### Fall Wrap-Up...

The Santa Clara women's tennis team opened up their 2007-2008 season with a promising start this fall. This was a transitional season for the team after Casey Knutson, Erika Barnes and Kim Daniel graduated last spring, leaving five returning players and introducing four newcomers. During this fall season, the freshmen on the team gained valuable experience with collegiate play, and the team was able to form strong doubles teams that could be used in the dual season. Samantha Georgino was unable to compete as she continues to recover from major elbow surgery. The Broncos participated in four tournaments, competing against conference rivals as well as many other great teams. First, the team traveled south for the Bulldog Classic in Fresno. Myra Davoudi and Lindsay McBride led the way in singles the first day, each with three-set victories. Continuing in the tournament, Stephanie Galainena and Davoudi turned out great performances, making it to the final day of consolation matches. In the Cal Invitational the following week, freshman Courtney Hull battled through tough matches, two of which were long three-setters, to capture the White bracket. Also that weekend, McBride and freshman Carmen Pham defeated their opponents from Saint Mary's in the Blue bracket to reach the semifinals. The Saint Mary's Invitational marked the second half of the team's fall season, and their steady improvements were clearly evident. Three of four doubles teams made it to the quarterfinals, including an impressive performance by
