### GAME #6 • POSTGAME NOTES

**Series Notes:**

- This was the fifth meeting all-time between Iowa State and Purdue and first since 2007. The Boilermakers lead the series 3-2.

**PURDUE [No. 4 seed] POSTGAME NOTES**

**Team Notes:**

- Purdue advanced to the Sweet 16 for the 10th time in program history and first time since 2010, while improving to 37-28 all-time in NCAA Tournament games.
- The Boilermakers shot 48.4 percent for the game, improving to 17-2 on the season when shooting at least 48 percent.
- Purdue held a lead for nearly 39 minutes of the game, building a game-high 19-point lead with 14:23 left in the game.
- After Iowa State took its only lead of the game (73-71), the Boilermakers used a 7-0 run and never looked back.
- The Boilermakers improved to 20-1 when leading at halftime.

**Individual Player Notes:**

- Caleb Swanigan recorded his fifth straight double-double (20 pts, 12 rebs) to extend his Big Ten double-doubles record to 28.
- With his four assists, Vincent Edwards became the second player in school history with 1,000 pts, 500 rebs and 300 asts.
- Vincent Edwards added a team-high 21 points and 10 rebounds for his third double-double of the season.
- Isaac Haas added 14 points off the bench, sparking a 23-5 advantage in bench points for Purdue.

**IOWA STATE [No. 5 seed] POSTGAME NOTES**

**Team Notes:**

- Iowa State finished its season 24-11 overall and is now 20-19 overall in 19 appearances in the NCAA Tournament.
- The Cyclones erased a 19-point second-half deficit to take their only lead of the game at 73-71 with 3:11 left.
- ISU shot 54.8 percent in the second half and an even 50 percent for the game.

**Individual Player Notes:**

- Deonte Burton scored a game-high 25 points, the fifth time this season the senior has scored at least 25 points or more.
- Monte Morris dished out a game-high nine assists, the ninth time this season he's finished with at least nine in a game.
- Burton (25), Matt Thomas (20), and Morris (18) combined for 63 of Iowa State's 76 points.
- Nazareth Mitrou-Long was held to a single-digit point total for just the fifth time in 35 games this season.
