m with a time of 1:53.94. Also in the 800m, junior Nick Berluti (Westwood, Mass.) finished seventh overall with an IC4A qualifying time of 1:54.34. The 4x400m relay team set a new school record, finishing in a time of 3:20.73. Freshman Brian Stannard (East Longmeadow, Mass.) led the relay off with a 51.46 split, handing off to Lourenco who split a 49.55. Dewey ran third for the Friars with a 48.24 split for the 400m and McDermott anchored the relay in a split time of 51.48. The record time beat the previous record by nearly a full second, which was 3:21.63, held since 2007.
