TONIGHT'S GAME... Providence College and the University of New Hampshire will face each other for the first time this season on Saturday, January 27 at the Whittemore Center. The last time the two teams met was on March 10, 2006 in the second game of a best-of-three Hockey East Quarterfinal series in Durham, N.H. UNH ousted PC, 2-1, in double overtime (94:18) as Friar goalie Tyler Sims recorded a career-high 59 saves.

SCOUTING UNH... The second-ranked Wildcats had their five-game winning streak snapped as UMass handed UNH a 3-0 loss in Amherst. The night before, the Wildcats defeated the Minutemen, 5-1, in Durham. Trevor Smith leads the team in scoring with 32 points (15 goals, 17 assists), while Matt Fornataro is second with 29 points (10 goals, 19 assists). In goal, Kevin Regan has played in 20 games and has a 16-3-1 record, a 2.08 goals against average and a .931 save percentage.

SERIES HISTORY VERSUS UNH... In 126 meetings between Providence College and New Hampshire, the Wildcats hold a 65-49-12 lead, including a 42-19-4 mark at UNH. Last season, the Wildcats captured the season series with a 3-1-1 record, including a 2-0 mark in the Hockey East Quarterfinals. UNH eliminated the Friars from the Hockey East playoffs with a 2-1 double overtime win at the Whittemore Center in the second game of a best-of-three series.

FRIAR QUICK NOTES...

- Junior goalie Tyler Sims (Grand Blanc, Mich.) was named Hockey East Co-Defensive Player of the Week on January 22. It marked the third time in his career that he has earned the honor.
- Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.) matched a career-high three points (two goals, one assist) in the win over No. 4 Maine on January 19. It marked the fourth time in his career that Rheault has posted three points in a game.
- PC's 3-0 win over No. 4 Maine on January 19 marked its first shutout victory since January 20, 2006 when the Friars posted a 4-0 win at Maine.
- The Friars are 6-0-1 when leading after two periods.
- PC has outshot its opponents in 19 of the 23 games this season. The Friars recorded a season-high 46 shots against Northeastern on Nov. 14.

• The Friars rank second in Hockey East and fifth in the nation on the penalty kill (88.7%). The Friars have killed off 15 consecutive opponent power-play opportunities.

• The Friars earned their first road win on Jan. 13 at UMass Lowell.

• PC is 2-0-1 in overtime games this season.

• Providence College has scored the first goal of the game six times. PC is 4-1-1 when scoring first and 2-15-0 when it is scored upon first.

• Junior Jon Rheault leads the team in scoring with 12 points (six goals, six assists), while sophomore Nick Mazzolini (Anchorage, Alaska) is second with 11 points (three goals, eight assists).

• Jon Rheault has a career-high three short-handed goals this season and all three have proved to be game winners.

LAST TIME OUT... PC outshot fourth-ranked Maine , 40-30, but it was Maine who emerged with a 2-0 victory over the Friars on Saturday, January 20. Maine goalie Ben Bishop stopped all 40 shots he faced to earn his second shutout win over the Friars this season. Maine scored in a 1:48 span in latter stages of the second period to account for the scoring. The Friars peppered Bishop with 16 shots in the third period, but could not score. Sims also was strong in net for the Friars, stopping 28 shots.

SHORT-HANDED RHEAULT... Friar junior Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.) leads the team with a career-high three short-handed goals. All three of his short-handed goals have been game winners. Rheault also leads Hockey East with three short-handed goals and is ranked tied for second nationally. In his first two seasons, Rheault totalled two short-handed goals.

SIMS NOTCHES FOURTH CAREER SHUTOUT... Junior Tyler Sims' (Grand Blanc, Mich.) shutout versus Maine on January 19 marked his fourth career shutout and the second against Maine. Last season on January 20, Sims made history when he became the first Friar netminder to ever post a shutout at Maine. Sims is one shutout away from tying a school mark for most career shutouts (five by Mario Proulx from 1980-84). In 2005-06, Sims tied a PC record with three shutouts in one season.

SECOND PERIOD SUCCESS... Of the 42 goals scored by the Friars this season, 21 have come in the second period. The Friars scored three times in the second period against No. 3 Boston College on October 31 and scored twice in the second period versus Northeastern on November 14. Conversely, PC has allowed 24 opponents' goals in the first period and are being outscored, 24-7, in the opening 20 minutes. However, the Friars have outscored their opponents, 2-0, in overtime.

PENALTY KILLERS... The PC penalty kill has been one of the strong points on the team this season. The Friars have thwarted 54 of the last 58 opponent power play opportunities, including the last 15. Prior to the third period at Maine on December 1, PC had killed off 31 consecutive penalties. Overall the Friars have killed off 102 of 115 power-play chances (.887), which ranks fifth in the nation. In addition, the Friars have four short-handed goals, and three of them have been scored by junior Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.).

SHOT ADVANTAGE... Through 23 games this season, the Friars have outshot their opponents in 19 of those contests. In all, PC is averaging 34.0 shots per game, while opponents are averaging 26.4. In 16 Hockey East games, the Friars are averaging 35.2 shots, while opponents are averaging 26.1 shots per contest.

SIMS CLIMBS INTO TOP 10 IN TWO CATEGORIES... Junior goalie Tyler Sims (Grand Blanc, Mich.) has climbed into the top 10 at Providence College in a pair of categories. Sims is ninth all-time at PC with 1,840 career saves and tied for eighth all-time with 74 career games played. This season, Sims has played in 21 games and has 466 saves. He has posted a 2.66 goals against average and a .901 save percentage. Sims has started the last 13 games for the Friars.

STREAK CONTINUES FOR ZANCANARO... Friar senior captain Tony Zancanaro (Trenton, Mich.) has played in all 133 games in his career at Providence College. He is on pace to finish his career in the top-10 in games played at PC. Current Friar Head Coach Tim Army holds PC's all-time record for games played with 151.

FRIARS AGAINST RANKED TEAMS... The Friars are 2-8-0 against ranked teams this season. PC was defeated 6-1 by No. 17 Clarkson in the regular season opener on October 13 at Schneider Arena. On October 31, the Friars upset No. 3 Boston College, 5-3, at Schneider Arena, marking the team's first win over a ranked opponent since beating No. 14 New Hampshire on February 25, 2006. Most recently, the Friars split two games against fourth-ranked Maine, winning 3-0 on January 19 and falling 4-0 on January 20.

HEAD COACH TIM ARMY... Tim Army is in his second season with the Friars. Army returned to his alma mater to take over the reigns of the PC hockey program on June 17, 2005 after spending three seasons with the Portland Pirates of the AHL. A 1985 graduate of the College and an East Providence native, Army became the 11th coach in the history of the program. He is the first PC alumnus to coach the team since his former coach Lou Lamoriello guided the Friars (1968-83). He also is the first former Hockey East player to be a head coach in the league. In his first season, Army led the team to a 17-16-3 overall record, including a 14-10-3 mark in Hockey East action. The 17 wins were the most by a Friar squad since 2002-03. In addition, the Friars, who were picked to finish eighth in the preseason coaches poll, recorded 14 conference victories and finished fifth in the league. The 14 Hockey East wins was one shy of tying a school record. Prior to coaching at Portland, Army spent nine seasons as an assistant coach in the NHL for two different teams. He worked for four seasons as an assistant for Friar great Ron Wilson with the Anaheim Mighty Ducks (1993-97) and five years under Wilson with the Washington Capitals (1997-02). While in Anaheim, Army was part of the 1996-97 team that earned the franchise's first ever playoff berth and advanced to the second round, where the Mighty Ducks fell to the eventual Stanley Cup Champion Detroit Red Wings. Army helped lead the squad to the 1998 Stanley Cup Finals, the team's only appearance in the finals.

NHL TIES... Five members of this season's PC squad have relatives who played or coached in the NHL. Colin McDonald's father, Gerry, played in the NHL for the Hartford Whalers from 1980-1984 ... Chase Watson's father, Jim, played in the NHL for 10 years with the Philadelphia Flyers ... Trevor Ludwig's father, Craig, also played in the NHL for 15 years and finished his career with the Dallas Stars in 1999 ... Tyler Sims' father, Al, played in the NHL for 10 seasons and is the former Head Coach of the San Jose Sharks ... Kyle Laughlin's father, Craig, played in the NHL for nine years, including six seasons with the Washington Capitals.

FRIARS DRAFTED BY THE NHL... This season's Providence team features six players who were selected in the NHL Entry Draft. Senior Colin McDonald (Wethersfield, Conn.) was drafted in the second round, 51st overall by the Edmonton Oilers in 2003. Junior defenseman Trevor Ludwig (Grapevine, Texas) was a 2004 sixth-round selection, 183rd overall by the Dallas Stars. Sophomore Pierce Norton (South Boston, Mass.) was a 2004 ninth-round pick, 285th overall by the Toronto Maple Leafs. Freshman Mark Fayne (Sagamore Beach, Mass.) was chosen in the fifth round, 155th overall by the New Jersey Devils in the 2005 draft. This past summer, PC had two players selected in the fifth round. Sophomore Cody Wild (North Providence, R.I.) was the 140th overall selection, while junior Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.) was the 145th pick.
