

**Indiana Intercollegiate Championships**  
**Purdue University**

**Tentative Race Times:** 3:30PM Women's 6K Championship, 4:15PM Men's 8K Championship, 5:00PM Women's 6K Open, 5:45PM Men's 8K Open

**Eligibility:** Open to Indiana colleges and universities only. A maximum of nine runners per school may run in the championship races, all others may run in the open race. Unattached runners may also run in the open race.

**Entry Information:** Entry will be handled on Direct Athletics (search for Indiana Intercollegiate Championships on website)

Entries will close on Monday, September 11th at 12:00pm

Each team will be allowed to race up to nine athletes in the championship race and the entries for the open race are unlimited.

**Entry Fee:** \$100 per team, \$20 per unattached (men's and women's teams are charged separately) Checks can be made out to **Purdue University** with a notation for **Indiana Intercollegiate Cross-Country Meet**

**Packet Pickup:** Packet pickup will take place at the large tent on the left side as you enter the course from the parking lot. Packet pickup will take place from 1:00P to 3:00P.

**Timing:** Timing information will be provided within the final meet information packet to be sent out in August.

**Results:** Will be available after the completion of all races. Results will also be posted on the Purdue Sports website immediately after the meet. [www.purduesports.com](http://www.purduesports.com) Please check this same website for updates and changes as the meet approaches. There will also be hard copies of the results available at the finish line after the completion of the awards ceremonies.

**Awards & Scoring:** Team awards will be given to the first place team in both the Big State and Little State divisions. Individual awards will be given to the top ten finishers in the Big State and to the top twenty finishers in the Little State. The meet will be scored two ways. First, all participating schools will be scored to determine the Big State results. Secondly, all non-Division I teams will be scored to determine the Little State order.
