## 2009 Season Review

The Santa Clara baseball team finished the year with a less than desirable 19-34 overall record and a 6-15 mark in West Coast Conference play. Yet, when all was said and done the Broncos did some remarkable things on the diamond this season to make 2009 memorable.

SCU started out the year by handing head coach Mark O'Brien his 200th career victory with a 3-0 sweep of Xavier. The Broncos went on to post wins against Oregon, then-No. 18 Cal Poly, USF, San Diego State, Stanford and Saint Mary's. The year also saw senior captain Matt Long climb into seven all-time Bronco record books as well as junior shortstop Jon Karcich get selected in the seventh round of the 2009 MLB First Year Player Draft. Both he and Long (30th Round) were chosen by the Anaheim Angels.

Santa Clara had five student-athletes earn All-WCC honors including first-time first team selection Geoff Klein, who led the league with a .379 batting average, and repeat honorees Long, Karcich and Nate Garcia. Freshman Andrew Biancardi continued the Broncos tradition of having a rookie earn All-Freshman honors.

The Broncos hit a bump in the road in 2009 but the sky's the limit in 2010 as many veteran players are slated to highlight the roster including Klein, three-time All-WCC honoree Garcia and All-American catcher Tommy Medica, who returns for his senior season after facing a season-ending shoulder injury in early March 2009, to name a few.

### Last Time Out

The Broncos brought the season to a close with a hard-fought battle against then-No. 14 Mustangs of Cal Poly. Santa Clara, after trailing 5-2, rallied for two runs in the seventh inning to make it a 5-4 ball game. However, Cal Poly quickly retired SCU in the final two innings to earn the win. Sophomore Curtis Wagner went 2-for-3 with two runs and an RBI, while Kevin Madden was 3-for-4 with two RBIs. Freshman Paul Twining (0-2) faced the loss after five innings in the start. He struck out four. RS Freshman Jason Westerberg tossed a solid three no-hit innings in relief.

### Bronco Watch

Junior Geoff Klein captured the team's batting title with a .379 clip. He also led the Broncos with 81 hits, 56 RBIs, five home runs and a .547 slugging percentage. Senior Matt Long tied Klein with a team-best five home runs, while leading the squad with 43 runs scored. Junior Jon Karcich hit a team-high 22 doubles and swiped a team-best eight bags. He also produced a team-best .545 on base percentage. Karcich was second on the squad with 37 runs scored and a .354 batting average. On the mound, junior Nate Garcia led with a 4.33 ERA and 7-5 overall record. He tossed a team-high 95.2 innings with 96 strikeouts and three complete games. Fellow junior Alex Rivers was second on the squad with a 4.85 ERA and 5-5 record. He tossed 78.0 innings with 67 strikeouts, two complete games and one save. Junior Steve Kalush added four saves to his career record.

### In the WCC

The Broncos finished the season tied for second in the WCC in doubles and sixth in triples and hits. SCU was also fourth in batters struck out. Individually, Geoff Klein led the league with a .379 batting average and was third in hits and doubles. Nate Garcia led all WCC pitchers in batters struck out and complete games, while finishing third in innings pitched and games started. See page 6 of the notes for the complete list.

**On the National Stage**

When all was said and done, the Broncos finished the year ranked in the top-100 nationally in doubles (No. 60), doubles per game (No. 36), sacrifice bunts (No. 81), strikeouts per nine innings (No. 66) and walks allowed per nine innings (No. 45). SCU also had five athletes end the year in the top-100 of five statistical categories. Matt Long was No. 24 and No. 22 in triples and triples per game, respectively. Jon Karcich was No. 27 and No. 33 in doubles per game and doubles, respectively. Geoff Klein was No. 53 in both doubles per game and doubles, while Brady Fuerst was No. 73 in doubles. Nate Garcia rounded out the group at No. 47 in strikeouts. See page 6 of the notes for the complete list.

**Broncos and the Record Books**

Santa Clara had five athletes enter the Bronco Record books this season. Senior Matt Long etched his name through the career lists entering seven categories. He is also listed in two single-season lists. Juniors Jon Karcich and Nate Garcia are now each ranked in two career lists and one single-season list, while fellow juniors Steve Kalush and Geoff Klein entered a career and single-season list, respectively. **WCC Players of the Week**

The Broncos had three athletes honored by the WCC with Player/Pitcher of the Week accolades. Picking up the first honors for SCU was Nate Garcia after leading the Broncos to a 2-1 opening weekend and O'Brien's 200th career victory. He earned the honor twice this season. The second came after his second win of the season against Oregon, in which he struck out a season-high 12 batters and surrendered just one run. Fellow pitcher Alex Rivers then received the honor in mid-March after a tremendous performance against Dartmouth. Rounding out the Players of the Week for SCU was senior centerfielder Matt Long, who was selected after leading the Broncos to a 3-1 week (May 4-10) with a non-conference win over Stanford and a 2-1 series win against Saint Mary's.

**A Night of Firsts**

Helping the Broncos to the win against Stanford on May 6, redshirt sophomore Cory Hall earned his first collegiate win. Freshman J.R. Graham also had a solid outing as he hit his first career home run and then came into pitch his first career save.

**Sending Seniors Out In Style**

Saturday's doubleheader against San Diego State (May 2) was Senior Day for Santa Clara and several of the Bronco veterans had strong showings. Long nearly hit for the cycle in game one. He was a home run shy of reaching the feat for the second time in his career. The Los Altos native compiled the cycle on April 26, 2008 against Hawaii-Hilo. His triple in game one was his sixth of the season and the 14th of his career. Long is now tied for second all-time. Kevin Madden had two runs and two RBIs on the day, while Kyle Van Dusen registered his second career home run in game two.

**Broncos Celebrate 100th Game At Schott With Win**

The single game against Dartmouth on March 22 marked the 100th game played in the friendly confines of Stephen Schott Stadium. The Broncos celebrated in style with an impressive 16-1 victory over the Big Green of Dartmouth. Sophomore Chris Morton and junior Patrick Glenn registered their first career home runs in the game, while sophomore Thain Simon earned his second win of the season, striking out a season-best seven batters.

**Medica To Undergo Season-Ending Shoulder Surgery**

Santa Clara All-American catcher Tommy Medica will miss the rest of the 2009 season, head baseball coach Mark O'Brien announced Wednesday. Medica will undergo surgery on April 3 to repair a separated shoulder. Medica suffered the injury during the third game of the series at Oregon on March 7. More information about his rehabilitation time will be released next week.

**Rivers Named WCC Pitcher of the Week**

Santa Clara junior Rivers was named the West Coast Conference's Pitcher of the Week; it was announced Monday. It is the first weekly honor for the right-hander from Lodi, Calif., and is the third Pitcher of the Week accolade for the Broncos this season. Fellow junior Garcia has received the honor twice. Rivers (2-0) started the second game of a three-game series against the Ivy League's Dartmouth. He helped the Broncos to a 3-0 shutout of the Big Green in game two of the Saturday, March 21 doubleheader. The 5-foot-10 Rivers had a no-hitter going into the eighth inning. He gave up two hits to start off the eighth inning before retiring. Rivers also struck out a career-high 11 batters in the victory.

**Garcia Earns Two WCC Weekly Honors**

Junior right-hander Nate Garcia was named the West Coast Conference's Pitcher of the Week on March 9. It is the Santa Clara native's fourth career weekly accolade from the WCC and the second of the season. In his third start of the year, the 6-foot-1 Bellarmine College Prep product was credited with a complete game and earned the win after allowing just one run on six hits against Oregon on Friday, March 6. Garcia also struck out a season-high 12 batters. The first came after a 3-0 shutout of Xavier in the season opener. Garcia tossed seven innings and struck out eight batters. He allowed no runs and just three Musketeer hits.

**O'Brien Gets 200**

With a 3-0 shutout of Xavier Friday morning, the Broncos handed eighth year head coach Mark O'Brien his 200th career victory (201-191). He joined John Oldham and Sal Taormina as the only Bronco baseball head coaches earn 200 wins.

**Medica Named to Johnny Bench Watch List**

Junior Tommy Medica was one of 44 catchers to be named to the initial Coleman Company - Johnny Bench Award Watch List it was announced on Mar. 16. The list also includes USF junior Ryan Lipkin. The list narrowed down to 10 semifinalists on May 14 and then to three finalists announced on June 3. The award will be presented to the winner at the 12th Annual Greater Wichita Sports Banquet on June 26. Medica received three preseason All-America honors. He leads the team with a .429 batting average and has scored nine runs in nine games with seven doubles, one home run and an RBI.

**Medica, Simon Earn Preseason All-America Honors**

Junior Tommy Medica and sophomore Thain Simon picked up three preseason All-America honors as they both were named to the Louisville Slugger, Recruiting Closer and CollegeBaseballInsider.com Preseason lists. Medica, a unanimous All-WCC honoree, led SCU in on-base percentage and tied for second in doubles (15) and ranked second in triples and walks. Simon earned three freshman All-America honors in 2008 and was named the WCC's Freshman of the Year.

**Simon Named to Two Watch Lists**

RHP Thain Simon was named to two preseason watch lists. He was one of six West Coast Conference athletes to be named to the watch list for the Brooks Wallace Award and one of three from the WCC named to the NCBWA Preseason Stopper of the Year watch list. Simon received three All-America honors after his rookie season as he was named to Baseball America's Freshman All-America second team, and to the Louisville Slugger's and NCBWA Freshman All-America teams. The right-handed pitcher from Toronto was also named the West Coast Conference's top freshman, the Broncos first since 2000. For the season, Simon was 9-2, starting the year in the bullpen and registering two saves on the WCC opening weekend against San Diego. He received WCC Co-Pitcher of the week honors for his performance. Simon moved into the

### Broncos Picked To Finish Third In WCC

For the second straight season, the Santa Clara baseball team was selected to finish third in the 2009 West Coast Conference Baseball Preseason Coaches Poll. San Diego and Pepperdine tied for first place with 45 overall points, but the Toreros received four of the possible eight first place votes and the Waves received three votes. SCU earned 35 overall points for third place, while Gonzaga was chosen to finish fourth and received the final first place vote.

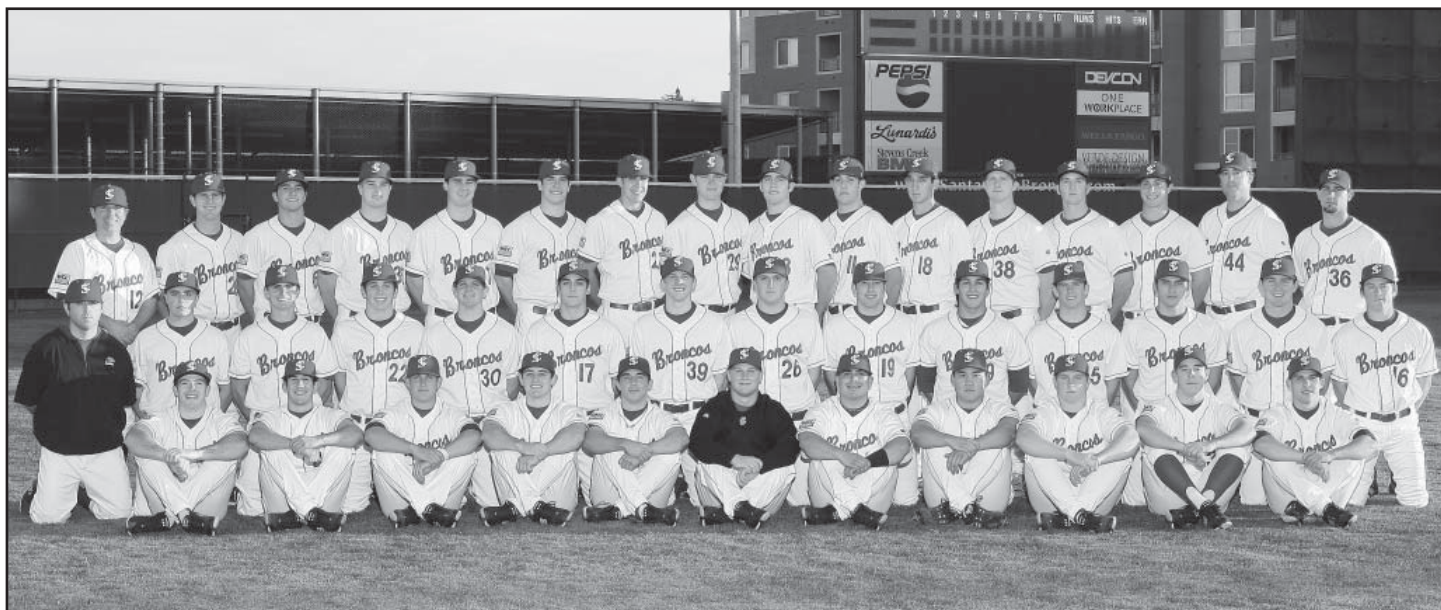
