**PROVIDENCE COLLEGE TO FACE USF IN BIG EAST CHAMPIONSHIP QUARTERFINALS...** Providence College earned the eighth seed in the BIG EAST Championship and will face top-seeded USF on Thursday, May 8 at 4:00 p.m. In all, the Friars have reached the BIG EAST Championship eight times (1990, 1992, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1996, 2006, 2008), including two of the last three seasons under Head Coach Kerri Jacklets. Providence captured its first BIG EAST Championship crown in 1994.

**PROVIDENCE VERSUS USF...** PC's game against USF on May 8 will mark the first ever meeting between the two teams in the BIG EAST Championship. Overall, the Friars are 0-6 against the Bulls, including a double header sweep (5-4, 5-1) on May 3.

**PROVIDENCE HISTORY IN THE BIG EAST CHAMPIONSHIP...** Providence has posted a 9-12 record all-time in the BIG EAST Championship. In 1994, the Friars went 4-1 en route to capturing their first BIG EAST crown. Most recently in 2006, PC recorded a 0-1 mark in tournament action as they were defeated, 4-1, by Notre Dame which went on to capture the tournament title.

**PROVIDENCE AGAINST THE CHAMPIONSHIP FIELD...** Providence posted a 2-10 record this season against BIG EAST Championship opponents. The Friars posted a 6-0 win over Connecticut on March 29 and a 5-3 triumph at Notre Dame on April 26.

**PROVIDENCE IN CLOSE GAMES...** The Friars have posted an 11-6 record this season in one-run games, including a 3-5 mark in BIG EAST Conference contests. In addition, Providence is 3-3-1 in extra inning games. Most recently, the Friars were defeated, 5-4, by USF on May 3 and posted a 2-1 win over Boston College on May 1.

#### FRIAR QUICK NOTES

- After six consecutive BIG EAST losses, the Friars posted a 7-6 record in their last 13 league games.
- The Friars earned their first ever win at Notre Dame on April 26.
- Sophomore Danielle Bertolette (Temecula, Calif.) has pitched five complete-game shutouts this season, which is tied for the fifth highest single season mark at Providence College.
- Sophomore Jenna Garcia (Morro Bay, Calif.) is on a four-game hit streak, which ties a season high.
- The Friars scored a season-high 14 runs in their 14-1 win over URI on April 23. It marked the second time this season that the Friars have scored 10 or more runs. PC plated 10 runs on March 22 versus Maine.
- The Friars have played in two extra-inning games during the BIG EAST Championship and have posted a 2-0 record. The Friars defeated Boston College, 4-3, in nine innings in 1993 and posted a 3-1 victory in 11 innings over UConn in 1994.

**WHAT'S NEXT...** The winner of the PC/USF game will play the winner of the Notre Dame/Louisville game in the semifinals on Friday, May 9 at 5:00 p.m. The semifinal games and the championship contest will be televised on CBS College Sports.

**FRIARS OVERCOME PRESEASON PREDICTION...** Providence College, which was picked to finish 12th in the BIG EAST Conference Preseason Coaches Poll, finished in eighth place and earned their second BIG EAST Championship berth in the last three years.

**PROVIDENCE IN NEUTRAL SITE GAMES...** The Friars have posted a 6-8 mark in neutral site games this season, including a 4-0 victory over then No. 18 Georgia on February 17 at the Florida International Invitational. In their 14 games in neutral sites, the Friars faced two ranked teams as they played Georgia twice and Ohio State once.

**BASE HEISTS...** Sophomore Katelyn Revens (Warwick, R.I.) has 26 stolen bases out of 29 attempts this season. The 26 stolen bases is second in the BIG EAST Conference behind Pittsburgh's Reba Tutt who has 27 out of 36 attempts. On April 23, Revens recorded three stolen bases against the University of Rhode Island and set a PC record with her 32nd career stolen base. Revens, who has four multiple-stolen base games this season, now has 35 career stolen bases. Kim Robbins '95 held the previous PC record with 31.

**TAKE A WALK...** Junior Mary Rose Sheehy (Woodbridge, Conn.) has set a Providence College single season record with 34 walks this year. The previous mark was 27 set by Kim Robbins in 1994. In the first game of a double header at Villanova on Sunday, April 20, Sheehy received two intentional walks as the Friars posted a 2-0 victory. She also had a career-high three walks on February 29 in a 5-3 triumph over Campbell at the Santa Clara Bronco Invitational. She has 64 career walks, which ranks second all-time at Providence. In addition, senior Samantha Pittman (San Diego, Calif.) ranks fourth all-time with 58 career walks, including 11 this season, which is tied for third on the team.

**WALK INTO THE RECORD BOOK...** Providence has set a school record for most walks in one season. The Friars have recorded 129 walks this season, six more than the previous mark of 123 which was set in 1982. PC had a season-high 10 walks against Quinnipiac on March 15. Mary Rose Sheehy leads the way with 34 walks, while Katelyn Revens has 21 walks.

**SHEEHY LEADING THE WAY FOR PC...** Mary Rose Sheehy leads PC in several offensive categories. She is the leader in batting average (.360), walks (34), slugging percentage (.511) and on-base percentage (.486). In addition, she ranks in the top-10 in the BIG EAST in batting average (eighth), on-base percentage (second) and walks (tied for third).

**FRIARS AMONG NATIONAL LEADERS...** Of games through April 27, the Friars were ranked tied for 45th in the nation in fielding percentage (.969). In addition, Katelyn Revens was 28th in stolen bases, while Mary Rose Sheehy was 29th in walks.

**HEAD COACH KERRI JACKLETS...** Kerri Jacklets is in her third season as head coach of the Providence College softball program. Last season, the Friars finished the season with an overall record of 23-24 including a 6-14 finish in the BIG EAST. The Friars earned their first ever victory over Notre Dame on April 14, defeating the Irish 9-0. Jacklets coached two players who earned All-BIG EAST honors in 2007. Rachel Bartholomew earned All-BIG EAST First Team accolades as well as Northeast All-Region First Team honors. Outfielder Mary Rose Sheehy also earned All-BIG EAST accolades as she was named to the third team. In 2006, Jacklets led the Friars to a 29-19-1 record, including an 11-11 mark in the BIG EAST. The 11 league wins were the most by a Friar team since 1995. Jacklets' team, which was picked to finish 11th out of 12 teams in the 2006 BIG EAST Preseason Coaches Poll, finished sixth in the Conference and earned the program's first trip to the BIG EAST Tournament since 1996. In addition, Jacklets coached three athletes who earned All-BIG EAST accolades. Samantha Pittman was named to the second team, while Elena Romero and Rachel Bartholomew garnered third team honors. Bartholomew and Pittman also were named to the All-Northeast Region Team. Jacklets enjoyed a stellar career as a catcher at PC from 1998-2001. She ranks third all-time at PC in batting average (.315), fifth all-time in home runs (18) and sixth in hits (179). Jacklets also ranks in the top-10 all-time in walks (41) and runs batted in (76). In 2001, she was named to the All-Northeast Region First Team. Jacklets was a four-time BIG EAST Academic All-Star and graduated with a 3.33 GPA in Social Science.

**FRIARS ONLY BIG EAST TEAM TO...** Providence is the only BIG EAST Conference team to hit four home runs in one game on two occasions. PC had four home runs against Maine on March 22 and four versus Connecticut on March 29. In addition, PC is the only team to have four home runs in a league game. The Friars, who rank fourth in the BIG EAST with 28 home runs, have had eight games in which they have hit multiple home runs. Sophomore Christy Becker (Atlanta, Ga.) leads the team with seven home runs.

**FRIAR ALUMNAE AMONG THE COACHING RANKS...** Four former PC softball players serve as head coaches at NCAA Division I schools. Kerri Jacklets '01, who played at Providence, currently is in her third season as the head coach at her alma mater. Amy Kvilhaug '96, one of PC's all-time greatest pitchers, serves as the head coach at St. John's University. Jen Finley '92 is the head coach at Boston College. In addition, twin sisters Kate Drohan '95 and Caryl Drohan '95 serve as the head coach and the associate head coach, respectively, at 11th-ranked Northwestern.

**HOME-SWEET-HOME...** After a 12-game road trip in which Providence posted a 6-5-1 record (4-4 BIG EAST), the Friars returned home for three consecutive games to close out the regular season. The Friars, who had not played at Raymond Field since April 11 when they split a league double header against Seton Hall, finished with an 11-4 mark at home this season. PC also was 4-4 in league home contests.
