### About the Broncos

Santa Clara (23-23, 7-8 WCC) continued its run-scoring binge for the second game in a row Tuesday night, pounding out 16 runs on 17 hits to defeat Stanford 16-8. The win was SCU's third win in a row over the Cardinal, and sixth in the last eight meetings with its South Bay rival. Nathan Faulkner went 5-for-5 with two RBIs, while three more Broncos had three hits apiece. Last weekend, SCU dropped two of three to Loyola Marymount in a WCC series, with the two losses each coming by a single run before the Broncos rebounded with an 11-1 win to avert the sweep. Tommy Medica batted 7-for-16 (.438) with nine RBIs and Ryan Conan batted .500 (7-for-14) with three doubles, a homer, and five RBIs last week.

**About Saint Mary's**

Saint Mary's (19-25-1, 1-14) heads into this weekend having lost 17 of their past 20 decisions, including their first 14 WCC contests up until Sunday's 5-2 win over Portland. The Gaels, though, won their second straight game Tuesday night, defeating Patten, 11-3. Joel Staples leads Saint Mary's in the power categories, complementing his .311 average with 10 doubles, six home runs, and 35 RBIs.

**Conan the Destroyer**

Junior first baseman Ryan Conan has stepped up this season as the Broncos' power bat at the ready. This past weekend, Conan crushed a towering home run out of Schott Stadium for his team-leading eighth of the season, a total that is also tied for second in the WCC. Conan put together a strong week in which he batted .500 (7-for-14) with three doubles, a home run, and five RBIs.

**Nate the Great**

After missing the entire 2006 season due to an elbow injury, senior right fielder Nathan Faulkner has put together a productive 2007 campaign at the plate. His efforts are highlighted by his career-best performance May 1 at Stanford, in which Faulkner went 5-for-5 with a double and a pair of RBIs, raising his season average to an even .300. Faulkner also has five doubles and 10 RBIs offensively, and has been a solid presence for the Bronco defense in right field.

**Bringing the Top-Brandt Stuff**

With the Broncos facing a potential sweep Sunday afternoon against Loyola Marymount, redshirt sophomore Donald Brandt took the hill and shutdown the Lions over six and two-thirds strong innings. As the SCU offense put up 10 quick runs, Brandt handled the rest, striking out six batters while allowing only five hits and one run to earn his fourth win of the season.

**Going For Two In A Row**

On the heels of Santa Clara's Daniel Nava winning the WCC batting title in 2006, the Broncos are zeroing in on producing their second straight batting champ, as freshman catcher Tommy Medica leads the loop with a .403 average. The San Jose native's 7-for-16 (.438) showing last week kept him atop the WCC batting leaders, while Medica also improved his already stellar case for WCC Freshman of the Year honors by driving in nine runs

and hitting his WCC-leading fourth triple. His week was highlighted by a 3-for-4, six-RBI effort in the 9-1 win over WAC-leading Fresno State, and a 3-for-4, two-RBI performance against Stanford this past Tuesday.

**Lightin' Up the Scoreboard**

Santa Clara's 16-run output Tuesday against Stanford marked the sixth time this season, and second in as many games, that the Broncos posted a double-digit runs figure. With SCU being 6-0 in those six games in which the team has scored 10+ runs, it shows not only the importance of scoring early and often, but also the contribution of the SCU defense, which has given up only 220 runs this year, fourth in the WCC.

**Leading Off In Style**

Sophomore outfielder Matt Long got the Broncos started off the best way one could, driving a pitch high and deep over the right-field fence for a leadoff home run in the bottom of the first. The quick homer propelled the Bronco offense to three runs in the first, and seven in the second en route to a fast 10-0 lead over LMU.

**2007 Freshman Class Noted Among the Nation's Best**

The Santa Clara University baseball program received an accolade from the *Collegiate Baseball* newspaper as the Broncos' 2006 recruiting class was named one of the Top-40 classes in the nation, coming in at No. 28, tops among West Coast Conference schools. The members of this class, who are currently in their first year on the Mission Campus, will look this spring to help lead the squad to its first WCC title since 1997.

Of the freshman class in 2007, Nathan Garcia (Bellarmine College Prep), Patrick Glenn (Amador Valley HS), Matthew Hiserman (Capistrano Valley HS), Steven Kalush (Aragon HS), Jon Karcich (Serra HS), Geoffrey Klein (Ocean View HS), Tommy Medica (Bellarmine College Prep), Alex Rivers (Tokay

HS) and Dylan Slocum (Paloma Valley HS) make up the California contingent. Tayler Thomas (Salpointe Catholic HS) hails from Arizona and Jeremy Zink (Garfield HS) will come to the Mission Campus from the state of Washington.

**Four Broncos Named to All-WCC 40th Anniversary Team**

The West Coast Conference announced its 40th Anniversary Baseball Team in early January, and four Broncos were named to the 40-man squad. LHP Rich Troedson (1969-72), catcher Troy Buckley (1987-89), RHP Bob Pailthorpe (1992-95), and outfielder Mike Frank (1994-97) were all honored for their achievements on the diamond.

**SCU Baseball Picked to Finish Sixth in WCC Preseason Poll**

The Santa Clara baseball team was selected to finished sixth in the West Coast Conference in the 2007 WCC preseason poll, as selected by the conference coaches. The Broncos were picked to finished behind Pepperdine, San Diego, San Francisco, LMU and Gonzaga. Santa Clara claimed the sixth position with 18 total points.

**Head Coach Mark O'Brien**

Bay Area native Mark O'Brien is in his fourth year as the head baseball coach at Santa Clara University. In his years at SCU, O'Brien has posted a 77-75 mark in the West Coast Conference and three second-place finishes in division play. In only his second season he guided the Broncos to their first winning season since 1997, posting a 31-26 overall record and a 21-9 mark in league play. O'Brien became the school's 35th head coach in the 111 years of the program when he was hired on June 11th, 2001.

During his brief time on the Mission Campus, O'Brien has accomplished things that not many of his predecessors had. He became only the fourth coach in program history to win his 50th game in only his second season as head coach, joining Sal Taormina, Jerry McClain and John Oldham. The win was a savory one as he watched his team defeat the second-ranked Stanford Cardinal by a 2-0 score in Sunken Diamond, giving him his second career win over his former team.

Additionally O'Brien has produced four All-Americans in his first three years as skipper, becoming the first coach in school history to produce four All-Americans in his first three years at the helm. Joey Gomes was a first team selection in 2002 followed by Scott Dierks and

Patrick Overholt in 2003 who earned honorable mention and Freshman All-American honors respectively. Last season, Anthony Rea was a second team honoree. Through out his extensive coaching career, O'Brien has tutored 20 All-Americans.

The three years prior to joining the Broncos, O'Brien served as an assistant coach at Stanford. O'Brien assisted with all aspects of the program and served as the Cardinal's hitting and fielding instructor, as well as the duties of first base coach. During those three seasons Stanford qualified for the College World Series, taking home a third place finish in 1999 and back-to-back national runners-up in '00 and '01. O'Brien's infield led the nation in 2001 with a .977 fielding percentage and was among the top-five in the nation in '99 and '00.

O'Brien has an impressive resume, having served as the head coach at DeAnza Junior College in 1998 and spending four seasons as an assistant coach at Cal Poly in addition to his three years at Stanford.

O'Brien played collegiately at San Jose State from 1991-92 and was the Spartans' team captain in his final year. He was also named an Alaska Summer League All-Star in 1991 after coming to SJSU from St. Francis High School and DeAnza College.

Has started 42 games this season ... batted .500 (7-for-14) with three doubles, five RBIs, and his eighth home run of the year last weekend ... batting .276 and leads team with eight homers and 47 RBIs this season ... tied for second in WCC in RBIs and home runs.

**2B - David Hoffmire (Sr., Novato)**

Has started 39 of the 43 games in which he has appeared this season ... batting .274 on the season, with 14 RBIs and 21 runs scored.

**SS - Jon Karcich (Fr., Belmont)**

Freshman out of Serra High has started 44 games this season ... has hit two home runs and driven in 23 runs so far in his freshman campaign.

**3B - Gabe Alcantar (Jr., San Jose)**

Had three hits and an RBI last weekend at Pepperdine ... second on the team with .333 average (fourth in WCC), 13 doubles and 30 runs scored, and is second with 26 RBIs.

**C - Tommy Medica (Fr., San Jose)**

Leading candidate for WCC Freshman of the

Year honors ... batted .438 (7-for-16) last week with nine RBIs ... had six RBIs in 9-1 win against Fresno State ... leads team and WCC with .403 average ... named WCC Player of the Week, and to *Collegiate Baseball News* National Honor Roll (4/9) after batting .706 (12-for-17) with two triples in four game s from April 9-15.

**RF - Nathan Faulkner (Sr., Temecula)**

Has started 21 of 33 games in which he has appeared this season ... went a career-best 5-for-5 with two RBIs against Stanford on Tuesday ... batting .300 on the year with five doubles and 10 RBIs.

**CF - Matt Long (So., Los Altos Hills)**

Has started all 46 games in the outfield this season ... led off Sunday's game with his second home run of the year ... batting .322 with seven doubles, two homers, and 20 RBIs this season.

**LF - Evan LeBlanc (So., Tucson, Ariz.)**

Sophomore transfer from Yavapai (Ariz.) Community College has started 38 games and is batting .281 on the season ... homered against LMU on Sunday ... has homered twice, and has eight doubles and 15 RBIs on the year.

**DH - Carl Bacon (Sr., Santa Cruz)**

Splits time at catcher and DH ... enjoying a career year so far in 2007 ... drove in a pair of runs with a double on Sunday ... batting a career-best .322 with 56 hits, nine doubles, a homer, and 25 RBIs.

**SP - Matt Wickswat (So., Bellevue, Wash.)**

Sophomore lefty is 6-5 this season with 3.72 ERA ... has struck out 10 batters on three occasions this season ... leads team with 63 strikeouts and 69.2 innings pitched.

Freshman starter struck out a career-high 13 batters April 13 against Gonzaga ... is 3-5 on the year with a 5.56 ERA.
