FRIARS FACE UNH IN HOCKEY EAST QUARTERFINALS...

Providence College, seeded No. 8, will battle New Hampshire, seeded No. 1, in a best-of-three Hockey East quarterfinal series, beginning on Thursday, March 8 at the Whittemore Center in Durham, N.H. It will mark the third time in four years, including the last two seasons, that PC and UNH have met in the quarterfinals. The Friars will seek to win their first Hockey East quarterfinal series since 2001 when they defeated Boston University (two-games-to-one) at Schneider Arena.

FRIAR HOCKEY EAST TOURNAMENT HISTORY... PC is 26-34-1

all-time in Hockey East Tournament games, including a 4-8 mark versus New Hampshire. The Friars have won two Hockey East Tournament titles (1985, 1996). Last season, fifth-seeded PC was swept by fourth-seeded UNH in the quarterfinals (two-games-to-none) at the Whittemore Center.

PROVIDENCE IN HOCKEY EAST QUARTERFINALS... The Friars

have posted a 19-25-1 mark in the Hockey East Quarterfinals, including a 4-6 mark against New Hampshire. The two teams played against each other in the league quarterfinals in 2006 and the Wildcats prevailed (two-games-to-none). They also squared off in 2004 with UNH winning (two-games-to-one).

FRIAR QUICK NOTES...

- The Friars enter the Hockey East Quarterfinals having won three consecutive games for the first time this season.
- PC earned consecutive victories over New Hampshire (7-1 on Feb. 24) and Merrimack (7-2 on Mar. 2). It marked the first time since the 1990-91 season that the Friars scored seven goals in back-to-back games.
- Junior Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.) has 10 points (four goals, six assists) in the last four games.
- PC has outshot its opponents in 28 of the 34 games this season. The Friars recorded a season-high 51 shots against New Hampshire on Feb. 24. In addition, PC has outshot its opponents in nine straight games.
- PC is 2-0-3 in overtime games this season.
- Providence College has scored the first goal of the game 14 times. PC is 8-4-2 when scoring first and 2-17-1 when it is scored upon first.
- After not scoring in the first 17 games this season, sophomore defenseman Cody Wild (North Providence, R.I.) has six goals in the last 13 games.
- The Friars earned their first road win on Jan. 13 at UMass Lowell. PC is 3-11-2 away from Schneider Arena this season.
- Rheault leads the team in scoring with 25 points (12 goals, 13 assists), while Mazzolini is second with 21 points (five goals, 16 assists).
- After not scoring a power-play goal in 14 consecutive games (0-62), the Friars have scored five power-play tallies in the last four games (5-20).

LAST TIME OUT... The Friars closed out the regular season with a 2-1 win over Merrimack Saturday night at Lawler Arena in North Andover, Mass. It marked PC's third consecutive win. Freshman John Cavanagh (Warwick, R.I.) gave the Friars a 1-0 lead late in the first period as he scored on the power play for his first career tally. The Warriors tied the game halfway through the second period, however, sophomore Matt Taormina's (Washington Township, Mich.) goal early in the third period was the difference in the game. Junior goalie Tyler Sims (Grand Blanc, Mich.) made 24 saves to earn his seventh win this season.

SERIES HISTORY VERSUS UNH... In 129 meetings between the two teams, the Wildcats hold a 67-50-12 lead, including a 44-19-4 mark at UNH. UNH captured the first two meetings this season, which were both played at the Whittemore Center. The Wildcats posted a 2-1 win on January 27 and a 6-4 triumph on February 23. However, the Friars registered a 7-1 win over the Wildcats on February 24 at Schneider Arena. Last season, the Wildcats captured the season series with a 3-1-1 record, including a 2-0 mark in the Hockey East Quarterfinals. UNH eliminated the Friars from the Hockey East playoffs with a 2-1 double overtime win in the second game of a best-of-three series.

SCOUTING NEW HAMPSHIRE... The Wildcats clinched the outright Hockey East Regular Season title on February 24 following a Boston University loss. It marked their sixth Hockey East regular season crown. UNH comes into the playoffs having posted a 1-4-1 record over the last six games, including a 4-2 loss in the regular season finale at Boston College. Trevor Smith leads the team with 40 points (19 goals, 21 assists), while Matt Fornataro is second with 37 points on 12 goals and 25 assists. In goal, Kevin Regan has seen the bulk of the action, posting a 21-7-2 record, a .931 save percentage and a 2.16 goals against average.

FRIARS SET MARK VERSUS UNH... PC set a number of marks in the win over UNH on February 24. The seven goals were the most against the Wildcats since they scored seven on November 14, 2003. In addition, the seven goals were the most by a Friar team since December 21, 2005. Junior Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.) tallied a career-high five points (two goals, three assists), while senior Colin McDonald (Wethersfield, Conn.) scored his career-high 12th goal of the season. In goal, sophomore Chris Mannix (Hubbardston, Mass.), who was making his first collegiate start, stopped a career-high 21 shots to earn his first win.

SHOT ADVANTAGE... Through 34 games this season, the Friars have outshot their opponents in 28 of those contests. In all, PC is averaging 35.0 shots per game, while opponents are averaging 26.0. In 27 Hockey East games, the Friars averaged 36.0 shots, while opponents averaged 25.8 shots per contest. Over the last eight games, the Friars are averaging 41.4 shots per game.

STREAK CONTINUES FOR ZANCANARO... Friar senior co-captain Tony Zancanaro (Trenton, Mich.) has played in all 144 games in his career at Providence College. He is currently tied for 12th all-time at PC in career games played. Current Friar Head Coach Tim Army holds PC's all-time record for games played with 151.

FRESHMAN TRIO MAKING IMPACT... The freshman trio of John Cavanagh (Warwick, R.I.), Greg Collins (Hingham, Mass.) and Mark Fayne (Sagamore Beach, Mass.) has made their mark as rookies this season. Despite missing 12 games because of injury, John Cavanagh has 11 points on one goal and 10 assists. His 10 assists ranks third on the team. He scored his first career goal on March 3 in a 2-1 win at Merrimack. Collins leads all freshmen in scoring with 13 points on five goals and eight assists. In addition, he ranks tied for fifth on the team in scoring. Fayne has been one of the top defensemen for PC this season. He has played in all 34 games and has 12 points on five goals and seven assists.

SHORT-HANDED RHEAULT... Friar junior Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.) leads the team with a career-high three short-handed goals. All three of his short-handed goals have been game winners. Rheault is second in Hockey East with three short-handed goals and is ranked tied for eighth nationally. In his first two seasons, Rheault totalled two short-handed goals.

SECOND PERIOD SUCCESS... Of the 76 goals scored by the Friars this season, 33 have come in the second period. The Friars scored three times in the second period against New Hampshire on February 23-24 and versus Merrimack on March 2. Conversely, PC has allowed 34 opponents' goals in the first period and are being outscored, 34-20, in the opening 20 minutes. However, the Friars have outscored their opponents, 2-0, in overtime.

FRIARS AGAINST RANKED TEAMS... The Friars are 4-12-1 against ranked teams this season. PC was defeated 6-1 by No. 17 Clarkson in the regular season opener on October 13 at Schneider Arena. On October 31, the Friars upset No. 3 Boston College, 5-3, at Schneider Arena, marking the team's first win over a ranked opponent since beating No. 14 New Hampshire on February 25, 2006. The Friars also defeated fourth-ranked Maine, 3-0, on January 19 and 14th-ranked Vermont on February 3. Most recently, the Friars defeated No. 3 UNH, 7-1, on February 24.

SIMS CLIMBS INTO TOP 10 IN TWO CATEGORIES... Junior goalie Tyler Sims (Grand Blanc, Mich.) has climbed into the top-10 at Providence College in a pair of categories. Sims is ninth all-time at PC with 2,031 career saves and is eighth all-time with 83 career games played. This season, Sims has played in 30 games and has 657 saves. He has posted a 2.72 goals against average and a .899 save percentage. Sims has started 22 of the last 24 games for the Friars.

HEAD COACH TIM ARMY... Tim Army is in his second season with the Friars. Army returned to his alma mater to take over the reigns of the PC hockey program on June 17, 2005 after spending three seasons with the Portland Pirates of the AHL. A 1985 graduate of the College and an East Providence native, Army became the 11th coach in the history of the program. He is the first PC alumnus to coach the team since his former coach Lou Lamoriello guided the Friars (1968-83). He also is the first former Hockey East player to be a head coach in the league. In his first season, Army led the team to a 17-16-3 overall record, including a 14-10-3 mark in Hockey East action. The 17 wins were the most by a Friar squad since 2002-03. In addition, the Friars, who were picked to finish eighth in the pre-season coaches poll, recorded 14 conference victories and finished fifth in the league. The 14 Hockey East wins were one shy of tying a school record. Prior to coaching at Portland, Army spent nine seasons as an assistant coach in the NHL for two different teams. He worked for four seasons as an assistant for Friar great Ron Wilson with the Anaheim Mighty Ducks (1993-97) and five years under Wilson with the Washington Capitals (1997-02). While in Anaheim, Army was part of the 1996-97 team that earned the franchise's first ever playoff berth and advanced to the second round, where the Mighty Ducks fell to the eventual Stanley Cup Champion Detroit Red Wings. Army helped lead the squad to the 1998 Stanley Cup Finals, the team's only appearance in the finals.

NHL TIES... Five members of this season's PC squad have relatives who played or coached in the NHL. Colin McDonald's father, Gerry, played in the NHL for the Hartford Whalers from 1980-1984 ... Chase Watson's father, Jim, played in the NHL for 10 years with the Philadelphia Flyers ... Trevor Ludwig's father, Craig, also played in the NHL for 15 years and finished his career with the Dallas Stars in 1999 ... Tyler Sims' father, Al, played in the NHL for 10 seasons and is the former Head Coach of the San Jose Sharks ... Kyle Laughlin's father, Craig, played in the NHL for nine years, including six seasons with the Washington Capitals.

FRIARS DRAFTED BY THE NHL... This season's Providence team features six players who were selected in the NHL Entry Draft. Senior Colin McDonald (Wethersfield, Conn.) was drafted in the second round, 51st overall by the Edmonton Oilers in 2003. Junior defenseman Trevor Ludwig (Grapevine, Texas) was a 2004 sixth-round selection, 183rd overall by the Dallas Stars. Sophomore Pierce Norton (South Boston, Mass.) was a 2004 ninth-round pick, 285th overall by the Toronto Maple Leafs. Freshman Mark Fayne (Sagamore Beach, Mass.) was chosen in the fifth round, 155th overall by the New Jersey Devils in the 2005 draft. This past summer, PC had two players selected in the fifth round. Sophomore Cody Wild (North Providence, R.I.) was the 140th overall selection, while junior Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.) was the 145th pick.

PC ANNOUNCES SIGNING OF SIX STUDENT-ATHLETES... Head Coach Tim Army announced on January 12 that student athletes Kyle Mackinnon (Walnut, Calif.), Jordan Kremyr (Cloverdale, B.C.), Austin Mayer (Providence, R.I.), Eric Baier (North Kingstown, R.I.) and Joe Lavin (Shrewsbury, Mass.) each have signed a National Letter of Intent to attend PC beginning in September 2007. Ian O'Connor (Londonderry, N.H.) also has committed to attend PC. Mackinnon is a 6-foot, 185-pound center, who plays for the Langley Chiefs of the British Columbia Hockey League; Kremyr, a 6-foot, 185-pound left wing, is in his fourth season in the BCHL and his third with the Alberni Valley Bulldogs; Mayer is a 6-foot, 190-pound left wing who currently plays for the New Hampshire Junior Monarchs of the EJHL; Baier is a 6-foot-2 inch, 195 pound defenseman, who also plays for the Monarchs; Lavin is a the 6-foot-1 inch defenseman who plays for the U.S. National Under-18 Team; O'Connor is a 6-foot, 190-pound left wing and also plays for the Monarchs.
