**FRIARS TO HOST NO. 4 UNH...** The No. 14/14 PC Friars will play a home-and-home series against the UNH Wildcats beginning on Friday, February 15 at Schneider Arena. The two teams will close out the series the following night at the Whittemore Center in Durham, N.H.

**SERIES HISTORY VERSUS NEW HAMPSHIRE..** In 132 meetings between the two teams, the Wildcats hold a 70-50-12 lead. Last season, the Wildcats posted a 4-1 record against the Friars, including a pair of wins in a best-of-three Hockey East Quarterfinal series at the Whittemore Center. PC's lone win against the Wildcats last season was on February 24 at Schneider Arena as the Friars posted a 7-1 triumph behind a five-point effort (two goals, three assists) by Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.). In the first meeting between the two teams this season, UNH defeated the Friars, 5-4, in overtime on November 17.

**SCOUTING NEW HAMPSHIRE...** The Wildcats have won seven of their last eight games, including five consecutive victories. Most recently, UNH swept a two-game series at Maine. On February 8, Mike Radja scored all three goals to lead the team to a 3-2 win. The following night, Radja had one goal and one assist as the Wildcats prevailed, 4-1, over the Black Bears. Matt Fornataro leads the team with 34 points (11 goals, 23 assists), while Rajda is tops on the squad with 17 goals and second with 31 points. In goal, Kevin Regan has played in 21 games and has a 2.29 goals against average and a .925 save percentage.

**RHEAULT REACHES MILESTONE...** PC senior co-captain Jon Rheault recorded his 99th, 100th and 101st career points on February 9 against Vermont. His assist in the second period was his 100th career point as he became the 48th Friar to reach the 100-point mark. Rheault, who has 19 points (14 goals, five assists) in the last 16 games, has 56 goals and 45 assists. Jon DiSalvatore (1999-03) was the last Friar to reach the century mark when he accomplished the feat on October 12, 2002. This season, Rheault leads the team lead in scoring with 27 points (17 goals, 10 assists) in 26 games.

## FRIAR QUICK NOTES...

- The Friars are 13-6-3 over the last 22 games after starting the season with four consecutive losses. In addition, PC is 6-3-1 in 2008.
- The Friars are ranked No. 14 in both the *USA Today*/USA Hockey Magazine Poll the USCHO.com/CSTV Poll, which were released on February 11. It marks the third consecutive week that PC has been ranked.
- The Friars are coming off a 4-3 overtime win over Vermont on February 9. Jon Rheault scored two goals, including the game winner and added one assist. Rheault recorded his 100th and 101st career points to become the 48th Friar to reach the 100-point plateau.
- Jon Rheault leads the team in scoring with 27 points on a career high 17 goals and 10 assists, while junior Matt Taormina (Washington Township, Mich.) is second with 24 points (eight goals, 16 assists).
- Rheault has scored both overtime goals for the Friars this season and is tied for the team lead with three game-winning goals.
- Senior goalie Tyler Sims (Fort Wayne, Ind.) has played in 107 career games in goal for PC. He is two games shy of tying a school record. Dan Dennis (109 from 1993-97) holds the record for most career games played.
- Providence College has gone 23-for-108 (.213) on the power play this season, which ranks second in Hockey East and sixth nationally. The 23 goals are seven more than last season's total on the man advantage.
- The Friars are tied for the national lead with nine short-handed goals.
- Junior defensemen Matt Taormina and Cody Wild (North Providence, R.I.) rank second and fifth in the nation, respectively in points per game among defensemen. Taormina (8 g, 16 a - 24 pts.) is averaging 0.92 points per game, while Wild (4 g, 14 a - 18 pts.) is averaging 0.82 points.

**RECAP OF LAST WEEKEND VERSUS VERMONT...** The Friars split a weekend series against Vermont. On February 8, the Friars were defeated by the Catamounts, 2-1, at Schneider Arena as Jon Rheault scored PC's only goal. The following night, the Friars earned a 4-3 overtime win over the Catamounts as Rheault scored two goals, including the game winner and added one assist. Rheault scored a short-handed goal to give the Friars a 1-0 lead, while junior Nick Mazzolini (Anchorage, Alaska) added a power play tally to increase that lead to 2-0. However, the Catamounts scored as time expired in the first period to cut the lead in half. Sophomore Greg Collins (Hingham, Mass.) gave PC a 3-1 lead in the second period, but Vermont responded with one goal in the second and third periods to even the score. Rheault then sealed PC's win when he deflected a shot past UVM goalie Joe Fallon with 16 seconds left in overtime. Sophomore John Cavanagh (Warwick, R.I.) had two assists, while senior Tyler Sims made 30 saves.

**FRIARS AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS...** The Friars are 9-5-0 against ranked teams this season. Most recently, PC defeated No. 9 Boston College, 3-2, on February 1. Other wins over ranked teams were against No. 11 Northeastern (5-1 on 1/25; 5-2 on 1/26), No. 9/10 UMass (3-2 on 1/18), No. 13 UMass Lowell (4-3 on 1/11), No. 5 Michigan State (5-3 on 12/29), No. 11 Maine (6-2 on 11/9; 1-0 on 11/10) and No. 16 UMass (3-1 on 10/26). PC's losses to ranked opponents came against No. 13 UMass Lowell (3-2 on 1/12), No. 1/2 Michigan (6-0 on 12/28), No. 6 New Hampshire on 11/17, No. 13 Clarkson (4-1 on 10/13) and No. 12 St. Lawrence (4-1 on 10/12). PC has won four consecutive games against ranked teams. Last season, the Friars posted a 4-14-1 record against ranked opponents.

**FRIARS THRIVING WHILE SHORT HANDED...** The Friars, who did not score a short-handed goal in their first six contests, have scored nine short-handed goals in the last 20 games. PC is tied for the national lead with nine short-handed tallies this season. The Friars tallied two goals while short handed on November 1 against Boston University. Jon Rheault, Matt Taormina, and Nick Mazzolini are tied for 13th in the nation with two short-handed goals, while five others each have one short-handed tally. The Friars are ranked first in Hockey East and 10th nationally on the penalty kill (.883).

**RECAP OF FIRST GAME VERSUS NEW HAMPSHIRE...** Paul Thompson scored three times including the overtime game winner to lead the Wildcats to a 5-4 victory over the Friars on November 17 in Providence. Thompson, who also added two assists, redirected a pass from James vanRiemsdyk at 2:03 of the extra session to seal the win for the Wildcats. He also scored at 11:48 of the third period to tie the game (4-4). Trailing 3-1 to start the third period, the Friars cut the margin to one just nine seconds into the period. Greg Collins fired a shot from the blue line that eluded UNH goalie Brian Foster. The Friars scored two goals in a span of 11 seconds halfway through the third period to take the lead, 4-3. PC tallied its second power-play goal of the night at 10:25 when Jon Rheault scored on a wrist shot from the left circle to tie the game. At 10:36, Pierce Norton recorded his second goal of the night. However, the lead was short-lived as Thompson scored from in close to even the score at 11:48. Norton opened the scoring at 14:50 of the first period as he converted on the power-play. UNH bounced back with three straight goals, including two late tallies in the first and second periods. Thompson scored his first of the night at 16:34 to even the score and vanRiemsdyk gave UNH a 2-1 first period lead at 19:40. With two seconds left in the second period, Craig Switzer added to the Wildcats' lead, scoring his second goal of the season.

**TAORMINA CONTINUES TO SHINE...** Defenseman Matt Taormina is off to a strong start for the Friars. He is second on the team lead with a career-high 24 points (eight goals, 15 assists). In his first two seasons at PC, he recorded 18 points (six goals, 12 assists). He has tallied 22 points (seven goals, 15 assists) in the last 18 games, including a career-high five points (two goals, three assists) in a 6-2 win at No. 11 Maine on November 9. He is tied for 13th in the nation with two short-handed goals and among defensemen he is the national leader in that category. In addition, he is second in the nation among defensemen with 0.92 points per game average and leads all defenders with eight goals. His 24 points marks the highest by a PC defenseman since Stephen Wood '04 had 29 points (11 goals, 18 assists) during the 2003-04 season.

**FRIARS TAKING THEIR SHOTS...** The Friars have outshot their opponents in 20 of the 26 games, including three contests with 50 shots or more. PC leads Hockey East in shots on goal, averaging 37.7 per game. Most recently, PC had 51 shots in a 1-1 tie at Merrimack on February 2. The Friars are 12-7-1 when outshooting their opponents.

**SIMS SETTING RECORDS...** Senior goalie Tyler Sims' shutout win at Vermont on December 1 marked his sixth career shutout, which set a Friar record. He now has seven shutouts after blanking Brown on December 4 for his second consecutive shutout. He is the only PC goalie to record back-to-back shutouts as he also did it on October 21-22, 2005 against UMass Lowell. His three shutouts this season also ties a school record for most in one season (set by Mario Proulx 1981-82, Nolan Schaefer 2000-01 and Sims in 2005-06). Sims earned his fifth shutout on November 10 at No. 11 Maine and tied the PC record for most career shutouts, which was set by Mario Proulx (1980-84). He also ranks sixth all-time with 2,599 career saves and is second all-time with 107 games played.

**THREE FRIARS NAMED AS SEMIFINALISTS FOR WALTER BROWN AWARD...** It was announced on February 4, that PC seniors Jon Rheault (Deering, N.H.) and Tyler Sims (Fort Wayne, Ind.) as well as junior Matt Taormina (Washington Township, Mich.) were named as three of the 15 semifinalists for the 56th Walter Brown Award, presented annually to the best American-born college hockey player in New England. PC led the way with three nominees, while Boston College, Boston University and New Hampshire each have two. Four PC players have earned the Walter Brown Award, with the last being Mike Omiccoli, who shared the honor with BC's Mike Mottau in 1999. Prior to Mike Omiccoli, Rob Gaudreau won the award in 1992. In addition, Friar Head Coach Tim Army won the award in 1985 and Ron Wilson, Head Coach of the NHL's San Jose Sharks, was the first Friar to win the award when he was honored in 1975.

**SIMPSON RETURNS TO FRIAR LINEUP...** Sophomore goalie Ryan Simpson (Bow, N.H.) who had not dressed for a game since November 10, 2006, returned to the Friar line up as the back-up on February 8 against Vermont. Simpson battled multiple injuries and is now healthy to play. In his freshman season, he played in four games, before sustaining an injury against Vermont.

**HEAD COACH TIM ARMY...** Tim Army is in his third season with the Friars. Army returned to his alma mater to take over the reigns of the PC hockey program on June 17, 2005 after spending three seasons with the Portland Pirates of the AHL. A 1985 graduate of the College and an East Providence native, Army became the 11th coach in the history of the program. He is the first PC alumnus to coach the team since his former coach Lou Lamoriello guided the Friars (1968-83). He also is the first former Hockey East player to be a head coach in the league. In his first season, Army led the team to a 17-16-3 overall record, including a 14-10-3 mark in Hockey East action. The 17 wins were the most by a Friar squad since 2002-03. In addition, the Friars, who were picked to finish eighth in the preseason coaches poll, recorded 14 conference victories and finished fifth in the league. The 14 Hockey East wins were one shy of tying a school record. Prior to coaching at Portland, Army spent nine seasons as an assistant coach in the NHL for two different teams. He worked for four seasons as an assistant for Friar great Ron Wilson with the Anaheim Mighty Ducks (1993-97) and five years under Wilson with the Washington Capitals (1997-02). While in Anaheim, Army was part of the 1996-97 team that earned the franchise's first ever playoff berth and advanced to the second round, where the Mighty Ducks fell to the eventual Stanley Cup Champion Detroit Red Wings. Army helped lead the squad to the 1998 Stanley Cup Finals, the team's only appearance in the finals.

**FRIARS DRAFTED BY THE NHL...** This season's PC team features six players who were selected in the NHL Entry Draft. Senior defenseman Trevor Ludwig (Grapevine, Texas) was a 2004 sixth-round selection, 183rd overall by the Dallas Stars.
