TONIGHT'S GAME... Providence College will look to clinch a playoff spot when it hosts Merrimack on Friday, March 2 at Schneider Arena. The two teams will complete the home-and-home series on Saturday, March 3 in North Andover, Mass. The Friars currently hold the eighth and final playoff spot, two points ahead of ninth-place UMass Lowell. PC needs one win or a UMass Lowell loss in order to clinch a playoff spot.

SCOUTING MERRIMACK... The Warriors are coming off a 5-1 loss at 11th-ranked Maine on Saturday, February 24. Merrimack is looking to end a 14-game winless streak. The Warriors are led in scoring by a pair of freshmen. Pat Kimball is tops on the team with 11 points (five goals, six assists), while J.C. Robitaille is second with nine points (three goals, six assists). In goal, senior Jim Healey has posted a 2.79 goals against average and a .906 save percentage.

SERIES HISTORY VERSUS MERRIMACK... In 97 meetings between the two teams, the Friars lead 70-22-5, including a 38-12-2 mark in Providence. In the first meeting between the two teams this season on October 27, the Warriors rallied from a 2-0 deficit to defeat the Friars, 3-2, at Schneider Arena. Last season, the Friars posted a 2-1 record versus the Warriors.

FRIAR QUICK NOTES...

- In PC's 7-1 win over No. 3 UNH on Feb. 24, the Friars recorded season highs in goals scored (7), shots (51) and power-play goals (3).
- Junior Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.) was named Hockey East Player of the Week on Feb. 26, marking the first such honor in his career.
- Senior Colin McDonald (Wethersfield, Conn.) recorded his 12th goal this season on Feb. 24, which marked a career high.
- PC has outshot its opponents in 26 of the 32 games this season. The Friars recorded a season-high 51 shots against New Hampshire on Feb. 24.
- PC is 2-0-3 in overtime games this season.
- Providence College has scored the first goal of the game 12 times. PC is 6-4-2 when scoring first and 2-17-1 when it is scored upon first.
- After not scoring in the first 17 games this season, sophomore defenseman Cody Wild (North Providence, R.I.) has five goals in the last 11 games.
- The Friars earned their first road win on Jan. 13 at UMass Lowell. PC is 2-10-2 away from Schneider Arena this season.
- Rheault leads the team in scoring with 22 points (11 goals, 11 assists), while sophomore Nick Mazzolini (Anchorage, Alaska) is second with 18 points (five goals, 13 assists).
- Freshman John Cavanagh (Warwick, R.I.) returned to the Friar lineup on Feb. 23 after missing the previous 12 contests because of an injury. Cavanagh recorded an assist in his return.
- After not scoring a power-play goal in 14 consecutive games (0-62), the Friars have scored four power-play tallies in the last two games (4-11).

LAST TIME OUT... The Friars defeated No. 3 New Hampshire, 7-1, on February 24 at Schneider Arena. Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.) scored twice and Colin McDonald (Wethersfield, Conn.) added another first period goal as the Friars led 3-0 after one period. Chase Watson (Media, Pa.) and Matt Taormina (Washington Township, Mich.) each scored power-play goals early in the second period to increase the lead to 5-0. After the Wildcats cut the lead to 5-1, Mark Fayne (Sagamore Beach, Mass.) scored as the Friars regained their five-goal cushion. Nick Mazzolini (Anchorage, Alaska) completed the scoring for PC in the third period. In goal, Chris Mannix (Hubbardston, Mass.), who was making his first collegiate start, stopped 21 shots to earn his first career victory. The Friars finished with a season-high 51 shots and seven goals. The last time PC scored seven goals was on December 21, 2005. PC also scored a season-high three power-play goals. Rheault finished with a career-high five points (two goals, three assists).

FRIARS SET MARK VERSUS UNH... PC set a number of marks in the win over UNH on February 24. The seven goals were the most against the Wildcats since they scored seven on November 14, 2003. In addition, the seven goals were the most by a Friar team since December 21, 2005. Junior Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.) tallied a career-high five points (two goals, three assists), while senior Colin McDonald (Wethersfield, Conn.) scored his career-high 12th goal of the season. In goal, sophomore Chris Mannix (Hubbardston, Mass.), who was making his first collegiate start, stopped a career-high 21 shots to earn his first win.

SHOT ADVANTAGE... Through 32 games this season, the Friars have outshot their opponents in 26 of those contests. In all, PC is averaging 35.1 shots per game, while opponents are averaging 26.1. In 25 Hockey East games, the Friars are averaging 36.1 shots, while opponents are averaging 26.0 shots per contest. Over the last six games, the Friars are averaging 43.7 shots per game.

SHORT-HANDED RHEAULT... Friar junior Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.) leads the team with a career-high three short-handed goals. All three of his short-handed goals have been game winners. Rheault is second in Hockey East with three short-handed goals and is ranked tied for eighth nationally. In his first two seasons, Rheault tallied two short-handed goals.

SECOND PERIOD SUCCESS... Of the 67 goals scored by the Friars this season, 30 have come in the second period. The Friars scored three times in the second period against New Hampshire on February 23-24 and Boston College on October 31. Conversely, PC has allowed 33 opponents' goals in the first period and are being outscored, 33-16, in the opening 20 minutes. However, the Friars have outscored their opponents, 2-0, in overtime.

SIMS CLIMBS INTO TOP 10 IN TWO CATEGORIES... Junior goalie Tyler Sims (Grand Blanc, Mich.) has climbed into the top-10 at Providence College in a pair of categories. Sims is ninth all-time at PC with 2,007 career saves and is eighth all-time with 82 career games played. This season, Sims has played in 29 games and has 633 saves. He has posted a 2.79 goals against average and a .897 save percentage. Sims has started the last 21 of the last 22 games for the Friars.

STREAK CONTINUES FOR ZANCANARO... Friar senior captain Tony Zancanaro (Trenton, Mich.) has played in all 142 games in his career at Providence College. He is currently tied for 15th all-time at PC in career games played. Current Friar Head Coach Tim Army holds PC's all-time record for games played with 151.

FRIARS AGAINST RANKED TEAMS... The Friars are 4-12-1 against ranked teams this season. PC was defeated 6-1 by No. 17 Clarkson in the regular season opener on October 13 at Schneider Arena. On October 31, the Friars upset No. 3 Boston College, 5-3, at Schneider Arena, marking the team's first win over a ranked opponent since beating No. 14 New

Hampshire on February 25, 2006. The Friars also defeated fourth-ranked Maine, 3-0, on January 19 and 14th-ranked Vermont on February 3. Most recently, the Friars defeated No. 3 UNH, 7-1, on February 24.

HEAD COACH TIM ARMY... Tim Army is in his second season with the Friars. Army returned to his alma mater to take over the reigns of the PC hockey program on June 17, 2005 after spending three seasons with the Portland Pirates of the AHL. A 1985 graduate of the College and an East Providence native, Army became the 11th coach in the history of the program. He is the first PC alumnus to coach the team since his former coach Lou Lamoriello guided the Friars (1968-83). He also is the first former Hockey East player to be a head coach in the league. In his first season, Army led the team to a 17-16-3 overall record, including a 14-10-3 mark in Hockey East action. The 17 wins were the most by a Friar squad since 2002-03. In addition, the Friars, who were picked to finish eighth in the pre-season coaches poll, recorded 14 conference victories and finished fifth in the league. The 14 Hockey East wins were one shy of tying a school record. Prior to coaching at Portland, Army spent nine seasons as an assistant coach in the NHL for two different teams. He worked for four seasons as an assistant for Friar great Ron Wilson with the Anaheim Mighty Ducks (1993-97) and five years under Wilson with the Washington Capitals (1997-02). While in Anaheim, Army was part of the 1996-97 team that earned the franchise's first ever playoff berth and advanced to the second round, where the Mighty Ducks fell to the eventual Stanley Cup Champion Detroit Red Wings. Army helped lead the squad to the 1998 Stanley Cup Finals, the team's only appearance in the finals.

NHL TIES... Five members of this season's PC squad have relatives who played or coached in the NHL. Colin McDonald's father, Gerry, played in the NHL for the Hartford Whalers from 1980-1984 ... Chase Watson's father, Jim, played in the NHL for 10 years with the Philadelphia Flyers ... Trevor Ludwig's father, Craig, also played in the NHL for 15 years and finished his career with the Dallas Stars in 1999 ... Tyler Sims' father, Al, played in the NHL for 10 seasons and is the former Head Coach of the San Jose Sharks ... Kyle Laughlin's father, Craig, played in the NHL for nine years, including six seasons with the Washington Capitals.

FRIARS DRAFTED BY THE NHL... This season's Providence team features six players who were selected in the NHL Entry Draft. Senior Colin McDonald (Wethersfield, Conn.) was drafted in the second round, 51st overall by the Edmonton Oilers in 2003. Junior defenseman Trevor Ludwig (Grapevine, Texas) was a 2004 sixth-round selection, 183rd overall by the Dallas Stars. Sophomore Pierce Norton (South Boston, Mass.) was a 2004 ninth-round pick, 285th overall by the Toronto Maple Leafs. Freshman Mark Fayne (Sagamore Beach, Mass.) was chosen in the fifth round, 155th overall by the New Jersey Devils in the 2005 draft. This past summer, PC had two players selected in the fifth round. Sophomore Cody Wild (North Providence, R.I.) was the 140th overall selection, while junior Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.) was the 145th pick.

PC ANNOUNCES SIGNING OF SIX STUDENT-ATHLETES... Head Coach Tim Army announced on January 12 that student athletes Kyle Mackinnon (Walnut, Calif.), Jordan Kremyr (Cloverdale, B.C.), Austin Mayer (Providence, R.I.), Eric Baier (North Kingstown, R.I.) and Joe Lavin (Shrewsbury, Mass.) each have signed a National Letter of Intent to attend PC beginning in September 2007. Ian O'Connor (Londonderry, N.H.) also has committed to attend PC. Mackinnon is a 6-foot, 185-pound center, who plays for the Langley Chiefs of the British Columbia Hockey League; Kremyr, a 6-foot, 185-pound left wing, is in his fourth season in the BCHL and his third with the Alberni Valley Bulldogs; Mayer is a 6-foot, 190-pound left wing who currently plays for the New Hampshire Junior Monarchs of the EJHL; Baier is a 6-foot-2 inch, 195 pound defenseman, who also plays for the Monarchs; Lavin is a the 6-foot-1 inch defenseman who plays for the U.S. National Under-18 Team; O'Connor is a 6-foot, 190-pound left wing and also plays for the Monarchs.
