Rice At C-USA Championship Owls Play Wednesday at 12:30 pm

The Rice baseball team (24-29-2 overall and 12-15-2 in Conference USA) is back to defend its 2017 league title at *The First, A National Banking Association C-USA Championship* beginning this Wednesday through Sunday (May 23-27) in Biloxi, Miss. The Championship returns to MGM Park, the minor league home of the Milwaukee Brewers' AA affiliate Biloxi Shuckers. The event features the league's top eight teams in two Omaha-style double-elimination brackets. The winner of the Championship earns the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament, which begins next week at 16 regional sites across the country.



Rice Meets Louisiana Tech In C-USA's Opening Round

Rice earned the No 7 seed of the Championship and plays No. 2 seed Louisiana Tech (38-18 overall, 21-9 C-USA) on Wednesday at 12:30 pm. The Owls then face either No. 3 seed Florida Atlantic (36-19, 19-11) or No. 6 seed FIU (26-26, 15-13) on Thursday at either 9 am (loser's bracket) or 4 pm (winner's bracket). The Championship Final of the 23rd annual tournament will be just one game on Sunday beginning at 1 pm.

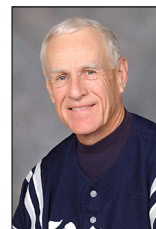

National Postseason Streak At 23-Straight

Rice baseball's 23-straight appearances in the NCAA Tournament is the third-longest active streak in the nation. Three of the country's top four streaks of making the NCAA Tournament are all of the active variety. In 2017 Florida State made the field for the 40th-consecutive year, while Cal State Fullerton made it in for the 26th-straight year.

Head Coach Wayne Graham

Four-time national coach of the year and 2012 College Baseball Hall of Fame inductee **Wayne Graham** (Texas, 1970) is in his 27th season at Rice. The 2018 campaign marks his 38th year as a collegiate head coach... He is now **1,171-526-2** with the Owls (691-200-1 at home, 370-251-1 on the road and 110-75 at neutral sites). His Rice winning percentage is .690, the best in school history. Another way of looking at Graham's .690 win percentage is that it is the equivalent of a major league team winning 111 games in a single year... Graham is **37-11 vs. Louisiana Tech** (24-3 at home, 11-7 road, 2-1 neutral); **12-5-1 vs. FAU** (5-3-1 at home, 4-2 road, 3-0 neutral); **17-6 vs. FIU** (7-3 at home, 9-2 road, 1-1 neutral)... Under Graham, the Owls clinched another postseason bid in 2017, making 23-straight seasons for Rice to earn a NCAA appearance. The Blue & Gray has advanced into the NCAA tournament in 1995-96-97-98-99-00-01-02-03-04-05-06-07-08-09-10-11-12-13-14-15-16-17. The 2003 bid culminated with the Owls' first national championship... Rice played in the 1994-95-96 Southwest Conference tournaments (winning the final league title in '96), won the 1997-98-99 WAC tournaments, shared the 2000 WAC title with San Jose State before winning the 2001-02-03-04-05 titles outright. He won (or shared) C-USA regular season crowns in 2006, 2007, 2008, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015, as well as the C-USA tournament championships in '06, '07, '09, '11, '13, '14 and '17... Graham was named the WAC Coach of the Year in 1998, '99, '02 and the Co-Coach of the Year in '03. He was named the Keith LeClair C-USA Coach of the Year in '06, his first year in the league, and again in '07, '08, '10 and '11... Rice has seven appearances in the NCAA College World Series, all under Graham (1997, '99, '02, '03, '06, '07, '08)... Graham has led the Owls to number-one rankings for seven weeks during the 1999 season, for six weeks during the '01 campaign, two weeks in '02, six weeks in 2003 (the last of which established some staying power), three weeks in 2004, 12 weeks in 2006 and five weeks in '07... Graham's San Jacinto Gators dominated the NJCAA World Series in Grand Junction, Colo., in the 1980s, winning five national titles in six years (1985-86-87, 89-90)... The Austin American-Statesman named Graham its SWC Coach of the Year in '95 after he led the Owls to their first NCAA tournament appearance... Collegiate Baseball was especially cognizant of Graham's efforts at San Jac. He was named the newspaper's Coach of the Decade for all levels in the 1980s after winning those five junior college national titles, and CB tabbed him the NJCAA Coach of the Century... He was named the 2007 Division I college Coach of the Year by FieldTurf... One of the few current collegiate head coaches to have played in the major leagues (N.Y. Mets in 1963, Philadelphia in 1964), Graham is aided by assistant coaches **John Pope** (Rice, 1990, Jones College; second year), **Paul Janish** (Rice, 2004; first year), and **Jordan Kopycinski** (Texas State, 2010; first year).



1,746 Collegiate Wins • A Baseball Odyssey

Wayne Graham owns 1,171 Division I wins at Rice, but his career victories tally to 1,746 when you include his 11 years at San Jacinto North College where he won five national championships. Graham's overall "*collegiate record*" is 1,746-638-2 in a coaching career that began in 1981. (He has 37 years completed. The 2018 season is his 38th of coaching college-age players).

Coach Graham announced Rice's starting pitcher for the first game of the C-USA Championship as sophomore right-hander **Matt Canterino** (6-4, 3.03). Coach Graham will announce the remaining pitchers at a later time.

Last Time Out: Rice Splits Twinbill At FIU; Series Finale Rained Out

MIAMI, Fla. – The Rice baseball team split its Conference USA double-header at FIU by the scores of 6-2 in game one and 6-8 in the nightcap, completing a seven-hour day of baseball Friday evening in Miami. With the game one win and other league outcomes the Owls officially clinched a spot in the C-USA Championship Tournament... It might even be more accurate to say Rice slammed its way Biloxi where the team can defend its 2017 league title. Down 2-1 to start the ninth inning of game one, the Owls rallied for five unanswered runs - four on the strength of a grand slam home run by true freshman and nearby Palmetto Bay, Fla., native Luis Aviles that vaulted the Blue & Gray to the 6-2 final... Rice first rallied for a single run to tie the game. Another south Florida native playing in his home state, Dominic DiCaprio, started it off by lining a one-out single up the middle. Trei Cruz followed with a walk and Andrew Dunlap was hit by a pitch to load the bases. Chace Sarchet drew a walk to force in the tying run, 2-2... It took until the ninth for Owls to pull even on the scoreboard, but the team wasn't quite finished. Rice head coach Wayne Graham made a move to for a pinch-hitter, calling on Aviles who had only logged 25 official at bats all year. Aviles did not waste any time, and promptly hit the first pitch he saw well past the wall in left field. His first career round-tripper, in front of his family and some hometown friends, put Rice in front 6-2... The Blue & Gray held on for the win. Paired with some scoreboard watching of other C-USA outcomes from around the league the Owls were Biloxi-bound... With the momentum of winning the series-opener, the Owls went right to work for a pair of runs in the top of the first inning game two. Rice worked out of a bases-loaded situation in the bottom of the first, but could not hold-off the Panthers in the second. FIU scored four runs on five singles and two hit batsmen... The Owls came right back with a run in the third to make it 4-3, but the Panthers answered with a score in the bottom of the inning and stretched the margin to 8-3 with a three-run sixth... Rice continued fight and rallied for three runs in the top of the eighth thanks to a big RBI double by Andrew Dunlap. FIU ended the threat and retired the Owls in the ninth for the 8-6 final... Saturday's series finale was canceled due to weather conditions.

Here's Who's Hot

Senior first baseman **Chace Sarchet** has put together a solid stretch of games. He is now 9-for-his-last-22 (.409) with a home run and a double for a .591 on-base percentage. He also has six RBI and five runs scored in the last seven games. Sarchet has also drawn three walks and been hit by a pitch for a .481 on-base percentage... Junior designated hitter/catcher **Dominic DiCaprio** continues to battle his way back from being sidelined earlier in the season. He's now 5-for-16 (.313) with a home run and a double (.563 SLG%) over the last five games. DiCaprio has also drawn three walks and been hit by a pitch (.450 OB%)... If you are only as good as your most-recent game, the Owl trio of **Ford Proctor** (3-for-5, one double), **Trei Cruz** (2-for-3, two doubles, two RBI), and **Ryan Chandler** (2-for-4, two runs, one RBI) are all in a good spot heading into the Biloxi.

Career Climber

Ryan Chandler recently broke the Rice school record for official career at bats and now has 943 heading into the C-USA Tournament. Chandler also started his 240th career game last weekend and now needs two more starts to move into second place at Rice ahead of **Austin Davis** (2001-2004). On the base hits list, Chandler has 279 and is six away from tying **Lance Berkman** (1995-1997) for fourth all-time at Rice. Chandler also has 55 career doubles which is tied for ninth all-time with **Brian Friday** (2005-2007). The duo of **Joe Savery** and **Rick Hague** share the next spot on the Rice list with 56 doubles.

After a one year absence Rice reclaimed a conference championship in 2017 by winning the C-USA Tournament title in Biloxi, Miss. From 1996 to 2015 the Owls had won or shared a total of 20-straight conference championships (including either regular season and/or conference tournament titles). The streak covered membership in three different leagues beginning with the Southwest Conference (1996), to nine seasons in the Western Athletic Conference (1997-2005) and now 11 C-USA titles from 2006-2017. This & That

Rice enters the C-USA Tournament with an RPI of No. 99 in the nation. The Owls were also listed as having the 31st-toughest schedule in the nation, and the toughest among all Conference USA schools, according to *Warren-Nolan.com*. Another site, *MasseyRatings.com*, meanwhile ranked the Owls' 2018 slate as the 28th-hardest in Division I. When recognizing the team's tough schedule, also consider that the Owls had nine losses by two runs or less, and were without stars **Dominic DiCaprio**, **Ricardo Salinas**, **Addison Moss** and **Dane Acker** for extended parts of the 2018 season... Rice's current .455 win percentage is just two games behind the same point where it was through 55 games last season... The Owls average more than a run per game in the eighth inning (56 total runs)... For as big a game as true freshman **Trei Cruz** had driving-in a career-high five runs against Columbia (March 14) he's still another *five RBI short* of the ten RBI his father, Owl All-America **Jose Cruz Jr.**, had in his best Rice game vs. Texas State in 1995.

Canterino & Proctor Lead Five Owls To All-Conference Honors

BILOXI, Miss. – On the eve of the 2018 Conference USA Baseball Championship Matt Canterino and Ford Proctor led a total of five Rice Owls to earn all-conference recognition, the C-USA office announced on Tuesday (May 22)... Canterino and Proctor were named to the C-USA First Team at pitcher and infielder, respectively. Senior out-fielder Ryan Chandler was named to the C-USA Second Team. Rice rookies Dan Acker and Trei Cruz selected to the league's All-Freshman team. The Owls trained under the development program of Rice head coach Wayne Graham. All the C-USA award honorees were selected on a vote of the conference's head coaches, sports information directors and a media representative who covers each program... Just 24 hours before Canterino was also named to C-USA All-Academic Team for maintaining 3.99 grade point average. The 'Friday night ace' of the Owls' pitching staff is 6-4 with a 3.03 ERA while holding opposing hitters to a composite .190 batting average. A native of Southlake, Texas, Canterino leads the team, and is tied for 17th in the nation, with 111 strikeouts in

89.0 innings of work... Steady as ever, junior shortstop Ford Proctor ranked among the team and C-USA leaders in batting average (.346), hits (75), home runs (7), RBI (37), runs scored (38), walks (36), slugging percentage (.512) and on-base percentage (.432). He owns a team-leading 24 multi-hit games, including two games with a season-best four-hits. During one stretch the standout from Beaumont, Texas, reached base 21 games in a row. On the defensive side Proctor has turned or started 29 of the team's 42 double plays... Not only has veteran Ryan Chandler been a fixture in the lineup starting each of the program's 240 games in centerfield dating back to his freshman year of 2015, the 2018 has been his best yet. Heading into the C-USA Tournament he leads the Owls in hits (77), batting average (.347) runs scored (41), triples (3) and steals (13). Not only does the former prep star from Houston Strake Jesuit defensively cover a wide range of ground in centerfield, he has showcased his arm by throwing out runners on the bases five different times... The Owls' true freshman tandem of Acker and Cruz have both had exceptional debut seasons at the Division I level. Cruz has maintained a .279 batting average starting 54 of the team's games at second base. In addition to sharing the team lead with 13 doubles, the former Bellaire Episcopal star has knocked five home runs and maintained a .436 slugging percentage. He leads the Owls with 43 RBI and has drive-in two or runs in a game a team-best 11 times. Acker meanwhile bounced back from being sidelined earlier in the year to post a 4-2 record and 4.42 ERA in 36.2 innings on the mound. The Brenham, Texas, native appeared in 15 games overall and worked his way into three starting assignments.

Canterino Named To C-USA All-Academic Team

Sophomore Matt Canterino has been named to the 2018 inTouch Credit Union Conference USA Baseball All-Academic Team, the league office announced on Monday, May 21... Canterino is one of just 11 student-athletes C-USA recognized Monday for balancing play on the baseball field with academic success. The 'Friday night ace' of the Owls' pitching staff was 6-4 with a 3.03 ERA while holding opposing hitters to a composite .190 batting average. The Southlake, Texas, native leads the team, and is tied for 17th in the nation, with 111 strikeouts in 89.0 innings of work, all while maintaining a 3.99 grade point average as a Mechanical Engineering major. Not only is Canterino a C-USA Academic Medalist and member of the C-USA Academic Honor Roll, he has also been named to the Rice President's Honor Roll (a special designation for the University's elite students and not specific to student-athletes).

New At Reckling Park! Bixby Batting Barn; New Fan "Roost"

Rice's Reckling Park, the best place to watch and play a college game, is better than ever this season after its most-recent renovations that benefit both the student-athletes and fans. In the on-going commitment to player development, the enclosed **Bixby Batting Barn** down the right-field line has been upgraded with expansion and remodeling. The final phase of the upgrade is the installment of large color banners showcasing the program's 37 former Owls who have gone on to play in the major leagues. The true-blue fans meanwhile will be sure to flock to the permanent new 'Roost' on the first base side for in-game hospitality. The fully-air conditioned facility features its own restrooms, lobby and service area, as well as a tiered outdoor patio that is close to the action but safe with newly installed netting.

Rice Owls On The Coaching Staff

There are two former Rice Owls on **Wayne Graham's** 2018 coaching staff. Rice graduate and two-time Texas High School Baseball Coach of the Year **John Pope** (Jones College, 1990) is in his second season as an assistant coach at his alma mater. He played his final two collegiate seasons at Rice in 1988 and 1989 and went on to log 19 years of coaching in the high school ranks in the greater Houston area. Former major leaguer and 2003 Rice National Champion **Paul Janish** joined the Owls' baseball staff as an assistant coach in August of 2017. Janish (Wiess College) played professionally the last 13 years with nine seasons in the major leagues, most recently in 2017 with the Baltimore Orioles... "It is a unique challenge to be a student-athlete at Rice," coach Graham explained. "I like having former Rice players on the coaching staff who have already been through the experience. It is important our players are able to relate to the staff in that way."

Rookie Ball!

There are some Rice newcomers to keep an eye on in 2018. Third baseman **Braden Comeaux** joins the Owls as a sophomore transfer from LSU-Eunice, the No. 2 junior college program in the nation. Comeaux started 55 games for the Bengals primarily at shortstop, where he batted .377 with 53 runs scored, 49 RBI, a .447 on-base percentage and 30 stolen bases. True freshman second baseman **Trei Cruz** is a highly honored switch-hitting prep standout from nearby Episcopal High School who was selected in the 33rd round of the 2017 Major League Draft by the hometown Astros. Cruz is a Rice University legacy player as his father, **Jose Cruz Jr.** (1993-1995), and uncle, **Enrique Cruz** (2001-2003) both played for coach Graham.

Rice Since 1999

Using the 1999 season as the starting point (the year the NCAA expanded the postseason tournament field to 64 teams with the current Super Regional format), Rice baseball has maintained one of the nation's top win percentages over the last 19 years. Here's a closer look at the country's winningest programs from 1999-2017 (**note: this listing will not be updated to include games played in 2018**):
