Accommodations: Players will be housed two to a room in one of the residence dorms on campus. If you have a roommate preference, please indicate whom on your application. Coaches will stay in dorms for supervision at all times.

Meals: Three buffet meals served daily in the campus dining facility. A snack bar will be provided with food and SCU clothing.

Cancellations: A \$100 charge will be made for cancellations prior to July 7th. After the July 7th, a refund less than \$100 will be made for **medical reasons only**.

Applications submitted after July 7th, must include full payment.

A detailed informational letter will be sent to you by July 14th. Keep this brochure and that letter for reference.

Insurance: CAMPERS MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN ACCIDENTAL INSURANCE. A full time trainer is on duty to attend to the medical needs of the campers. Please advise the administrator regarding any pre-existing medical conditions we should be aware of. No medical claims will be accepted after one year from the end of camp.

TEACHING CONCEPTS

- **Offensive Skills:** shooting techniques covering many game situations
- **Ballhandling:** Dribbling, Passing, Catching, Pivoting, etc...
- **Footwork/Moving without the ball**
- **Position Play:** Guard, wing, and post specific moves and drills
- **Rebounding:** proper technique, footwork, and drills
- **Defensive:** terminology, footwork, individual and team drills in every phase of defensive situations
- **Conditioning:** basketball workout drills that also increase stamina and overall condition

ADDED FEATURES

- **Guest speakers:** Former Santa Clara University players, NBA representatives will be guest speakers during the week
- **Competition:** 5 on 5 camp games as well as 3 on 3 and 1 on 1, and free throw competition
