About the Broncos

Santa Clara (24-26, 8-10 WCC) is currently on a three-game slide, having dropped a close 9-8 decision to the Nevada Wolfpack Tuesday night. The Broncos had opened last week with a 16-8 bashing of the Stanford Cardinal, as Nathan Faulkner went 5-for-5 with two RBIs, and Carl Bacon, Evan LeBlanc, and Tommy Medica each had three hits and two RBIs in the win. But things got tough over the weekend, as the Broncos, following a 5-3 series-opening win over Saint Mary's dropped consecutive one-run decisions, 3-2 and 5-4, to the Gaels, falling in the series. Bacon had a good week at the plate despite the outcomes, batting .538 (7-for-13) with a double and four RBIs, while Jon Karcich hit his third home run of the year at SMC.

About San Diego

Sixth-ranked San Diego (39-14, 16-2) just rose to it's highest ranking in school history after a three-game sweep of San Francisco, solidifying their hold on first place in the WCC. The Toreros, who defeated UC Irvine 4-1 Tuesday night, have been boosted by the power of Shane Buschini, who leads the team with a .366 average, 51 runs, 18 doubles, two triples, 13 home runs, and is second with 53 RBIs. Brian Matusz (9-2, 2.51), Josh Roman-ski (8-1, 2.88), and Matt Couch (8-2, 3.55) pace a USD staff that boasts a combined ERA of 3.36.

Bringing the Stuff

Santa Clara's starting pitching put together a strong weekend of performances in Moraga, although only one starter, Nate Garcia, came away with a win. Garcia gave up only three runs over seven innings and struck out six in SCU's 5-3 win Friday, while Matt Wickswat didn't give up an earned run and struck out 10 batters over 8.1 innings on Saturday, but got a no-decision when SMC tied it in the ninth. Donald Brandt then tossed a great game Sunday, allowing only one run on six hits over six innings and leaving the game with a 4-1 lead, but got a no-decision when SMC scored four runs off the SCU bullpen and won, 5-4.

Making His Case

Catcher Tommy Medica has been pressing his case for WCC Freshman of the Year honors, batting .400 (6-for-15) last week, and going 2-for-3 against Nevada on Tuesday, bringing his average to .399 on the year, tops in the WCC. He could very well also garner Freshman All-America honors, marking the second year in a row that SCU was represented on the Freshman All-America team.

Sizzling At the Plate

Carl Bacon continued his career year this past week, batting .538 (7-for-13) with a double and four RBIs. Bacon's hitting surge has brought his average on the season to .323, fourth on the team. Bacon is also third on the team with 60 hits in 2007.

Power and Defense

While playing solid defense day in and day out for the Broncos with his .951 fielding percentage as a freshman shortstop, Jon Karcich has also shown that he can provide some pop to the SCU lineup. This past weekend at Saint Mary's Karcich hit a three-run bomb on

Sunday to give SCU a 4-1 lead. The homer was his third of the year.

Gettin' Across

Sophomore transfer Evan LeBlanc has made it a habit this season of not only getting on base, but also scoring runs for the Broncos. While hitting .287 on the year, LeBlanc's speed on the basepaths has been beneficial to SCU's success, as his ability to take the extra base has led to him scoring 32 runs on the year, tied for second on the team.

Stop Thief!

Sophomore Matt Long, while continuing to have a productive year with a .325 average, 62 hits, nine doubles, three home runs, and 24 RBIs, has also been a boon to the Broncos on the basepaths. Last weekend, Long was a perfect 3-for-3 in his stolen-base attempts, giving him a team-leading 13 stolen bases on the year. In 2007, Long has been successful on 68.4% of his stolen base attempts (13-for-19).

2007 Freshman Class Noted Among the Nation's Best

The Santa Clara University baseball program received an accolade from the *Collegiate Baseball* newspaper as the Broncos' 2006 recruiting class was named one of the Top-40 classes in the nation, coming in at No. 28, tops among West Coast Conference schools. The members of this class, who are currently in their first year on the Mission Campus, will look this spring to help lead the squad to its first WCC title since 1997.

Of the freshman class in 2007, Nathan Garcia (Bellarmine College Prep), Patrick Glenn (Amador Valley HS), Matthew Hiserman (Capistrano Valley HS), Steven Kalush (Aragon HS), Jon Karcich (Serra HS), Geoffrey Klein (Ocean View HS), Tommy Medica (Bellarmine College Prep), Alex Rivers (Tokay HS) and Dylan Slocum (Paloma Valley HS) make up the California contingent. Tayler Thomas (Salpointe Catholic HS) hails from

Arizona and Jeremy Zink (Garfield HS) will come to the Mission Campus from the state of Washington.

Four Broncos Named to All-WCC 40th Anniversary Team

The West Coast Conference announced its 40th Anniversary Baseball Team in early January, and four Broncos were named to the 40-man squad. LHP Rich Troedson (1969-72), catcher Troy Buckley (1987-89), RHP Bob Pailthorpe (1992-95), and outfielder Mike Frank (1994-97) were all honored for their achievements on the diamond.

SCU Baseball Picked to Finish Sixth in WCC Preseason Poll

The Santa Clara baseball team was selected to finished sixth in the West Coast Conference in the 2007 WCC preseason poll, as selected by the conference coaches. The Broncos were picked to finished behind Pepperdine, San Diego, San Francisco, LMU and Gonzaga. Santa Clara claimed the sixth position with 18 total points.

Head Coach Mark O'Brien

Bay Area native Mark O'Brien is in his fourth year as the head baseball coach at Santa Clara University. In his years at SCU, O'Brien has posted three second-place finishes in division play. In only his second season he guided the Broncos to their first winning season since 1997, posting a 31-26 overall record and a 21-9 mark in league play. O'Brien became the school's 35th head coach in the 111 years of the program when he was hired on June 11th, 2001.

During his brief time on the Mission Campus, O'Brien has accomplished things that not many of his predecessors had. He became only the fourth coach in program history to win his 50th game in only his second season as head coach, joining Sal Taormina, Jerry McClain and John Oldham. The win was a savory one as he watched his team defeat the second-ranked Stanford Cardinal by a 2-0 score in Sunken Diamond, giving him his second career win over his former team.

Additionally O'Brien has produced four All-Americans in his first three years as skipper, becoming the first coach in school history to produce four All-Americans in his first three years at the helm. Joey Gomes was a first team selection in 2002 followed by Scott Dierks and Patrick Overholt in 2003 who earned honorable

mention and Freshman All-American honors respectively. Last season, Anthony Rea was a second team honoree. Through out his extensive coaching career, O'Brien has tutored 20 All-Americans.

The three years prior to joining the Broncos, O'Brien served as an assistant coach at Stanford. O'Brien assisted with all aspects of the program and served as the Cardinal's hitting and fielding instructor, as well as the duties of first base coach. During those three seasons Stanford qualified for the College World Series, taking home a third place finish in 1999 and back-to-back national runners-up in '00 and '01. O'Brien's infield led the nation in 2001 with a .977 fielding percentage and was among the top-five in the nation in '99 and '00.

O'Brien has an impressive resume, having served as the head coach at DeAnza Junior College in 1998 and spending four seasons as an assistant coach at Cal Poly in addition to his three years at Stanford.

O'Brien played collegiately at San Jose State from 1991-92 and was the Spartans' team captain in his final year. He was also named an Alaska Summer League All-Star in 1991 after coming to SJSU from St. Francis High School and DeAnza College.

Has started 43 of the 47 games in which he has appeared this season ... batting .260 on the season, with 14 RBIs and 23 runs scored.

SS - Jon Karcich (Fr., Belmont)

Freshman out of Serra High has started 48 games this season ... has hit three home runs and driven in 26 runs so far in his freshman campaign.

3B - Gabe Alcantar (Jr., San Jose)

Doubled and had an RBI in Moraga this weekend ... tied for second on the team with .330 average, 14 doubles and 32 runs scored, and is second with 27 RBIs.

C - Tommy Medica (Fr., San Jose)

Leading candidate for WCC Freshman of the Year honors ... batted .400 (6-for-15) last week ... went 2-for-3 at Nevada ... leads team and WCC

with .399 average ... named WCC Player of the Week, and to *Collegiate Baseball News* National Honor Roll (4/9) after batting .706 (12-for-17) with two triples in four games from April 9-15.

RF - Nathan Faulkner (Sr., Temecula)

Has started 25 of 37 games in which he has appeared this season ... went a career-best 5-for-5 with two RBIs against Stanford ... had three hits at Nevada ... batting .301 on the year with five doubles and 13 RBIs.

CF - Matt Long (So., Los Altos Hills)

Has started all 50 games in the outfield this season ... went 3-for-6 with a home run, two doubles, and three RBIs ... batting .325 with nine doubles, three homers, and 24 RBIs this season.

LF - Evan LeBlanc (So., Tucson, Ariz.)

Sophomore transfer from Yavapai (Ariz.) Community College has started 42 games and is batting .287 on the season ... had three hits at Nevada ... has homered twice, and has 10 doubles and 16 RBIs on the year.

DH - Carl Bacon (Sr., Santa Cruz)

Splits time at catcher and DH ... enjoying a

career year so far in 2007 ... hit .538 (7-for-13) this past weekend ... batting a career-best .323 with 60 hits, 10 doubles, a homer, and 27 RBIs.

SP - Matt Wickswat (So., Bellevue, Wash.)

Sophomore lefty is 6-5 this season with 3.35 ERA ... has struck out 10 batters on four occasions this season, most recently May 5 at Saint Mary's ... leads team with 75 strikeouts and 83.1 innings pitched.

SP - Nate Garcia (Fr., Santa Clara)

Freshman starter earned win Friday at Saint Mary's, allowing only three runs over seven innings ... struck out a career-high 13 batters April 13 against Gonzaga ... is 4-5 on the year with a 5.40 ERA.

RP - Jeff Lombard (Jr., Woodinville, Wash.)

Leads the team with 10 saves on the season ... is 3-4 on the season with a 3.12 ERA ... has struck out 33 batters in 34.2 innings of work ... second in WCC with 10 saves.
