Pepperdine Women Claim Fourth at NCAA Golf Championships



The Pepperdine women's golf team posted a fourth place finish at the 2005 NCAA Golf Championships on the Meadows Course in Sunriver, Oregon. The Waves finished nine shots behind first place Duke, which captured its third national title. Pepperdine's placed in the Top 5 at the NCAA Championships for the third time in school history and recorded its fifth Top 10 showing in six trips to the championships.

Junior Carolina Llano tied for sixth place with rounds of 69-77-72-72, while freshman Leanne Bowditch finished in 39th place in her first showing at the championships.

Pepperdine carded rounds of 291-295-299-294 and was one of three teams to shoot under 300 in all four rounds at the championships.

The Waves concluded their season as the No. 4 ranked team in the nation as listed by Golfweek.com. Pepperdine golfers Llano and Eileen Vargas ended their season at No. 16 and No. 30 in the nation, respectively.

Pepperdine Posts 10th Place Tie, Saint Mary's Ties for 14th Place



The Pepperdine Waves and the Saint Mary's Gaels tied for 10th and 14th place, respectively at the NCAA West Regionals on the Stanford Golf Course. Pepperdine finished the final round of play tied with South Carolina and USC for the final berth into the NCAA Championships. The Waves fell in the play-offs as USC claimed the final spot. Pepperdine was in pursuit of its second straight NCAA Championships appearance.

The Waves' Michael Putnam defeated South Carolina's Alex Hamilton during the play-off to capture the second of two individual spots into the NCAA Championships. Putnam tied for 12th place with rounds of 66-73-73 for a score of 212. This marks the second time Putnam has qualified individually for the NCAA Championships as the senior last did so in 2003. The championships will be held June 1-4 at the Caves Valley Golf Course in Owings, Maryland.

The Saint Mary's Gaels tied for 14th place in their first NCAA Regional outing in the program's 34-year history. Senior Joe Lanza ended his career at SMC by posting the Gaels' low score and tying for 26th place. Lanza shot rounds of 74-72-69 for a 5-over total of 215. The Gaels' Liam Kendregan tied for 31st place with rounds of 75-67-74 for a 6-over total of 216.

The Waves are ranked as the No. 27 team in the country by Golfweek.com, while Michael Putnam is ranked No. 11. Pepperdine claimed its seventh straight WCC crown this season and qualified for NCAA Regional play for the seventh consecutive year. Four Pepperdine golfers received All-WCC honors in Alex Coe, Brian O'Flaherty, Putnam and Colin Wilcox. The Gaels posted their second consecutive second-place result at the WCC Championships and had three All-WCC performers in Chadd Cocco, Kendregan and Lanza.

Gonzaga Bulldogs -- Men's and Women's Golf Notes:

The Bulldog men placed in seventh at the WCC Golf Championships ... **Trevor Loe** (77-77-75) tied for 20th place with a score of 229 ... **Jimmy Hayes** (81-74-77) took home a 25th place finish with a score of 232 ... On the women's side, Gonzaga finished in fifth place ... **Mary Kate Morgan** posted a top-10 result with a ninth place finish ... Morgan shot rounds of 79-80-78 for a score of 237 ... **Lacey Jo Manwaring** ended in 20th place.



Loyola Marymount Lions -- Men's Golf Notes:

The LMU men placed in eighth at the WCC Golf Championships ... The Lions' top finisher was **Brendan von Doehren** who shot rounds of 79-77-78 for a score of 234 ... **Jason D'Amore** won WCC Freshman of the Year honors and was also an all-conference selection ... D'Amore tied for 32nd at the championships with a score of 237 ... LMU posted a fifth place finish last season ... The Lions posted top-5 finishes at the last three golf championships.



Pepperdine Waves -- Men's and Women's Golf Notes:

Pepperdine capped its season with a 10th place tie at the NCAA West Regional ... The Waves lost a three-way for the final spot into NCAA Championship play ... Senior Pepperdine golfer **Michael Putnam** collected one of two individual spots and qualified for the NCAA Championships to be played June 1-4 at the Caves Valley Golf Course in Owings, Maryland ... Putnam tied for 12th at the West Rional with rounds of 66-73-73 for a total of 212 ... Putnam paced the Waves this season with a 70.73 stroke average ... Putnam is also a finalist for the Byron Nelson Award ... The winner will be announced at the NCAA Championships in June ... Pepperdine loses two-time All-American Putnam and All-WCC selection **Brian O'Flaherty**, but will return **Alex Coe** and two freshmen who gained valuable experience this season in **Michael Baird** and **Colin Wilcox** ... Coe and Wilcox claimed fourth and fifth place, respectively at the WCC Championships, while Baird tied for 11th ... The Pepperdine women posted a fourth place finish at the NCAA Championships ... The result marked the Waves third Top 5 result at the championships ... **Carolina Llano** completed a strong third year in Malibu with a sixth place tie at the NCAA Championships ... Llano tied for fifth at the NCAA East Regionals and claimed her third straight WCC Championship crown ... The junior paced Pepperdine with a 73.81 stroke average ... Llano also posted a seventh place finish at the Arizona Wildcat Invitational and tied for ninth at the Arizona State Invitational ... As a senior next season, Llano will anchor an even younger Pepperdine roster for the 2006 season ... The Waves graduate one senior in **Rachel Kyono**, while returning freshmen **Leanne Bowditch** and **Marina Choi** along with **Eileen Vargas** who will be a junior next season ... Pepperdine has a trio of golfers in **Maria Arenas**, **Courtney Clark** and **Stephanie Gelleni** who carded a limited number of rounds this season, but may be looked upon to fill the void left by Kyono.



Portland Pilots -- Men's and Women's Golf Notes:

The Portland men placed fourth at the WCC Golf Championships ... The Pilots' **Mike McCabe** tied for ninth with rounds of 72-75-75 for a score of 222 ... **Jake Easterly** tied for 20th place as he shot a 229 ... For the women, **Melanie Lee** recorded the team's highest finish as she tied for 11th ... Portland captured fourth place at the WCC Golf Championships with a score of 984 ... The Pilots fourth place finish is their second such result in four years ... Portland finished in seventh place last season.



Saint Mary's Gaels -- Men's Golf Notes:

The Gaels reached NCAA Regional play for the first time in the 34-year history of the program ... At the NCAA West Regional, the Gaels finished in a three-way tie for 14th place ... **Joe Lanza** tied for 26th place after recording a 1-under par score of 69 in his final round ... **Liam Kendregan** tied for 31st place, while freshman **Josh Kelley** tied for 39th place ... SMC posted a second consecutive runner-up showing at the WCC Championships as Lanza won individual medalist honors ... SMC is listed as the No. 38 team in the nation by Golfweek.com, while Kendregan is ranked as the No. 72 golfer in the country and Lanza at No. 102 ... Fifth year Saint Mary's Head Coach **Scott Hardy** has raised the Gael program to new heights during his time in Moraga ... Hardy directed SMC to consecutive second place finishes at the WCC Championships, which resulted in a berth into the NCAA West Regionals this season ... The Gaels will lose senior standouts Kendregan and Lanza, but will return **Chadd Cocco** and a pair of freshmen who gained experience this year in Kelley and **Michael McRae** ... Kelley tied for 39th place at the NCAA West Regionals, while McRae tied for 119th place in both players initial exposure to postseason golf.



San Diego Toreros -- Men's Golf Notes:

The Toreros recorded a six place finish at the WCC Golf Championships ... **Jimmy Harris** posted the best result for USD with a 15th place finish ... Harris shot rounds of 75-73-77 for a score of 225 ... Head coach **Tim Mickelson** was one of three coaches to share WCC Coach of the Year honors ... Other results for the Toreros included a tie for 22nd place by **Luke Antonelli** and a 24th place finish by **Bucky Coe** ... San Diego had a fourth place finish in last year's championships, the first under the guidance of coach Mickelson.



San Francisco Dons -- Men's and Women's Golf Notes:

The USF women posted a second place result with rounds of 308-305-309 for a score of 922 ... **Mariko Shimozaki** recorded a sixth place finish at the tournament with a score of 228 ... Shimozaki also gained all-conference honors ... **Nikki Jacoby** and **Jessica Potter** tied for seventh place, while **Kristin Nichols** tied for 11th and **Chaneng Joe** gained a 13th place finish ... The Don men placed in fifth at the tournament with a score of 920 ... **Taylor Hobin** recorded a seventh place finish with rounds of 70-72-73 for a 1-under score of 215 ... **Moses Kahalekulu** tied for 17th place with a score of 228 ... Hobin tied for 29th in last year's tournament as a freshman ... The USF women kept its streak alive of finishing in either first or second place during the eight-year history of the women's tournament.



Santa Clara Broncos -- Men's and Women's Golf Notes:

The Bronco men and women each claimed a third place finish at the WCC Golf Championships ... The men recorded a score of 891, while the women posted a score of 977 ... **Michael Nicoletti** and **Eric Lillibridge** each tied for 11th with a score of 223 ... **Samantha Trask** posted a 10th place finish on the women's side as well as picking up all-conference honors ... Trask gained all-conference honors last season as well ... **Candice Palmer** had a 14th place result with a score of 244 ... Nicoletti has posted the best men's score for SCU the last three years ... The men's last third place finish occurred in 2003 ... The Bronco women have now recorded consecutive third place finishes at the tournament ... Trask was the women's best finisher for the second straight year.
