THE STAFF

The camp will be under the direction of University of Richmond coaches **Jill Briles-Hinton** and **Adam Decker**. Coach Briles-Hinton is one of the few college coaches to be dual members of the LPGA Tour and LPGA Teaching and Club Professional Association. She comes to Richmond after a successful 11 year stint with the University of Florida where she led the Gators to 5 top 10 ten finishes in 6 NCAA Championship appearances. In 2008 she led her team to victory in the SEC Championship and the NCAA East Regional Championship. A former Academic All-American at the University of Miami (FL) Coach Briles-Hinton enjoyed a 12 year career on the LPGA Tour, which included career low rounds of 66 three times. Recipient of many prestigious awards, among them being the Budget Service Award for her contributions to junior golf.

Coach Decker is a former All-American at Penn State University ('97). After graduating from PSU, he worked at Caves Valley Golf Club in Owings Mills, MD. Following completion of his PGA membership, he played six years of professional golf including Nationwide and PGA Tour events. Decker served as the assistant coach back at his Alma Mater for 1 year, before taking over coaching duties at the University of Richmond. In the 2005 season, he led the Spiders to their first NCAA appearance since 2000. He has helped guide 3 student athletes to earn Academic All-American status during his time at Richmond.

Coaches may also be joined by current UR team members and qualified staff to assist in the operation of camps.

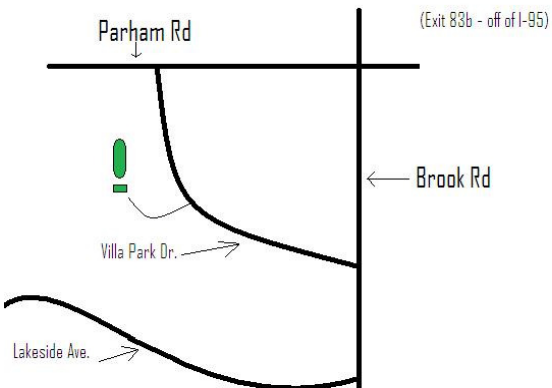
