FRIARS RETURN TO ACTION... The Friars, who have not played since November 17, will play three games in a span of one week beginning on December 1 with a Hockey East contest against Vermont in Burlington.

SERIES HISTORY VERSUS VERMONT... In 32 all-time meetings between the two teams, the Catamounts lead 17-13-2 including a 9-6-0 mark in Vermont. Last season, Vermont took the season series, 2-1, winning once at UVM and at Providence. In the final regular season meeting between the two teams last season on February 3, the Friars defeated the Catamounts, 4-1, in Burlington. The win ended PC's six-game winless streak (0-5-1) against the Catamounts. PC had not defeated Vermont since December 27, 1997 (5-1 at the Gutterson Fieldhouse).

SCOUTING THE CATAMOUNTS... After starting the season with a 0-4-1 record, Vermont has gone 3-1-1 in its last five games, including a 2-0-1 mark in the last three games. Most recently, the Catamounts played Maine to a 5-5 overtime tie in Orono on Sunday, November 25. Five different players scored for the Catamounts, including Corey Carlson and Peter Lenex who each had one goal and two assists. UVM led, 5-3, after two periods, but Maine scored twice, including the game-tying goal with 59 seconds remaining to force overtime. Lenex leads the team in scoring with 10 points (4 g, 6 a), while Carlson is second with nine points (4 g, 5 a). Joe Fallon has seen a bulk of the work in net, playing in nine games and posting a 3.25 goals against average and a .894 save percentage.

FRIAR QUICK NOTES...

- After starting the season with four consecutive losses, PC has gone 3-2-2 over the last seven games.
- The Friars are coming off a 5-4 overtime loss against No. 6 New Hampshire on November 17 at Schneider Arena, ending PC's season-long three-game unbeaten streak.
- Junior defenseman Matt Taormina (Washington Township, Mich.) and classmate Pierce Norton (South Boston, Mass.) lead the team in scoring with 11 points each. Taormina has five goals and six assists, while Norton has a career-high seven goals and four assists.
- Providence College has gone 6-for-12 (.500) on the power play over the last four games.
- All three of PC's wins this season have come against ranked teams.

LAST TIME OUT... In their last game on November 17, the Friars were defeated, 5-4, in overtime by No. 6 New Hampshire. The Friars trailed 3-1 after two periods, but third period goals by Greg Collins (Hingham, Mass.), Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.) and Pierce Norton (South Boston, Mass.) gave the Friars a 4-3 lead. However, the Wildcats evened the score shortly thereafter and went on to win at the 2:57 mark of overtime as Paul Thompson scored his third goal of the night. Norton finished with two goals for the second consecutive game, while freshman Joe Lavin (Shrewsbury, Mass.) collected his first two collegiate assists. The Friars finished with a 45-38 shot advantage.

POWER SURGE... After not scoring on the power play in their first three games (0-for-10), PC has gone 12-for-33 (.364) on the man advantage over the last eight games, including three goals in the third period at No. 11 Maine on November 9. Overall, the Friars are 12-for-43 (.279) on the power play, which ranks first in Hockey East and second in the nation. Nine different Friars have scored on the power play this season, including junior Pierce Norton (South Boston, Mass.) who has three goals on the man advantage.

NORTON ON FOUR-GAME POINT STREAK... Junior Pierce Norton (South Boston, Mass.), who has scored two goals in each of the last two games, is currently on a four-game point streak in which he has recorded five goals and two assists. He is tied for the team lead in scoring with 11 points (seven goals and four assists). His seven goals is the same amount he had in his first two seasons at Providence College.

FRIARS AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS... The Friars are 3-2 against ranked teams this season. Most recently, the Friars were defeated by No. 6 New Hampshire, 5-4, in overtime on November 17. The Friars posted two wins at No. 11 Maine on November 9-10. On October 26, PC defeated No. 16 UMass, 3-1. The Friars also have played against No. 12/16 St. Lawrence and No. 13/7 Clarkson this season. Last season, the Friars posted a 4-14-1 record against ranked opponents.

FRIARS SCORE WHILE SHORT HANDED... The Friars, who did not score a short-handed goal in their first six contests, have scored three short-handed goals in the last five games. PC is tied for third in the nation with three short-handed tallies and is tied for the Hockey East lead in that category. The Friars tallied two goals while short handed on Thursday, November 1 against Boston University. Junior Matt Taormina (Washington Township, Mich.) is tied for second in the nation with two short-handed goals, while senior Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.) has one short-handed tally.

TAORMINA OFF TO STRONG START... Junior defenseman Matt Taormina (Washington Township, Mich.) is off to a strong start for the Friars. In 11 games, he has 11 points (five goals, six assists). He has tallied nine points (four goals, five assists) in the last six games, including a career-high five points (two goals, three assists) in a 6-2 win at No. 11 Maine on November 9. He is tied for second in the nation with two short-handed goals and among defensemen he is the national leader in that category.

SIMS CLIMBING UP THE PC RECORD BOOKS... Senior goalie Tyler Sims' shutout win at No. 11 Maine on November 10 marked his fifth career shutout, tying a PC record, which was set by Mario Proulx (1980-84). In addition, Sims also shares the record of most shutouts in one season, which he tied during the 2005-06 season. He also ranks seventh all-time with 2,244 career saves and sixth all-time with 92 games played.

MONARCHS REIGN... This season's Friar squad features seven athletes, including four freshmen, who played junior hockey for the New Hampshire Monarchs. Seniors Marc Bastarache (Lynn, Mass.), Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.), sophomore Ryan Simpson (Bow, N.H.) as well as freshmen Eric Baier (North Kingstown, R.I.), Matt Germain (Rockland, Mass.), Austin Mayer (Providence, R.I.) and Ian O'Connor (Londonderry, N.H.) all played for the Monarchs. O'Connor, Mayer and Germain have played together on the fourth line in the first four games this season and have seen significant ice time, while Baier has played on the third defensive pair.

HEAD COACH TIM ARMY... Tim Army is in his third season with the Friars. Army returned to his alma mater to take over the reigns of the PC hockey program on June 17, 2005 after spending three seasons with the Portland Pirates of the AHL. A 1985 graduate of the College and an East Providence native, Army became the 11th coach in the history of the program. He is the first PC alumnus to coach the team since his former coach Lou Lamoriello guided the Friars (1968-83). He also is the first former Hockey East player to be a head coach in the league. In his first season, Army led the team to a 17-16-3 overall record, including a 14-10-3 mark in Hockey East action. The 17 wins were the most by a Friar squad since 2002-03. In addition, the Friars, who were picked to finish eighth in the preseason coaches poll, recorded 14 conference victories and finished fifth in the league. The 14 Hockey East wins were one shy of tying a school record. Prior to coaching at Portland, Army spent nine seasons as an assistant coach in the NHL for two different teams. He worked for four seasons as an assistant for Friar great Ron Wilson with the Anaheim Mighty Ducks (1993-97) and five years under Wilson with the Washington Capitals (1997-02). While in Anaheim, Army was part of the 1996-97 team that earned the franchise's first ever playoff berth and advanced to the second round, where the Mighty Ducks fell to the eventual Stanley Cup Champion Detroit Red Wings. Army helped lead the squad to the 1998 Stanley Cup Finals, the team's only appearance in the finals.

NHL TIES... Three members of this season's PC squad have relatives who played or coached in the NHL. Trevor Ludwig's father, Craig, played in the NHL for 15 years and finished his career with the Dallas Stars in 1999 ... Tyler Sims' father, Al, played in the NHL for 10 seasons and is the former Head Coach of the San Jose Sharks ... Kyle Laughlin's father, Craig, played in the NHL for nine years, including six seasons with the Washington Capitals.

FRIARS DRAFTED BY THE NHL... This season's Providence College team features six players who were selected in the NHL Entry Draft. Senior defenseman Trevor Ludwig (Grapevine, Texas) was a 2004 sixth-round selection, 183rd overall by the Dallas Stars. Junior Pierce Norton (South Boston, Mass.) was a 2004 ninth-round pick, 285th overall by the Toronto Maple Leafs. Sophomore Mark Fayne (Bourne, Mass.) was chosen in the fifth round, 155th overall by the New Jersey Devils in the 2005 draft. In 2006, PC had two players selected in the fifth round. Junior Cody Wild (North Providence, R.I.) was the 140th overall selection, while senior Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.) was the 145th pick. Freshman Joe Lavin (Shewsbury, Mass.) was selected in the fifth round (126th overall) in the 2007 Draft.

OCEAN STATE CONNECTION... The 2007-08 men's hockey team has a strong contingent of Rhode Islanders. In addition to six players, Head Coach Tim Army (East Providence) and Assistant Coach David Berard (Coventry) also hail from the Ocean State. The Rhode Islanders on this season's team are: junior Cody Wild (North Providence), sophomores David Cavanagh, John Cavanagh (Warwick), and Matt Tommasiello (Cranston) as well as freshmen Eric Baier (North Kingstown) and Austin Mayer (Providence).
