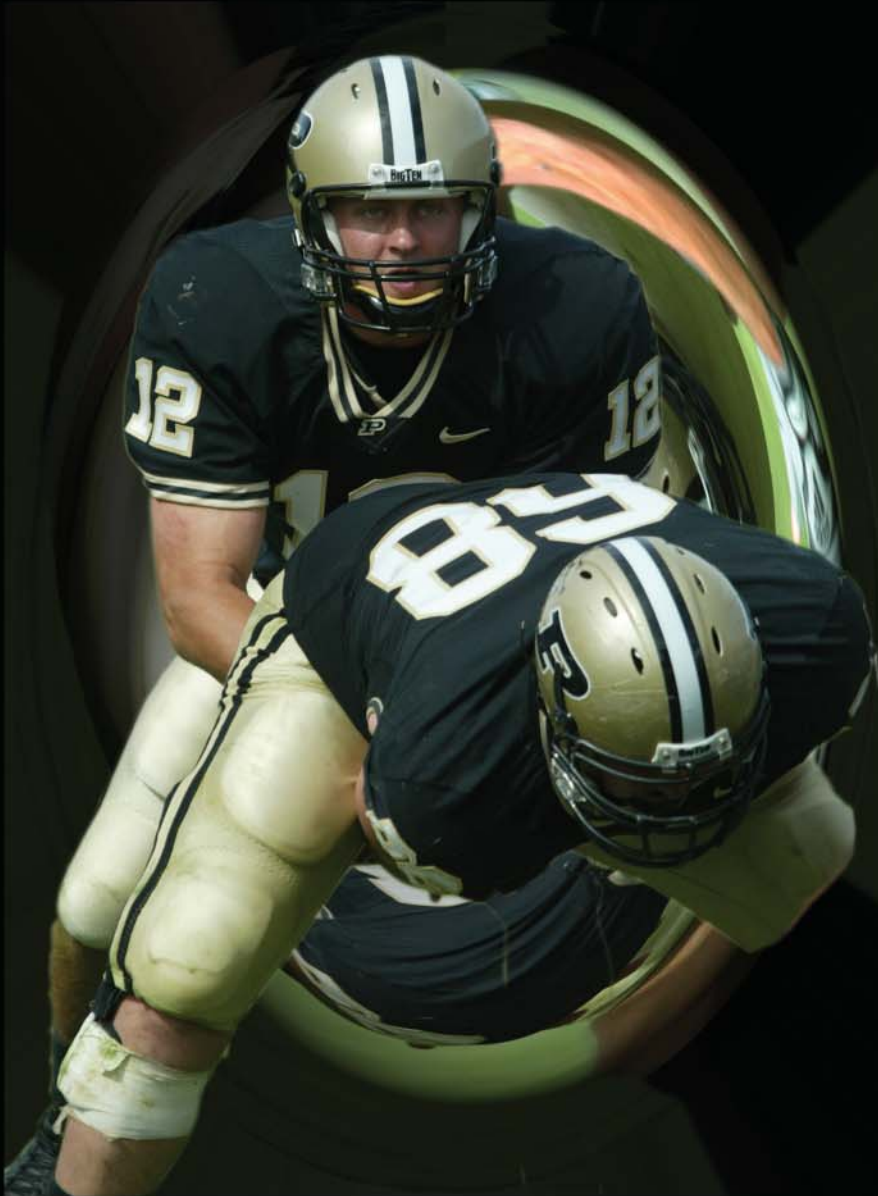

Curtis Painter enters his senior season ranked among the top 10 in four offensive categories in the Big Ten career records book.

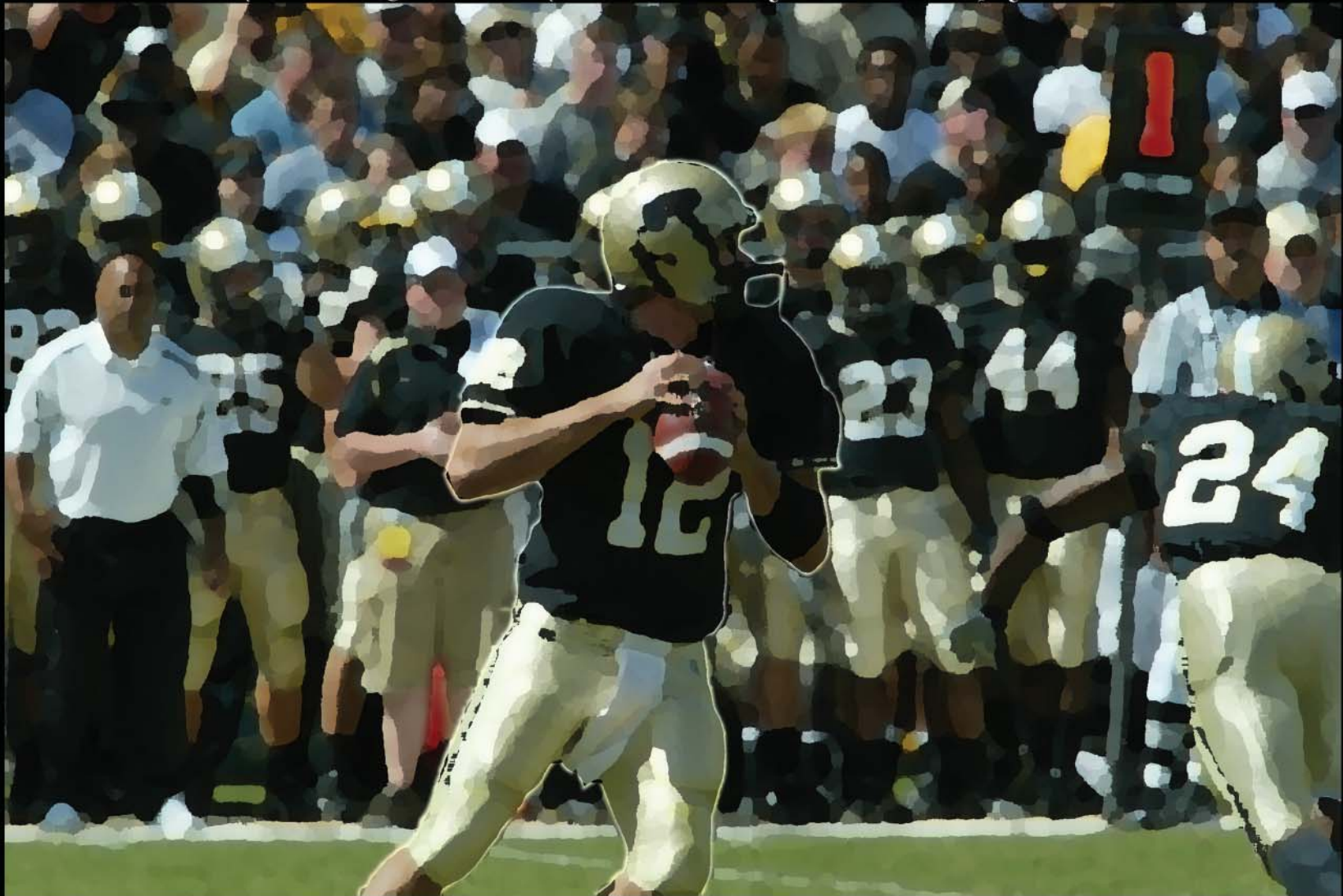

*Did You Know?*

*In 2007, Curtis Painter threw for 3,846 yards, completing 356 passes, and 29 touchdowns, which rank fourth-, second- and third-most in a season in school history. The 6-4, 230-pound Painter also ranked 12th nationally in passing yards per game with 295.9 and 18th in total offense with 294.3, and tied the Big Ten season record for passing attempts with 569.*

## Did You Know?

Painter ranks among the Purdue top 10 career lists in eight different offensive categories:

- Completion percentage (2nd with .599)
- 300-yard passing games (2nd with 10)
- Passing attempts (4th with 1,269)
- Completions (4th with 760)
- Passing yards (4th with 8,763)
- Passing touchdowns (4th with 54)
- Total offense (4th with 9,101 yards)
- Passing efficiency rating (6th with 126.4)

If Painter puts up numbers comparable to his 2007 season, he should own the Purdue and Big Ten records for passing attempts, completions, passing yards and total offense by year's end.

Former Boilermaker Drew Brees (1997-2000) currently boasts the Purdue and Big Ten records in each category.

Curtis Painter led Purdue to a 51-48 Motor City Bowl victory over Central Michigan on Dec. 26, 2007. He threw for a school record 546 yards on 35 of 54 passing with three touchdowns, while racking up 540 total yards in the contest en route to Most Valuable Player honors. The bowl game was Purdue's 10th in the last 11 years under head coach Joe Tiller.
