THE LATEST

▶ Starting four freshmen and playing with just two returning scholarship players, the Spiders are 3-0 having pulled off a pair of victories when they trailed by seven points in the second half, and leading by as many as 20 in the win over Longwood on Monday.

▶ The Spiders are off to just the 20th 3-0 start in 95 seasons of Richmond basketball, and just the fifth in the last 48 years. Richmond's last 3-0 start came in 2003-04, the last time the Spiders went to the NCAA Tournament. Richmond will be looking for its first 4-0 start since the 1985-86 NCAA team started the year 8-0.

▶ When the Spiders score 58 points or more they are 13-0 under second-year head coach **Chris Mooney**. Richmond has scored over 60 points in all three games this season and over 70 points twice, equaling the number of times the Spiders broke 70 points last year.

▶ Five different Richmond freshmen have scored in double-figures through three games. Freshman **Dan Geriot** has scored in double figures in all three games, while freshmen **David Brewster**, **Ryan Butler** and **Brian Morris** have reached double-figures twice. Freshman **David Gonzalvez** reached double-figures with 12 points vs. Longwood. Senior **Peter Thomas** has scored in double digits twice.

▶ Freshman **Dan Geriot** leads the Spiders in scoring through two games, averaging 17.0 per outing. He scored 14 points in the season opener, 18 points against American and 19 vs. Longwood.

▶ Richmond shot an impressive 71.8 percent (28-of-39) from the floor and 68.8 percent (11-of-16) from 3-point land vs. Longwood.

▶ The Spiders are shooting 50 percent from 3-point land through three games (29-of-58).

▶ Richmond has had five different players make a 3-pointer in all three games this season and seven players have made a trey for the Spiders.

▶ Richmond has boasted quite a balanced scoring attack through the first three games. The biggest example of that is in the fact freshman **Brian Morris** reached double-figures in the first two games, but did not even take a shot from the field and scored just two points as the Spiders scored a season-high 83 points in the win over Longwood on Monday.

THE TEAMS

SCOUTING RICHMOND: The Spiders have started four freshmen and six freshmen are averaging at least 12 minutes per game, but that has not stopped Richmond from a 3-0 start. The youngsters have shown the poise of upper-classmen, erasing seven-point second-half deficits in the first two contests and holding off Longwood's comeback bid in the third game. The Spiders are shooting 51.8 percent from the floor on the season, and 50-percent from 3 (29-of-58). The Spiders shot 71.8 percent from the floor vs. Longwood on Monday.
SCOUTING OLD DOMINION: The Monarchs are coming off of a 75-62 victory over then No. 8 ranked Georgetown on Sunday. Old Dominion shot 56 percent from 3-point land (9-of-16) vs. Georgetown, but are shooting just 30.3 percent from behind the arc on the season.

NOTES

WINNING THE CLOSE ONES ►

Richmond is 5-0 in games decided by five points or less and 2-0 in overtime games during second-year head coach Chris Mooney's tenure. The Spiders are a perfect 13-0 when they score 58 points or more under Mooney.

MORRIS VS. MORRIS ►

Richmond freshman **Brian Morris** has three brothers who play or played college basketball and one of them is Old Dominion senior John Morris. As the younger brother, Brian normally came up on the short end of their backyard battles, but will have a chance for some redemption Saturday. Richmond's Morris has started all three games in his rookie year for the Spiders, and has scored in double-figures twice. He finished two assists shy of a triple-double in his first collegiate game (11 points, 10 rebounds, 8 assists) and came two rebounds shy of his second-straight double-double vs. American (15 points, 8 rebounds) making a perfect 4-of-4 shots from 3.

3'S COMPANY ►

Richmond's offense relied heavily on the 3-point shot in 2005-06 as the Spiders took 47.7 percent of their field goal attempts from behind the arc, but shot just 29.5 percent. Richmond did not have the complement of 3-point shooters that thrive in this type of offense, but have added several players who can make the outside shot. That has showed as seven different players have made 3-pointers and the Spiders are shooting 29-of-58 (.500) from behind the arc. Freshman **David Brewster** leads the team with eight 3-pointers in 14 attempts (.571), while freshman **Ryan Butler** is 7-of-13 (.538). Freshman **Brian Morris** and **Jarhon Giddings** have each made four treys, senior **Peter Thomas** is 3-of-4 (.750) from behind the arc, freshman **Dan Geriot** is 2-of-6 (.333) and freshman **David Gonzalez** is 1-of-3 (.333).

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME ►

Richmond will be playing its third-straight home game to start the season Monday. The Spiders play five of their first six games and seven of the first nine in the Robins Center. Eight of the first nine games of the season are in the state of Virginia, as the Spiders first road trip is down route 64 East in Norfolk vs. Old Dominion on Saturday. Richmond is 3-0 this season in the Robins Center and 14-5 in the Robins Center under second-year head coach **Chris Mooney**. The Spiders played 16 home games last season, the second most in the 34 years of the Robins Center, and will play 16 home games again in 2006-07. The Spiders were 11-5 at home last year, marking the 15th season that the Spiders have won 10 or more games in the Robins Center. Richmond is 305-147 (.675) all-time in the arena.

RICHMOND BASKETBALL

NOTES

CAUSING MATCH-UP PROBLEMS ►

Richmond's match-up zone defense led the nation in fewest points allowed for most of last season and finished the year seventh in the country in scoring defense, allowing just 57.8 points per game. The Spiders are allowing 63.0 points through two games, including the overtime contest with East Carolina. The Spiders allowed just 61 points through regulation vs. East Carolina, a team that scored 86 in its season opener. Richmond gave up 67 points for the game and then held American, which had scored 97 points in its previous outing, to 50 points on Friday night. The Spiders have held opponents to 50 points or less 11 times in 32 games under second-year coach **Chris Mooney** and have kept teams from scoring over 60 points 19 times in 33 games. Richmond has allowed over 70 points just twice under Mooney.

LIVING A CHILDHOOD DREAM ►

Red-shirt freshman **Ryan Butler** was injured in the preseason last year and played in two games before shutting it down for the season. Butler, the son of former Spider star **Jeff Butler**, is now a starting guard for the Spiders. Butler made all five of his shots, including three-straight 3-pointers late in the first half on his way to a career-high 16 points in the win over Longwood on Nov. 20. He scored 11 points in the season opener, including a 3-pointer that gave Richmond the lead for good in overtime. Butler also set up fellow freshman Dan Geriot's game-tying 3-pointer at the end of regulation. The 6-foot-6 guard brought the ball up the court and spun on his defender, causing the defender to slip. That drew Geriot's man over and Butler dumped it off to Geriot on the right wing. Butler is averaging 10.7 points per game through three games, having made 7-of-13 3-pointers (.538). Butler, who grew up near campus and starred at nearby Douglas Freeman High, has been coming to games in the Robins Center since he was a young boy.

SPIDERS IN TOP TIER OF A-10 ►

This is Richmond's sixth season in the Atlantic 10 and the Spiders have shown they are one of the league's premier teams. Among the 12 teams in the Atlantic 10 that have completed at least two seasons, Richmond has the third highest winning percentage in conference regular-season play at 56.3 percent (45-35). Temple is first at 74.7 percent (295-100) and Xavier is second at 79.3 percent (122-54).

BLUE COLLAR TO IVY ►

While **Chris Mooney** is an Ivy Leaguer with his degree from Princeton, he grew up in blue-collar Philadelphia, the son of a Greyhound Bus driver. His mother died of cancer when he was 13 and Mooney says he lost himself in basketball at that point, dreaming of becoming a player and a coach. Mooney's background shows in his coaching with his teams' grind-it-out, hard-working style of play.

NOTES

LIKE PLAYER, LIKE COACH ►

Richmond has started four freshmen in its first two games of the season and while "freshmen are freshmen," Richmond head coach knows that freshmen can step right in and contribute. Mooney pulled the rare accomplishment of starting as a freshman for Hall of Fame coach Pete Carril at Princeton. He was the runner-up for Ivy League Rookie of the Year and helped the Tigers to a pair of Ivy League titles and NCAA Tournament appearance.

SUPER SIZED ►

Richmond might have some freshmen a bit on the skinny size but the Spiders do bring a lot of height to the jump circle for tip off. The Spiders start a pair of 6-foot-6 guards (**Ryan Butler** and **Brian Morris**), a 6-5 (**Peter Thomas**) and 6-6 forward (**David Brewster**) and a 6-9 center (**Dan Geriot**). The Spiders also have 6-9 forward **Jarhon Giddings** and 6-11 center **Drew Crank**.

WHO'S PLAYING THE FOUR ►

Do not ask who is playing the power forward or small forward position for Richmond because the Spider coaching staff does not assign that specific a role for a player. Head coach **Chris Mooney** and his staff want "everyone to do everything" and that can lead to lineups that do not follow the traditional point guard, shooting guard, small forward, power forward and center mix. The Spiders play two guards, two forwards and a center.

GERIOT KNOWS ►

The offense Richmond runs is heavily reliant on having a center that can shoot, pass and dribble. Head coach **Chris Mooney** found that in freshman **Dan Geriot**, a native of Springfield, Pa. who ran a similar offense all four years of high school. As Mooney said after the American game, "we run our offense through our center," whether that means getting it to Geriot and the block or at the high post, or even 30-feet from the basket at the top of the key, Geriot will have the ball in his hands a lot for the Spiders.

THE YOUNG AND THE RESTLESS ►

Richmond coach **Chris Mooney** got his first Division I head coaching job at the age of 32, which made him the fourth-youngest coach in the nation two years ago. Even with his youth, don't look for any grizzled veterans on the 34-year-old Mooney's staff. Associate head coach **Mike McKee** is also 34, having spent four seasons with Mooney at Air Force. Thirty-three year-old assistant coach **Kevin McGeehan**, an assistant for Mooney at Landsdale Catholic when the two were just out of college, followed Mooney to Beaver College and rejoined him last year at Air Force. Assistant coach **Carlin Hartman**, who is in his second year with Mooney, is 34. Directors of basketball operations **Jamal Brunt** and **Rob Jones** are 26 and 28, trainer **Jeff Gaylord** is 28, and strength & conditioning coach **Jason DeMayo** is 27.

NOTES

AGE IS NOTHING BUT A NUMBER ►

When Richmond athletic director **Jim Miller** hires coaches, he definitely does not let age dissuade him. Miller has hired the second youngest combination of basketball and football coaches in the nation behind only Western Kentucky. Mooney is 34, women's basketball coach **Michael Shafer** is also 34 and football coach **Dave Clawson** is the eldest of the bunch at 39.

LIKE FATHER, LIKE SON ►

Richmond red-shirt freshman **Ryan Butler** and his father **Jeff Butler** are the second father-son duo to play for the Spiders, joining **Pat DiServio** (1981-83) and **Tony DiServio** (1945-47). Jeff Butler was a star for the Spiders from 1975-77, leading the team in scoring both seasons. He averaged 14.3 points per game in 1975-76 and 16.3 points per game in 1976-77. Jeff Butler was later an assistant coach for the Spiders under Hall of Fame coach **Dick Tarrant**, who regularly attends games in the Robins Center.

WALK THIS WAY ►

Walk-ons will continue to play a prominent role in the Richmond men's basketball program in 2006-07 as freshman **Kevin Hovde** is averaging 12.3 minutes per game through the first three contests and sophomore walk-on **Duncan McLean** is averaging 10.3 minutes per game. Hovde was recruited by some Division I schools, but his sister attends Richmond and he liked the campus so much that he decided to join the program as a walk-on. McLean had plans to walk-on to the Richmond men's soccer team, but ended up on the hoops squad, playing in 29 of 30 games last season and averaging 13 minutes per game. Senior captain **Peter Thomas** came to Richmond as a walk-on and was awarded a scholarship before last season, when he led the team in minutes played. Sophomore **Mark McGonigal** is also a walk-on, who played in the first half of the victory over Longwood on Monday.

MOONEY INKS TWO FOR 2007-08 ►

Richmond native **Justin Harper** and **Darryl Cowan Jr.** of Goldsboro, N.C. signed with Richmond during the early signing period. Harper is a 6-foot-8, 195-pound forward from Meadowbrook High in Richmond and Cowan is a 6-3 guard from Eastern Wayne High in Goldsboro, N.C. The two players will join the program for the 2007-08 season. Harper is the second Richmond-area player Mooney has signed, joining **Ryan Butler**. Harper had an impressive summer playing for the Richmond Metro AAU team. His final two choices came down to Richmond and Providence. Harper helped his team to the Central Region Tourney title and a berth in the state quarterfinals. He scored a career-high 22 points with four 3-pointers in a Central Region quarterfinal victory. Cowan was Eastern Wayne High's leading scorer and team MVP as a junior last season. As a junior, Cowan averaged 14 points per game as a junior, shooting 97-percent from the foul throw.

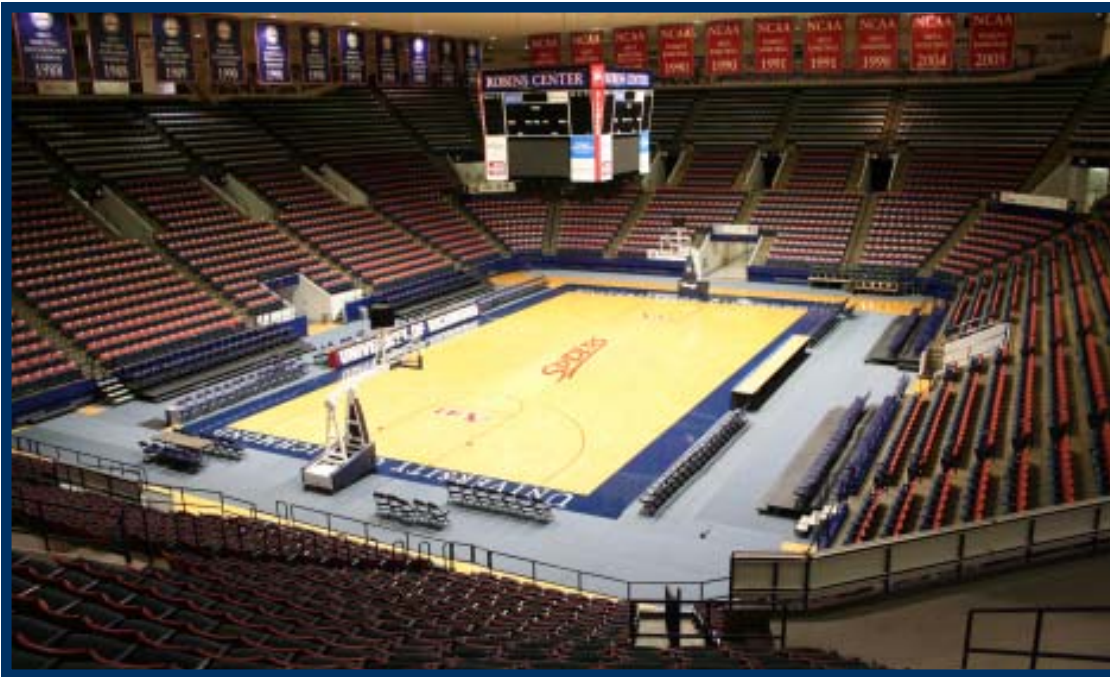
