

CAMP INFORMATION

This camp is designed for the softball player from beginner to experienced. It is open to players from age 8 to incoming college freshmen. The camp will be run by the Providence College Softball Staff in conjunction with a camp staff, including college players and coaches. The camp will be a general skills camp where players will learn the fundamentals of pitching, catching, infield and outfield hitting, baserunning, team play and rules of the game.

DIRECTIONS

From Boston and Points North using I-95

Follow I-95 South to Rhode Island Exit 23 (Charles Street). Proceed right onto Charles Street and go 0.2 miles to the first light at Admiral Street. Take a left onto Admiral Street and proceed approximately 1 mile. Take a left onto Huxley Avenue and the field will be on your right.

From New York, Southern Connecticut and Points South

Take I-95 North to Rhode Island Exit 23 (State Offices). Turn right onto Orms Street. After the first light, veer right onto Douglas Avenue (Route 7). Proceed 0.7 miles to the third light on Douglas and make a left-hand turn onto Eaton Street. Proceed about 0.5 miles to the first light and take a right onto Huxley Avenue. The field will be on your left.

From Hartford and Central Connecticut

Take I-84 to Route 2 East. Follow Route 2 East to Norwich, CT and then take I-395 North. Proceed along I-395 North to Route 6 East. Take Route 6 East into Johnston, RI. Proceed along Route 6 East to Route 10 North. Take I-95 North to Rhode Island Exit 23 (State Offices). Turn right onto Orms Street. After the first light, veer right onto Douglas Avenue (Route 7). Proceed 0.7 miles to third light on Douglas and make a left-hand turn onto Eaton Street. Proceed about 0.5 miles to the first light and take a right onto Huxley Avenue. The field will be on your left.

CAMP DIRECTORS



Kerri Jacklets just completed her first season as head coach of the Providence College softball team.

Jacklets guided the Friars to a 29-19-1 overall record, including an 11-11 mark in the BIG EAST, which was good for sixth-place in the conference. The 11 BIG EAST wins were the most by a Friar squad since 1995. In addition, the Friars earned a berth in the BIG EAST Tournament for the first time since 1996.

Jacklets also coached three players who earned All-BIG EAST honors.

Prior to becoming head coach this year, Jacklets spent the 2005 season as an assistant coach with the Friars. She also spent three seasons (2001-04) as an assistant at Brown University. While with the Bears, Jacklets was responsible for overseeing a number of roles, including practice coaching duties with an emphasis on hitting, catching and the outfield. She also was responsible for recruiting, managing budgetary requests, and organizing transportation and other accommodations. In 2004, she helped guide the Bears to the 2004 Ivy League Championship. She coached numerous players who earned Ivy League and Northeast Region honors, including the 2004 Ivy League Pitcher of the Year. In addition to her coaching abilities, Jacklets excels at recruiting. She recruited and coached the Ivy League Rookie of the Year in 2004.

Jacklets enjoyed a stellar career as a catcher at Providence from 1998-2001. She stills ranks second all-time in batting average (.315), fifth in home runs (18) and hits (179). In 2001, she was named to the All-Northeast Region First Team. Jacklets was a four-time BIG EAST Academic All-Star and graduated from PC with a 3.33 GPA in Social Science.

A native of Sayville, N.Y., Jacklets currently resides in Providence, R.I.



Former Seton Hall standout **Laura Taylor** (Hockessin, Del.) joined the Friar softball program assistant coach in February of 2006. The 2005 BIG EAST Player of the Year, Taylor finished her playing career as the top power hitter in school history, as well as one of the top sluggers in NCAA history.

Seton Hall's all-time leader in home runs, Taylor totaled 59 round trippers over her four year career, which is also one of the top-10 figures in NCAA history. In addition, she totaled 180 hits and a school-record 160 RBIs. A three-time All-BIG EAST selection, she also was a three-time All-Northeast Region choice.

A Finance major at Seton Hall, Taylor graduated as a Dean's List member in May of 2005. In the summer of 2005, Taylor signed a professional contract with the NY/NJ Juggernauts of the National Pro Fastpitch League.
