



## PENN STATE MEN'S SOCCER BIG TEN TOURNAMENT HISTORY

The 2015 Big Ten Men's Soccer Tournament will be Penn State's 25th appearance. The Nittany Lions sport a 28-17-5 all-time mark for a .610 winning percentage. The 28 wins are the second most in tournament history, just three behind Indiana.

The 2015 tournament will feature nine teams for the second time along with a campus-centric format after the conference changed the format prior to the 2014 campaign. The quarterfinals will be hosted by the higher four seeds on Sunday, Nov. 8, with the eight and nine seeds playing at the No. 1 seed earlier that weekend.

The semifinals and final will be contested at one site hosted by the highest remaining seed. The semifinals are set for Friday, Nov. 13 and the championship match on Sunday, Nov. 15.

Penn State is 27-31-1 all-time in the tournament with a 22-7-1 record at Jeffrey Field and a 5-23-0 mark in away games.

The Nittany Lions defeated Hartwick at Jeffrey Field before bowing out to No. 9 Syracuse in the second round.

*Penn State forward Jim Stamatis received collegiate soccer's highest honor, when he was named the winner of the 1979 Robert Hermann Trophy as the nation's outstanding player. The senior out of Bethlehem, Pennsylvania capped a standout career with 16 goals and 12 assists for 44 points in 23 games in 1979. He led the Nittany Lions to an 18-4-1 record and the school's first appearance in the NCAA College Cup, where the Lions finished third. Stamatis is Penn State's leading career scorer with 133 points (52 G, 29 A).*

### BOB WARMING

2010-present

**PSU Record: 58-34-11 (.617);**

**Career Record: 441-214-75 (.655)**

Last season, Warming led PSU to its second-straight NCAA Tournament, carrying a 13-6-1 record and tying for second in the Big Ten. In 2013, he led Nittany Lions to a 13-6-2 record, a second straight Big Ten title and the NCAA Sweet 16. Warming won his second-straight Big Ten Coach of the Year honor following the team's Big Ten title in 2012, PSU's first in seven years. In his first year in Happy Valley, Bob Warming, the third winningest active NCAA Division I coach, led Penn State to a 14-8-1 record and to the third round of the NCAA Tournament. The 2010 Nittany Lions featured the nation's leader in goals and points (Corey Hertzog) and assists (Matheus Braga).

### BARRY GORMAN

1988-2009

**Career Record: 266-158-42 (.616)**

Barry Gorman, the program's all-time winningest coach with 266 career victories, led Penn State to three Big Ten Conference Championships, and two Atlantic 10 Conference Championships and earned three NSCAA Regional Coach of the Year awards. Gorman coached seven All-Americans, 22 First Team All-Big Ten honorees, and 21 All-Region honorees.

### WALTER BAHR

1974-87

**Career Record: 185-66-22 (.718)**

During his distinguished career, Bahr led Penn State to 12 NCAA Championship appearances and to an Atlantic 10 Conference Championship. He was named Regional and National Coach of the Year in 1979 and is an NSCAA Hall of Fame inductee. Bahr coached five All-American selections, two Soccer America Freshman All-America honorees, a Hermann Award winner, two Olympians, and 16 All-Mid-Atlantic Region honorees.

### HERB SCHMIDT

1968-73

**Career Record: 38-21-8 (.627)**

Schmidt guided Penn State teams that earned four NCAA Championship field berths in his five year tenure, including the program's first appearance in an NCAA title game (1970). He coached six All-Mid-Atlantic Region honorees during his career.

### KEN HOSTERMAN

1953-67

**Career Record: 72-60-5 (.544)**

Hosterman owns Penn State's third longest head coaching tenure. He coached two consecutive ISFA championship teams, three All-America selections, three Olympians, and three All-Mid-Atlantic Region players.

### BILL JEFFREY

1926-52

**Career Record: 153-24-29 (.813)**

Penn State's sixth head coach, Jeffrey is Penn State's all-time coaching leader by percentage and possesses the program's longest coaching tenure at over a quarter of a century. His teams outscored their opponents 689-184 and captured seven ISFA championships. His 1933 team posted Penn State's first perfect season, amassing a 6-0-0 record. Jeffrey led the U.S. Soccer team to a momentous 1-0 win over England in the 1950 World Cup.

### RALPH LEONARD

1924-25

**Career Record: 9-1-1 (.864)**

Over Leonard's two seasons in leading the program, the Lions outscored their opponents by an impressive 29-6 margin.

### LARRY LONGHURST

1923

**Career Record: 4-0-1 (.900)**

Longhurst coached for just one year; a season in which his Lions were unbeaten and scored 20 goals in just five games.

### HUGH KEENLEYSIDE

1922

**Career Record: 2-0-2 (.750)**

Led the Lions to an undefeated season in his lone year as head coach.

### COMPTON PACKENHAM

1921

**Career Record: 2-0-1 (.833)**

His 1921 Lions held opponents to just two goals.

### JIM CROWELL

1916-17, 1919-20

**Career Record: 11-0-2 (.923)**

Penn State's first soccer coach. Unbeaten in his tenure, Crowell's Lions held the record for highest goal tally in a season (24) until 1927.
