Structure:

8:00-8:30 Registration

8:30-9:00 Instruction (Led by UR coaching staff)

9:00-12:00 Games to determine pool seeding

(Each team is guaranteed 4 games in round robin format)

12:00-1:00 Lunch (Pizza and Powerade sold on site)

Teams placed in pool based on morning record during break

1:00-4:00 Pool play begins

(Each team is guaranteed 4 more games in pool play)

4:00 "2008 Spider Shootout Champion" is crowned

Rules of Play:

- 40 yard field (regulation width) plus end zone.
- First down can be gained at 25 and 10 yard lines
- All play is 1 hand touch above the waist
- No blocking is allowed
- QB has 4.0 seconds to throw the ball
- No running plays are allowed
- Each TD is worth one point
- Interceptions returned past the line of scrimmage count as a TD
- No conversion attempts after TD's
