FRIARS FACE BOSTON UNIVERSITY... The Friars will close out the regular season with a pivotal home-and-home series against Boston University beginning on Thursday, March 6 at Schneider Arena. The two teams will square off again Friday night at Agganis Arena in Boston.

SERIES HISTORY VERSUS BOSTON UNIVERSITY... In 152 all-time meetings between the two teams, the Terriers lead, 92-48-12, including a 39-27-6 mark in Providence. Last season, BU won all three games against PC, including a triumph at Schneider Arena. BU also posted a 5-2 win over the Friars on November 1 at Schneider Arena in the first meeting this season.. The Friars' last win over the Terriers was on January 6, 2006 at Agganis Arena.

FRIAR QUICK NOTES...

- The Friars are 14-9-5 over the last 28 games after starting the season with four consecutive losses.
- The Friars are seeking to match their highest ever finish in Hockey East since the 2000-01 season when they finished in a tie for second place.
- PC's two wins at BC's Kelley Rink this season marks the first time since the 1995-96 campaign that they have accomplished the feat. In addition, the Friars captured their first regular season series against the Eagles since the 2001-02 season.
- In Friday night's game against BC, PC junior Jon Mori (Westport, Conn.) had a penalty shot that was saved by BC's John Muse. It marked the Friars' first penalty shot since December 21, 1991.
- The Friars are ranked No. 15 in the *USA Today*/USA Hockey Magazine Poll and No. 17 in the USCHO.com/CSTV Poll, which were released on March 3. It marks the sixth week that PC has been ranked in either poll.
- Jon Rheault leads the team in scoring with 29 points on a career-high 17 goals and 12 assists, while junior Matt Taormina (8 g, 17 a) is second with 25 points.
- Rheault has scored both overtime goals for the Friars this season and is tied for the team lead with three game-winning goals.
- Senior goalie Tyler Sims (Fort Wayne, Ind.) played in his 110th career game in goal for PC on February 22 and set a school record. He has now played in 113 career games. Dan Dennis (109 games from 1993-97) held the previous record.
- Providence College has gone 25-for-140 (.179) on the power play this season, which ranks fourth in Hockey East and 19th nationally. The 25 goals are nine more than last season's total on the man advantage.
- The Friars are tied for third in the nation with nine short-handed goals.
- Junior defensemen Cody Wild (North Providence, R.I.) and Matt Taormina (Washington Township, Mich.) rank fifth and sixth in the nation, respectively in points per game among defensemen. Wild (4 g, 18 a - 22 pts.) is averaging 0.79 points, while Taormina (8 g, 17 a - 25 pts.) is averaging 0.78 points per game.
- Junior Pierce Norton (South Boston, Mass.) has scored a career-high 14 goals this season, which is double the amount of goals he scored in his first two seasons at Providence College.

SCOUTING BOSTON UNIVERSITY... The Terriers had their seven-game winning streak snapped on March 1 as they were defeated by UMass. BU posted a 28-15 shot advantage but Brand Yip was the lone goal scorer as he recorded his 11th goal of the season to even the score with 15 seconds left in the opening period. The previous night, the Terriers posted a 3-0 over the Minutemen as Nick Bonino had two goals and one assist. Peter MacArthur leads the team in scoring with 37 points (14 g, 23 a), while Bryan Ewing is second with 36 points (17 g, 19 a). In goal, Brett Bennett has played in 26 games and has posted a 2.79 goals against average and a .881 save percentage.

RECAP OF LAST WEEKEND VERSUS BOSTON COLLEGE... PC posted a 1-0-1 record against No. 8 Boston College last weekend as the Friars climbed into a fourth-place tie with BC in the Hockey East standings. On Friday, February 29, the Friars defeated the Eagles, 3-2, at Kelley Rink in Chestnut Hill, Mass. Freshman Jordan Kremyr (Cloverdale, B.C.) scored a career-high two goals to give PC a 2-0 lead, while classmate Ian O'Connor (Londonderry, N.H.) scored the game-winning goal in the second period to lift the Friars to their second win at Kelley Rink this season. In goal, senior Tyler Sims (Fort Wayne, Ind.) made 35 saves. The following night, the two teams skated to a 2-2 overtime tie. Sophomore Mark Fayne (Bourne, Mass.) and junior Nick Mazzolini (Anchorage, Alaska) each scored for the Friars, while Sims stopped 29 shots.

WORKING OVERTIME... The Friars have played in 10 overtime games this season and have posted a 2-3-5 record. The 10 overtime games, matches a school record that was set by the 1984-85 squad which posted a 4-1-5 mark and went on to capture the first Hockey East Tournament title.

FRIARS AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS... The Friars are 10-6-2 against ranked teams this season. Most recently, PC defeated No. 8/8 Boston College, 3-2, on February 29 and tied the Eagles, 2-2, on March 1. In addition, PC also defeated No. 9 Boston College, 3-2, on February 1. Other wins over ranked teams were against No. 11 Northeastern (5-1 on 1/25; 5-2 on 1/26), No. 9/10 UMass (3-2 on 1/18), No. 13 UMass Lowell (4-3 on 1/11), No. 5 Michigan State (5-3 on 12/29), No. 11 Maine (6-2 on 11/9; 1-0 on 11/10) and No. 16 UMass (3-1 on 10/26). PC's losses to ranked opponents came against No. 13 UMass Lowell (3-2 on 1/12), No. 1/2 Michigan (6-0 on 12/28), No. 6 New Hampshire (5-4 on 11/17), No. 13 Clarkson (4-1 on 10/13) and No. 12 St. Lawrence (4-1 on 10/12). PC has gone 5-1-2 in the last seven games against ranked teams. Last season, the Friars posted a 4-14-1 record against ranked opponents.

SEVEN FRIARS REACH CAREER HIGH IN POINTS... Seven Friars have reached a career high in points this season, led by juniors Matt Taormina and Pierce Norton who have 25 and 24 points, respectively. In addition, Jon Rheault has a career high 17 goals.

SIMS INCHING CLOSER TO ANOTHER RECORD... Senior goalie Tyler Sims has set two school records this season and is closing in on another mark. On December 1, he posted his sixth career shutout (4-0 win at Vermont) which set a PC record for most career shutouts. He currently has seven shutouts after blanking Brown on December 4. His three shutouts this season also ties a school record for most in one season (set by Mario Proulx 1981-82, Nolan Schaefer 2000-01 and Sims in 2005-06). On February 22, he set another school mark by playing in his 110th game, surpassing Dan Dennis (1993-97) who played in 109 contests. He has now played in 113 games. Most recently, Sims surpassed former Friar Chris Terreri for fifth on the all-time list with 2,762 career saves. He needs 86 more saves to tie Nolan Schaefer atop the list. Schaefer recorded 2,848 stops from 1999-03.

FRIARS TAKING THEIR SHOTS... The Friars have outshot their opponents in 25 of the 32 games, including four contests with 50 shots or more. PC leads Hockey East in shots on goal, averaging 38.2 per game. Most recently, PC had 53 shots in a 1-1 tie against No. 4 New Hampshire on February 15. The Friars are 12-10-3 when outshooting their opponents.

FRIARS THRIVING WHILE SHORT HANDED... The Friars, who did not score a short-handed goal in their first six contests, have scored nine short-handed goals in the last 26 games. PC is tied for third in the nation with nine short-handed tallies this season. The Friars tallied two goals while short handed on November 1 against Boston University. Jon Rheault, Matt Taormina, and Nick Mazzolini are tied for 14th in the nation with two short-handed goals, while five others each have one. The Friars are ranked second in Hockey East and 12th nationally on the penalty kill (.867).

RHEAULT REACHES MILESTONE... PC senior co-captain Jon Rheault recorded his 99th, 100th and 101st career points on February 9 against Vermont. His assist in the second period was his 100th career point as he became the 48th Friar to reach the 100-point mark. Rheault, who leads the team in scoring with 29 points, currently has 103 points (56 g, 47 a), which ranks him tied for 44th all-time at Providence College. Jon DiSalvatore (1999-03) was the last Friar to reach the century mark when he accomplished the feat on October 12, 2002.

TAORMINA ENJOYING STRONG SEASON... Defenseman Matt Taormina has enjoyed a strong season thus far for the Friars. He is second on the team with a career-high 25 points (eight goals, 17 assists) after recording 18 points (six goals, 12 assists) in his first two seasons at PC. He tallied a career-high five points (two goals, three assists) in a 6-2 win at No. 11 Maine on November 9. He is tied for 14th in the nation with two short-handed goals and among defensemen he is the national leader in that category. In addition, he is sixth in the nation among defensemen with 0.78 points per game average and leads all defenders with eight goals. His 25 points marks the highest by a PC defenseman since All-American Stephen Wood '04 had 29 points (11 goals, 18 assists) during the 2003-04 season.

THREE FRIARS NAMED AS SEMIFINALISTS FOR WALTER BROWN AWARD... It was announced on February 4, that PC seniors Jon Rheault and Tyler Sims as well as junior Matt Taormina were named as three of the 15 semifinalists for the 56th Walter Brown Award, presented annually to the best American-born college hockey player in New England. PC led the way with three nominees, while Boston College, Boston University and New Hampshire each have two. Four PC players have earned the Walter Brown Award, with the last being Mike Omicioli, who shared the honor with BC's Mike Mottau in 1999. Prior to Mike Omicioli, Rob Gaudreau won the award in 1992. In addition, Friar Head Coach Tim Army won the award in 1985 and Ron Wilson, Head Coach of the NHL's San Jose Sharks, was the first Friar to win the award when he was honored in 1975.

SIMPSON RETURNS TO FRIAR LINEUP... Sophomore goalie Ryan Simpson (Bow, N.H.) who had not dressed for a game since November 10, 2006, returned to the Friar line up as the back-up on February 8 against Vermont. Simpson battled multiple injuries and is now healthy to play. In his freshman season, he played in four games, before sustaining an injury.

HEAD COACH TIM ARMY... Tim Army is in his third season with the Friars. Army returned to his alma mater to take over the reigns of the PC hockey program on June 17, 2005 after spending three seasons with the Portland Pirates of the AHL. A 1985 graduate of the College and an East Providence native, Army became the 11th coach in the history of the program. He is the first PC alumnus to coach the team since his former coach Lou Lamoriello guided the Friars (1968-83). He also is the first former Hockey East player to be a head coach in the league. In his first season, Army led the team to a 17-16-3 overall record, including a 14-10-3 mark in Hockey East action. The 17 wins were the most by a Friar squad since 2002-03. In addition, the Friars, who were picked to finish eighth in the preseason coaches poll, recorded 14 conference victories and finished fifth in the league. The 14 Hockey East wins were one shy of tying a school record. Prior to coaching at Portland, Army spent nine seasons as an assistant coach in the NHL for two different teams. He worked for four seasons as an assistant for Friar great Ron Wilson with the Anaheim Mighty Ducks (1993-97) and five years under Wilson with the Washington Capitals (1997-02). While in Anaheim, Army was part of the 1996-97 team that earned the franchise's first ever playoff berth and advanced to the second round, where the Mighty Ducks fell to the eventual Stanley Cup Champion Detroit Red Wings. Army helped lead the squad to the 1998 Stanley Cup Finals, the team's only appearance in the finals.

FRIARS DRAFTED BY THE NHL... This season's PC team features six players who were selected in the NHL Entry Draft. Senior defenseman Trevor Ludwig (Grapevine, Texas) was a 2004 sixth-round selection, 183rd overall by the Dallas Stars. Junior Pierce Norton was a 2004 ninth-round pick, 285th overall by the Toronto Maple Leafs. Sophomore Mark Fayne (Bourne, Mass.) was chosen in the fifth round, 155th overall by the New Jersey Devils in the 2005 draft. In 2006, PC had two players selected in the fifth round. Junior Cody Wild was the 140th overall selection, while senior Jon Rheault was the 145th pick. Freshman Joe Lavin (Shrewsbury, Mass.) was picked in the fifth round (126th overall) in the 2007 Draft.
