THE STAFF

The camp will be under the direction of University of Richmond coaches Leighann Albaugh and Adam Decker. PGA member, Leighann Albaugh is a former Methodist College All-American. Before entering the coaching profession, Leighann taught golf at the Dana Rader Golf School in Charlotte, NC, a top-25 golf school. She mentored under Dana Rader and Julie Cole, who are two of the top LPGA instructors in the nation. She also served as a teaching assistant for Dr. Jim Suttie, who is ranked among Golf Digest's Top-15 greatest teachers and 2000 National teacher of the year.

Coach Decker is a former All-American at Penn State University ('97). After graduating from PSU, he worked at Caves Valley Golf Club in Owings Mills, MD. Following completion of his PGA membership, he played six years of professional golf including Nationwide and PGA Tour events. Decker served as the assistant coach back at his Alma Mater for 1 year, before taking over coaching duties at the University of Richmond. In the 2005 season, he led the Spiders to their first NCAA appearance since 2000. Coaches may also be joined by current UR team members to assist in the operation of camps.
