

Meet the Instructors

Denise St. Pierre is in her 18th year as head coach of the Penn State Women's Team after serving five years as an assistant coach for the men's and women's teams. In 1992, she was recognized as the East Regional coach of the year. Her teams as well as individual players have qualified to play at the NCAA regional and national championships. Denise started her career with the Nittany Lions as a player and is a 1983 PSU alumna.



Denise is a Class A member of the PGA and director of Penn State golf instruction. Denise was selected as one of Golf for Women's top 50 instructors. Additionally, she was chosen to coach US Women's teams at the US vs. Japan Tournament in 1999 and the 2004 and 2006 World University Games in Thailand and Italy, respectively. Denise has been involved at an administrative level with the National Golf Coaches Association (NGCA). Having previously served as secretary and chair of the NCGA education committee, she was elected by her peers to serve as President of the NCGA from 2004–2006.

Greg Nye is in his 15th year as the head coach for the Penn State Men's Golf team. He is a Class A member of the PGA and has experience as a club professional, men's and women's golf coach and is highly regarded by his peers as an accomplished instructor of the game.

Mary Kennedy-Zierke is the Director of Instruction at Toftrees Resort in State College. Mary was the Head Coach of both the Men's and Women's Golf teams at Penn State for 10 years. A former mini-tour professional and voted as a top 50 instructor by Golf for Women magazine, Mary brings 25 years of experience teaching all levels of players.

Sara Doell is in her third year as the Assistant Women's Golf Coach at Penn State. She is a Class A Member of the LPGA Teaching and Club Professional Division. Sara graduated from Penn State in 2000 and is an alumna of the Penn State Women's Golf team.
