Danette Doetzel (Jr., Macklin, Sask.)... Doetzel traveled to Walnut, Calif. for the Mt. Sac Relays this past weekend and won the OD 5000m in a time of 16:15.91, which qualified her for the NCAA Regional Championships in Tallahassee, Fla. on May 30 and 31.

MEN'S OUTDOOR TRACK... This past weekend a few members of PC's men's track team traveled to Walnut, Calif. to compete in the Mt. Sac Relays, while the rest of the team was in Storrs, Conn. competing in the UConn Spring Invitational. In California, senior Max Smith (Dunedin, New Zealand) and sophomore Hayden McLaren (Christchurch, New Zealand) each ran well in the 1500m, finishing in fifth and eighth place with times of 3:45.94 and 3:46.39, respectively. Both times qualified for the NCAA Regional Championships. At UConn, junior Charles Dewey (Worcester, Mass.) won the 800m in 1:51.26 and senior James Lourenco (West Warwick, R.I.) placed third in a time of 1:53.25. Sophomores Michael Anderson (Ajax, Ont.) and Tom Webb (Barrington, R.I.) finished first and second in the 5000m with times of 14:51.24 and 15:02.38, respectively. The Friars will compete next in the Penn Relays in Philadelphia, Pa., starting on Thursday, April 24 and continuing until Saturday, April 26. They will also compete in the Brown Springtime Invitational in Providence, R.I. on Sunday, April 27.

WOMEN'S OUTDOOR TRACK... This past weekend a few members of PC's women's track team traveled to Walnut, Calif. to compete in the Mt. Sac Relays, while the rest of the team was in Storrs, Conn. competing in the UConn Spring Invitational. In California, junior Danette Doetzel (Macklin, Sask.) won the OD 5000m with a time of 16:15.91, which qualified her for the NCAA Regional Championships in Tallahassee, Fla. on May 30 and 31. At UConn, junior Katie Elliot (Penfield, N.Y.) finished fourth in the 800m with a time of 2:15.04 and junior Katherine Schock (Norwood, Mass.) placed fifth in a time of 2:16.04. The Friars will compete next in the Penn Relays in Philadelphia, Pa., starting on Thursday, April 24 and continuing until Saturday, April 26. They will also compete in the Brown Springtime Invitational in Providence, R.I. on Sunday, April 27.

WOMEN'S TENNIS (8-9)... The Providence College women's tennis team posted a 1-0 record last week. On Tuesday, April 15, the Friars hosted Holy Cross in Providence, R.I. for their final match of the season. After honoring seniors Kate Danaher (Norwood, Mass.), Erin Kenaga (Norwalk, Conn.), and Kate Lyons (Barrington, R.I.), PC took the courts, defeating the Crusaders, 4-3. Lyons ended her Providence career on a high note, winning in the No. 6 singles position, 6-3, 6-2. Sophomore Jen Cusack (Bayport, N.Y.) and freshman Ayushi Sinha (Mumbai, India) also won in singles, Cusack in the No. 4 spot and Sinha in No. 5. The Friars earned the doubles point by sweeping all three spots. Providence finished their spring season with an 8-9 mark, 9-10 overall.

SOFTBALL (21-19-2, 7-7 BIG EAST)... The softball team posted a 3-2-1 record last week. Providence began the week with a loss (3-2) and a tie (6-6) in a double header at Yale on Wednesday, April 16. The second contest was called because of darkness. The Friars then swept a BIG EAST double header at Rutgers on Saturday, April 19. PC won the first game, 7-1, and rallied in the seventh inning to capture the second contest, 6-3. Sophomore Jenna Garcia (Morro Bay, Calif.) combined for four hits (one home run) and four RBI's in the two games. The Friars had 15 hits in the first game, led by Garcia and freshman Justine Stratton (Fresno, Calif.) who each had three. On Sunday, April 20, the Friars split a pair of games at Villanova. PC won the first contest, 2-0, behind sophomore Danielle Bertolette (Temecula, Calif.) who recorded her seventh shutout of the season and finished with five strikeouts. Junior Mary Rose Sheehy (Woodbridge, Conn.) and sophomore Katelyn Revens (Warwick, R.I.) each drove in one run for PC. The Friars were then defeated, 1-0, in the second contest. The Friars are back in action on Wednesday, April 23 when they travel to the University of Rhode Island for a double header beginning at 3:00 p.m.

MEN'S LACROSSE (5-7, 5-1 MAAC)... The Providence College men's lacrosse team posted an 0-2 record last week. On April 16, the Friars suffered their first Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) loss of the season at Marist, 7-6. Graduate student Bennett Murphy (Princeton, N.J.) led the Friar offense with two goals and one assist. Junior Bobby Labadini (Westford, Mass.) also netted two goals in the losing effort. On April 19, the Friars fell to 14th-ranked Brown, 11-9, in Providence, R.I. Sophomore Colin Tigh (Garden City, N.Y.) exploded for a career-high four goals, while Murphy chipped in two goals for PC. Providence returns to action on Wednesday, April 23 against MAAC foe Wagner. The game will be played at the Friar Field Hockey & Lacrosse Complex in Providence, R.I. Opening face off is scheduled for 7:00 p.m. Prior to the start of the game, the program will honor four graduate students and seven senior members of the team who will be playing in their final home game at Providence.
