ATHLETES OF THE WEEK

Mark Dillon (Grad., Gaithersburg, Md.)... Dillon led the men's lacrosse team to a 10-5 victory over MAAC foe Mount St. Mary's on April 5 in Providence, R.I. Dillon notched a career-high six point on four goals and two assists. One of his four goals came during a man-up opportunity.

Katie DiCamillo (Jr., Garden City, N.J.)... DiCamillo won the 5000m in a time of 16:43.61 at the UConn Invitational on April 5. The Friar junior crushed the competition, as she was 51 seconds ahead of the second-place finisher and nearly a minute and a half ahead of the third-place finisher. DiCamillo earned 10 points for the Friars in her victory.

MEN'S OUTDOOR TRACK... The Providence College men's track team competed in the Stanford Invitational in Palo Alto, California this past weekend. The men's squad was led by senior Ahmed Haji (West Hartford, Conn.) who placed fifth in the 5000m with a time of 14:01.39. The Friar men's track team will compete next in the Quinnipiac Invitational in Hamden, Conn. on Wednesday, April 9.

WOMEN'S OUTDOOR TRACK... The Providence College women's track team competed in the UConn Invitational on Saturday, April 5. Junior Katie Elliot (Penfield, N.Y.) placed second in the 800m with a time of 2:15.37 and junior Katherine Schock (Norwood, Mass.) finished fifth in a time of 2:17.22. Douglas also won the 1500m with a time of 4:37.25 and sophomore Breffini Twohig (Dublin, Ireland) placed fifth in a time of 4:45.48. Junior Katie DiCamillo (Garden City, N.Y.) and junior Sarah Morgan (Waikato, New Zealand) placed first and second in the 5000m with times of 16:43.61 and 17:24.44, respectively. Freshman Katherine Luegers (Richmond, Vt.) won the 3000m Steeplechase with a time of 11:26.31. Providence finished the meet in fifth place out of eight teams. The Friar women's track team will compete next in the Quinnipiac Invitational in Hamden, Conn. on Wednesday, April 9.

WOMEN'S TENNIS (5-9)... The Providence College women's tennis squad traveled to Storrs, Conn. on Tuesday, April 2 to take on the University of Connecticut Huskies. After dropping to BIG EAST foe Marquette a few days prior, the Friars hoped to turn things around against another conference opponent. Despite improvements, the Huskies prevailed, 7-0. The doubles duo of freshman Avery Gibson (Fairfield, Iowa) and sophomore Dara Hawkins-Hodgson (South Euclid, Ohio) kept things tight in the No. 1 doubles spot, falling 8-7. Senior Kate Lyons (Barrington, R.I.) also made strides but dropped 6-0, 7-6. Next up for the Friars is the University of Hartford. Providence will travel to West Hartford, Conn. on Tuesday, April 8 for the 3:00 p.m. match.

SOFTBALL (15-16-1, 1-5 BIG EAST)... The softball team posted a 0-5 record last week. The Friars began the week with a 7-3 loss at Boston University on Wednesday, April 2. Mary Rose Sheehy (Woodbridge, Conn.) led the Friars with three hits and one RBI, while sophomore Katelyn Revens (Warwick, R.I.) and senior Samantha Pittman (San Diego, Calif.) each had two hits. The Friars were then defeated at Syracuse (6-0, 3-0) in a BIG EAST Conference double header on Saturday, April 5. The following day, the Friars dropped two games at Pittsburgh (3-0, 1-0). Sophomore Danielle Bertolette (Temecula, Calif.) and junior Jennifer Maccio (Huntington Station, N.Y.) combined to allow just two earned runs in the two games. The Friars are back in action on Thursday, April 10 when they host Harvard in a non-conference double header at Raymond Field.

MEN'S LACROSSE (4-5, 4-0 MAAC)... The Providence College men's lacrosse team posted a 1-0 record last week. On April 5, the Friars defeated Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) foe Mount St. Mary's, 10-5, in Providence, R.I. Graduate student Mark Dillon (Gaithersburg, Md.) led Providence with a career-high six points on four goals and two assists. Sophomore Jackson Fallon (Arlington, Mass.) netted four points on three goals and one assist. Graduate student Thomas Wenskus (East Islip, N.Y.) led the way for PC on face-offs with 10 victories in 12 opportunities. Junior goalkeeper Robert Bryan (Apex, N.C.) made five saves and picked up one groundball in the win between the pipes. Providence returns to action on Saturday, April 12 against MAAC opponent St. Joseph's. The game will be played at 1:00 p.m. in Philadelphia, Pa. It marks the first of four-straight road games for PC.
