

## 2006-07 Penn State Women's Golf Results and Statistics

### Cougar Classic

After the three rounds of the Cougar Classic, the Nittany Lions finished in a disappointing 19th place out of the 20 competing teams.

Senior Christin Pacacha shot par for the third round and regained the lead for the Nittany Lions with a final score of 227. Sophomore Katherine Murphy shot 79 on the final day of the Cougar Classic, giving her a three-round score of 230.

Freshmen Giulia Carando and Brianna Malcolmsen competed in their first collegiate tournament finishing with scores of 241 and 244, respectively.

Notre Dame finished in first place with a score of six-over 870. Tennessee finished one stroke behind in second place with a score of 871. Individually, Notre Dame's Lisa Maunu finished in first place with a score of 210.

### Lady Northern Invitational

After two days and three rounds of the Lady Northern Invitational, the Nittany Lions finished in 12 place. The team shot 309 in the third round and finished the tournament with a score of 69-over 933.

Freshman Brianna Malcolmsen shot three-over 75 to lead the Nittany Lions after round one on Saturday. Sophomore Katherine Murphy shot 79 in the first round and 77 in the second round to lead the Nittany Lions into the third and final round. In round three, Murphy shot four-over 76 to finish on top for the Nittany Lions with a final score of 232. Senior Sara Lester finished only two strokes behind Murphy.

Senior Christin Pacacha improved her score from round one and shot 76 in the second round and 77 in the final round for a final score of 239. Megan Padua was one stroke behind with a score of 240.

After a close competition between Kent State and Michigan State, Kent State came out on top to win the tournament with a three-round score of 14-over 878. Michigan finished with a score of 883. Individually, Kira Meixner of Kent State won the Lady Northern with a score of four-under 212. Michigan State's Laura Kueny was the runner-up with a score of one-under 215.

The Nittany Lions shot a three-round score of 935 to finish the Nittany Lion Invitational in third place. Princeton, with a score of 910, finished the competition in first place.

Senior Christin Pacacha and sophomore Katherine Murphy led the Nittany Lions with tied tenth place finishes and scores of 232. Freshman Brianna Malcolmsen finished the competition only two strokes behind in a tied 15 th place. Sara Lester and Megan Padua were also a part of the Nittany Lion team. Senior Emily Pavesich and freshmen Guilia Carando and Kelly Osborne competed as individuals.

Lauren Bavaird of Western Michigan University was the top finisher of the tournament with the three-round score of 223. Princeton's Susannah Aboff, who led the competition after the first two rounds, finished in second place, only one stroke behind Bavaird.
