FRIARS FACE BC IN HOCKEY EAST QUARTERFINALS... Providence College, seeded No. 5, will battle Boston College, seeded No. 4, in a best-of-three Hockey East quarterfinal series, beginning on Friday, March 14 at the Kelley Rink in Chestnut Hill, Mass. It will mark the third time ever that the two teams will face each other in the Hockey East quarterfinals. The last time that PC and BC squared off in the quarterfinals was in 1998 as the Eagles swept the best-of-three series. The two teams also played each other in 1996 and the Friars swept the series en route to winning their second Hockey East Tournament title.

FRIAR HOCKEY EAST TOURNAMENT HISTORY... PC is 26-37-1 all-time in Hockey East Tournament games, including a 3-4 mark versus Boston College. The Friars have won two Hockey East Tournament titles (1985, 1996). Last season, eighth-seeded PC was swept by top-seeded UNH in the quarterfinals at the Whittemore Center.

PC IN HOCKEY EAST QUARTERFINALS... The Friars have posted a 19-27-1 mark in the Hockey East Quarterfinals, including a 2-2 mark against the Eagles. PC swept a quarterfinal series against BC in 1996 at Schneider Arena and BC avenged that loss two years later with a sweep of the Friars in 1998 at Kelley Rink. In both occasions, the team that has won the quarterfinal series also has won the Hockey East Tournament title.

FRIAR QUICK NOTES...

- PC's two wins at BC's Kelley Rink this season marked the first time since the 1995-96 campaign that they have accomplished the feat. In addition, the Friars captured their first regular season series against the Eagles since the 2001-02 season.
- In the February 29 game against BC, PC junior Jon Mori had a penalty shot that was saved by John Muse. It marked the Friars' first penalty shot since December 21, 1991.
- The Friars are ranked No. 19 in the USCHO.com/CSTV Poll, which was released on March 10. It marks the seventh consecutive week that PC has been ranked in USCHO.com/CSTV Poll.
- Jon Rheault leads the team in scoring with 29 points on a career-high 17 goals and 12 assists, while Matt Taormina (8 g, 17 a) is second with 25 points.
- Rheault has scored both overtime goals for the Friars this season and is tied for the team lead with three game-winning goals.
- Senior goalie Tyler Sims played in his 110th career game in goal for PC on February 22 setting the school record. He has now played in 115 career games. Dan Dennis (109 games from 1993-97) held the previous record.
- The Friars are tied for fourth in the nation with nine short-handed goals.
- Junior defensemen Matt Taormina and Cody Wild rank seventh and eighth in the nation, respectively, in points per game among defensemen. Taormina (8 g, 17 a - 25 pts.) is averaging 0.74 points, while Wild (4 g, 18 a - 22 pts.) also averaging 0.73 points per game.
- Junior Pierce Norton has scored a career-high 14 goals this season, which is double the amount of goals he scored in his first two seasons at Providence College.

SERIES HISTORY VERSUS BOSTON COLLEGE... In 148 all-time meetings, the Eagles lead, 92-45-11, including a 53-19-3 mark at BC. On February 1, the Friars defeated the Eagles, 3-2, at Kelley Rink, marking their first victory over the Eagles at Kelley Rink since January 24, 2003. On February 29, PC earned a 3-2 triumph over the Eagles. It was the first time since the 1995-96 season that PC won two games at Kelley rink. The Friars also recorded a 2-2 overtime tie against the Eagles on March 1. Last season, the Friars posted a 1-2 record against BC.

SCOUTING BOSTON COLLEGE... The Eagles ended a five-game winless streak with a 4-1 win at Northeastern on Saturday, March 8. BC scored three times in a span of 1:06 late in the first period en route to the win. Nathan Gerbe and Brian Gibbons each finished with one goal and one assist, while John Muse finished with 35 saves. Gerbe leads the team in scoring with 48 points on 24 goals and 24 assists, while Joe Whitney is second with 41 points (seven goals, 34 assists). Muse has played in every game for the Eagles and has posted a 2.38 goals against average and a .913 save percentage.

WORKING OVERTIME... The Friars have played in 10 overtime games this season and have posted a 2-3-5 record. The 10 overtime games, matches a school record that was set by the 1984-85 squad which posted a 4-1-5 mark and went on to capture the first Hockey East Tournament title.

FRIARS AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS... The Friars are 10-7-3 against ranked teams this season. PC defeated No. 8/8 Boston College, 3-2, on February 29 and tied the Eagles, 2-2, on March 1. In addition, PC also defeated No. 9 Boston College, 3-2, on February 1. Other wins over ranked teams were against No. 11 Northeastern (5-1 on 1/25; 5-2 on 1/26), No. 9/10 UMass (3-2 on 1/18), No. 13 UMass Lowell (4-3 on 1/11), No. 5 Michigan State (5-3 on 12/29), No. 11 Maine (6-2 on 11/9; 1-0 on 11/10) and No. 16 UMass (3-1 on 10/26). PC's losses to ranked opponents came against No. 16 Boston University (6-0 on 3/6; 2-0 on 3/7), No. 4 New Hampshire (4-3 on 2/16), No. 13 UMass Lowell (3-2 on 1/12), No. 1/2 Michigan (6-0 on 12/28), No. 6 New Hampshire (5-4 on 11/17), No. 13 Clarkson (4-1 on 10/13) and No. 12 St. Lawrence (4-1 on 10/12). PC has gone 5-3-2 in the last 10 games against ranked teams. Last season, the Friars posted a 4-14-1 record against ranked opponents.

SEVEN FRIARS REACH CAREER HIGH IN POINTS... Seven Friars have reached a career high in points this season, led by juniors Matt Taormina and Pierce Norton who have 25 and 24 points, respectively. In addition, Jon Rheault has a career high 17 goals.

SIMS INCHING CLOSER TO ANOTHER RECORD... Senior goalie Tyler Sims has set two school records this season and is closing in on another mark. On December 1, he posted his sixth career shutout (4-0 win at Vermont) which set a PC record for most career shutouts. He currently has seven shutouts after blanking Brown on December 4. His three shutouts this season also ties a school record for most in one season (set by Mario Proulx 1981-82, Nolan Schaefer 2000-01 and Sims in 2005-06). On February 22, he set another school mark by playing in his 110th game, surpassing Dan Dennis (1993-97) who played in 109 contests. He has now played in 115 games. He also has 2,780 career saves. He needs 68 more saves to tie Nolan Schaefer (2,848 from 1999-03) atop the list.

FRIARS TAKING THEIR SHOTS... The Friars have outshot their opponents in 27 of the 34 games, including four contests with 50 shots or more. PC leads Hockey East in shots on goal, averaging 37.7 per game. Most recently, PC had 53 shots in a 1-1 tie against No. 4 New Hampshire on February 15. The Friars are 12-12-3 when outshooting their opponents.

FRIARS THRIVING WHILE SHORT HANDED... The Friars, who did not score a short-handed goal in their first six contests, have scored nine short-handed goals in the last 28 games. PC is tied for fourth in the nation with nine short-handed tallies this season. The Friars tallied two goals while short handed on November 1 against Boston University. Jon Rheault, Matt Taormina, and Nick Mazzolini are tied for 15th in the nation with two short-handed goals, while five others each have one.

RHEAULT REACHES MILESTONE... PC senior co-captain Jon Rheault recorded his 99th, 100th and 101st career points on February 9 against Vermont. His assist in the second period was his 100th career point as he became the 48th Friar to reach the 100-point mark. Rheault, who leads the team in scoring with 29 points, currently has 103 points (56 g, 47 a), which ranks tied for 44th all-time at Providence College. Jon DiSalvatore (1999-03) was the last Friar to reach the century mark when he accomplished the feat on October 12, 2002.

TAORMINA ENJOYING STRONG SEASON... Defenseman Matt Taormina has enjoyed a strong season. He is second on the team with a career-high 25 points (8 g, 17 a) after recording 18 points (6 g, 12 a) in his first two seasons at PC. He tallied a career-high five points (two goals, three assists) in a 6-2 win at No. 11 Maine on November 9. He is tied for 15th in the nation with two short-handed goals and among defensemen he is the national leader in that category. In addition, he is seventh in the nation among defensemen with a 0.74 points per game average and is tied for the national lead among defensemen with eight goals. His 25 points marks the highest by a PC defenseman since All-American Stephen Wood '04 had 29 points (11 g, 18 a) during the 2003-04 season.

THREE FRIARS NAMED AS SEMIFINALISTS FOR WALTER BROWN AWARD... It was announced on February 4, that PC seniors Jon Rheault and Tyler Sims as well as junior Matt Taormina were named as three of the 15 semifinalists for the 56th Walter Brown Award, presented annually to the best American-born college hockey player in New England. PC led the way with three nominees, while Boston College, Boston University and New Hampshire each have two. Four PC players have earned the Walter Brown Award, with the last being Mike Omiccioli, who shared the honor with BC's Mike Mottau in 1999. Prior to Mike Omiccioli, Rob Gaudreau won the award in 1992. In addition, PC coach Tim Army won the award in 1985 and Ron Wilson, Head Coach of the NHL's San Jose Sharks, was the first Friar to win the award when he was honored in 1975.

SIMPSON RETURNS TO FRIAR LINEUP... Sophomore goalie Ryan Simpson (Bow, N.H.) who had not dressed for a game since November 10, 2006 because of injuries, returned to the Friar lineup as the back-up on February 8 against Vermont. He made his first appearance this season on March 6 versus Boston University and also played on March 7 at BU. In his freshman season, he played in four games, before sustaining an injury.

HEAD COACH TIM ARMY... Tim Army is in his third season with the Friars. Army returned to his alma mater to take over the reigns of the PC hockey program on June 17, 2005 after spending three seasons with the Portland Pirates of the AHL. A 1985 graduate of the College and an East Providence native, Army became the 11th coach in the history of the program. He is the first PC alumnus to coach the team since his former coach Lou Lamoriello guided the Friars (1968-83). He also is the first former Hockey East player to be a head coach in the league. In his first season, Army led the team to a 17-16-3 overall record, including a 14-10-3 mark in Hockey East action. The 17 wins were the most by a Friar squad since 2002-03. In addition, the Friars, who were picked to finish eighth in the preseason coaches poll, recorded 14 conference victories and finished fifth in the league. The 14 Hockey East wins were one shy of tying a school record. Prior to coaching at Portland, Army spent nine seasons as an assistant coach in the NHL for two different teams. He worked for four seasons as an assistant for Friar great Ron Wilson with the Anaheim Mighty Ducks (1993-97) and five years under Wilson with the Washington Capitals (1997-02). While in Anaheim, Army was part of the 1996-97 team that earned the franchise's first ever playoff berth and advanced to the second round, where the Mighty Ducks fell to the eventual Stanley Cup Champion Detroit Red Wings. Army helped lead the Capitals to the 1998 Stanley Cup Finals, the team's only appearance in the finals.

FRIARS DRAFTED BY THE NHL... This season's PC team features six players who were selected in the NHL Entry Draft. Senior Trevor Ludwig (Grapevine, Texas) was a 2004 sixth-round selection, 183rd overall by the Dallas Stars. Junior Pierce Norton was a 2004 ninth-round pick, 285th overall by the Toronto Maple Leafs. Sophomore Mark Fayne (Bourne, Mass.) was chosen in the fifth round, 155th overall by the New Jersey Devils in the 2005 draft. In 2006, PC had two players selected in the fifth round. Junior Cody Wild was the 140th overall selection, while senior Jon Rheault was the 145th pick. Freshman Joe Lavin (Shrewsbury, Mass.) was picked in the fifth round (126th overall) in the 2007 Draft.
