



# Men's Basketball Game Notes

## SACRED HEART UNIVERSITY (10-15, 7-9) AT ST. FRANCIS COLLEGE (10-14, 7-8)

Date: Tuesday – February 21, 2006 \* Place - Fairfield, CT \* Tipoff: 7:00 pm EST

**Setting The Scene:** The Sacred Heart University men's basketball desperately needs a win if it is to secure a place in the Northeast Conference post-season tournament. The Pioneers have lost seven of eight and look to right the ship on Tuesday with a 7 p.m. home game against St. Francis College of Brooklyn.

**Series:** This is the 13th meeting between the two schools, and St. Francis holds a commanding 9-2 lead in the series, including the last six in a row and seven of the last eight. SFNY won an earlier meeting this season on February 11, 62-58 in Brooklyn. The Terriers won both meetings last season, 78-66 in Brooklyn and 88-83 in Fairfield. The first meeting was back when SHU was still in Division II during the 1997-98 season, a 76-61 St. Francis victory.

**The Coaches:** **Dave Bike** (Sacred Heart '69) is in his 28th year as the head coach of Sacred Heart. He has a career record of 427-381 and guided the Pioneers in their transition from a Division II program to Division I. He led the Pioneers to eight NCAA Division II tournaments, and his 1985-86 team won the national championship while finishing 30-4. Bike was named the national Coach of the Year by the NABC following the title game. Prior to joining the SHU coaching staff, he worked as an assistant at Seattle University for four seasons. Drafted as a baseball player by Detroit, he spent five seasons as a catcher in the Tiger farm system.

**Brian Nash** (Keene St. '92) is in his first season as a collegiate head coach, taking over the Terrier program after a stint as an assistant at Seton Hall University. His coaching career actually began at Sacred Heart, where he was an assistant during the 1993-94 season. A Brooklyn native, Nash has also made assistant coaching stops at Siena College and St. Bonaventure.

**Scouting the Opponent:** St. Francis comes in as the hottest team in the Northeast Conference with four straight wins. All four of those wins came at home, where SFNY is 8-5 this season. The Terriers are just 2-9 on the road this season and 1-5 in road games in the NEC. The Terriers are coming off a 70-69 overtime win over Robert Morris on Saturday, led by 17 points from freshman guard **John Gooden**.

Junior forward **Allan Sheppard** lead St. Francis in scoring at 11.3 points per game. He is the club's second best rebounder at five per game and is also second on the team with 16 blocked shots.

Senior forward **Christian Brown** is second in scoring at 11.2 points per game. He leads the team in rebounding at 5.4 per contest, assists with 59 and steals with 30. He has canned over 37 percent of his three-point attempts.

St. Francis is tenth in the conference in scoring, averaging just 63.2 points per game. They are also tenth in field goal percentage in the NEC at 41 percent.

**Upcoming Games:** The Pioneers finish the regular season with a home game against Quinnipiac on Saturday at 5:00 p.m.

## Last Game – CCSU 73, Sacred Heart 56-

**February 16, 2006:** Junior guard Javier Mojica scored 16 points to lead Central Connecticut into a tie for second place in the Northeast Conference with a 73-56 victory over Sacred Heart on Saturday. Tristan Blackwood and Justin Chiera had 14 apiece for the Blue Devils.

Central (14-10, 10-5 NEC) jumped in front with a 12-0 run over a stretch of 5:05 to take a 23-16 lead. Sacred Heart (10-15, 7-9) scored two of the next three baskets, but CCSU then went on another tear, this time scoring seven straight points and 12 of the next 14 to open up a 37-22 lead. Drew Shubik had 13 of his 16 points in the first half to keep the Pioneers in the game.

Luke Granato made two 3-pointers as Sacred Heart closed the gap to 47-41 with less than 11 minutes left in the game. But Chiera buried a three and Obie Nwadike made a pair of free throws to build the lead back to 11 at 52-41.

Central's defense held senior center Kibwe Trim, who came in averaging nearly 20 points a game this season to just eight points on three shots from the floor. It snapped a streak of 29 straight games that he had reached double figures in scoring. Trim did finish with ten rebounds.

## Last Time vs. SFNY – SFNY 62, Sacred Heart 58-

**January 11, 2006:** Allan Sheppard scored 16 points, including a pair of free throws in the final minute, to help the St. Francis College Terriers defeat visiting Sacred Heart University 62-58 in a Northeast Conference men's basketball game Saturday afternoon.

The Pioneers, 10-13 overall and 7-7 in the Northeast Conference, trailed 24-14 at the intermission, due to just 29 percent shooting (6-21) and 14 turnovers. Kibwe Trim, SHU's leading scorer had just six points in the half and took just three shots.

A 7-2 run to start the second half got SHU back within five at 26-21 with 17:28 to play. Trim had a three-point play in the middle of that run. Tristan Smith knocked home a three for the Terriers to push it back to eight, but Trim answered with another conventional three-point play of his own.

Yet another three-point play by Trim with 15:30 left put the Pioneers within 31-27. Nick Jones hit a pair of free throws with 12:00 left to give the Terriers a 37-31 lead. Ryon Howard cut it to 41-37 with just over ten minutes remaining in the game.

A three by Tristan Smith with 8:00 left extended the Terrier lead to 48-39. Jarrid Frye knifed through the lane between three white shirts with 6:38 left to put SHU back within 48-43. Jones hit another three for the Terriers to get the lead back to eight.

After Trim stole an inbounds pass by St. Francis, Frye finished it off with a layup to make it 51-47 with 5:35 to play. Trim missed two free throws with 4:25 left that could have cut the gap to two and Allan Sheppard made it hurt when he converted a layup at the other end to make it 53-47. Sheppard hit a rainbow jumper over Frye with 3:00 remaining to give the Terriers a 55-47 lead.

Trim was fouled grabbing a rebound with 2:40 remaining and missed the front end of a one-and-one. Howard grabbed the offensive board, but his follow-up was blocked and St. Francis went the other way. Trim kept the Pioneers alive by hitting a pair of free throws with 1:23 to go to make it 55-49. Sheppard was fouled on the inbound pass and made two to push the lead back to eight.

A Drew Shubik three for SHU with 1:08 left made it 57-52. The Pioneers again fouled on the inbound pass and Smith hit both to make it 59-52. Frye knocked home another three for the Pioneers to get within four. Shubik tied up Smith on the ensuing inbound and the possession arrow favored the Pioneers. Trim went to the basket after the tie-up and was fouled while completing a layup with :44 left. He made the free throw to cut the Terrier lead to one at 59-58.

Sheppard was fouled driving to the basket by Howard with :25 left and calmly sank both tries and give SFNY a 61-58 lead/ Frye lost the ball off his hands driving the other way, giving the ball back to the Terriers. Forced to foul again, Brown sank both tried with :16 left to give the Terriers a five-point bulge and ice the Pioneers.

Trim finished the game with 22 points and eight boards for the Pioneers, while Frye finished with 13.

**Playoff Picture:** With two games remaining in the season, the Pioneers find themselves in eighth place at 7-9. The SHU playoff destiny lies in the Pitt Center. If the Pioneers win the final two games over St. Francis (NY) and Quinnipiac, they clinch a playoff berth. Winning just one of two would mean the Pioneers need help to get in. Losing both would have the Pioneers on the outside looking in.

**Can Ya Spot me Twenty?** Senior center Kibwe Trim has scored 20 or more points in a game 12 times this season, while junior guard Jarrid Frye has done it ten times. They rank one-two in the NEC in that category this season. That is the most for a Pioneer since Maurice Bailey poured in 20 or more 14 times during the 2003-04 season, on his way to leading the Northeast Conference in scoring at 20.1 points per game.

**Milestone Man:** Senior center Kibwe Trim has hit a few career milestones this season. He played the 100th game of his career as a Pioneer on January 19 against Robert Morris. He became the 26th player in school history to reach the 1000-point mark in his career with a free throw in the first two minutes of the game at Mount St. Mary's on January 12. He is the second player, behind Maurice Bailey (2002-04) to score all 1,000 at the Division I level for the Pioneers. During the Mount game, Trim also recorded his 500th career rebound. He needs one more rebound to hit the 600 mark.

**Chasing History:** Senior center Kibwe Trim's .583 career field goal percentage is the best in school history, leading Rhonie Wright (1979-83) in second place, who finished with at .581.

**Pencil 'Em In:** The Pioneers used the same starting lineup in each of the first nine games. The first different lineup came in game ten when Gene Pettway started in place of Brice Brooks. So far this season, head coach Dave Bike has used just three different starting lineups. That is a stark contrast to the 2004-05 season when Sacred Heart used 13 different starting combinations.

**Trim Hits the Books, too:** Senior center Kibwe Trim was named first team *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-District last week. He will now be placed on the national ballot for a spot on the Academic All-America team. Trim, the NEC's leading scorer at 19.0 ppg, was a District I (New England/New York) honoree. He is a Computer Science major and sports a 3.69 grade point average.

**Close Shave and a Haircut:** The Pioneers have lost 13 of their 15 games to date by a combined 80 points, an average of just over six points per game! They lost to URI by six, Yale by five, Quinnipiac by four, Harvard and LIU by three and Columbia by two. They have also had some close calls on the positive side, winning two of their four games by just two points. The lone anomaly was the 80-65 loss to LIU on February 4, the most lopsided defeat of the season.

**Home Cookin':** The Pioneers are 7-4 overall and 5-2 in the NEC in the Pitt Center this season. Sacred Heart will play the final two games of the season at home.

**Trim Leads the Pack:** Senior center Kibwe Trim is leading all scorers in the Northeast Conference so far this season at 19 per game. Trim, who averaged 10.5 ppg in 2004-05, is also first in field goal percentage (.620) and 4th in rebounding (8.6 rpg). He could be the second Pioneer to lead the conference in scoring in the last three years. Maurice Bailey led the NEC with a 20.1 average in 2003-04.

**Bombs Away:** Sophomore guard Luke Granato tied a school Division I record on January 21 against St. Francis (PA) when he dropped in seven threes on ten attempts. The last time a Pioneer made seven threes in a game was on 1/6/03 when Omar Wellington did it at Columbia in an overtime loss. The school record is eight, set during the Division II days, by Louis Frye against Bryant on 12/20/96 and John Randazzo against Stony Brook on 1/14/98.

**Shubik Finding the Range:** Sophomore guard Drew Shubik has hit at least one three-pointer in 22 of the 25 Pioneer games this season, including 11 of the last 13. He hit a season-high three threes, on six attempts, in the win over Lehigh and tied that on five attempts at St. Francis and against against Robert Morris.

**Two for the Price of One:** The men's basketball team has seven doubleheaders with the women's team this season, four of them at home. So far four of the six twinbills have resulted in Pioneer sweeps. The final DH will be on Saturday, February 25 when both teams will play at home against Quinnipiac.

**SHU Against Connecticut Opponents:** Sacred Heart has a 167-118 record all-time against schools from the Nutmeg State. The Pioneers have a 59-50 record against schools that are currently Division I in the state, with 29 of those wins coming against Quinnipiac. The Pioneers have a high of 39 wins against the University of Bridgeport during the SHU Division II years.

**Out of Left Field:** The Sacred Heart men's basketball team got some unexpected news in January when it was informed by Lehigh University that it was forfeiting a win it recorded last season against the Pioneers because of the use of an ineligible player. That changes the 2004-05 final record from 4-23 to 5-22.

**Eight (Hundred) is Great:** On Thursday, January 12, head coach Dave Bike worked his 800th game on the Sacred Heart bench. Tom Greene of Fairleigh Dickinson has the next highest number of games as a head coach in the NEC at 652.

**Cleaning the Glass:** Sacred Heart has outrebounded 17 of 24 opponents this season, including 12 of the last 16, and have only been bested in the rebounding department five times. Only Yale, Wagner, FDU and #8 Boston College have had more rebounds in a game than the Pioneers, and SHU was even with URI in the season opener.

**Dynamic Duo:** Senior center Kibwe Trim and junior guard Jarrid Frye lead seven duos in the NEC who combine to average at least 25 points per game. Trim (19.5) and Frye (16.4) rank first and fourth, respectively, in the conference in scoring and are far ahead of any other pair with a combined 35.9 ppg. AJ Jackson and Jeremy Chappell of Robert Morris are second at a combined 30.9.

**Twin Twenties- Times 4:** When Kibwe Trim (25) and Jarrid Frye (22) both notched over 20 points in the win over Army on December

5, it was the first time since February 14, 2004 that two Pioneers had scored over 20 in the same game. In that contest, Maurice Bailey finished with 22 and Trim had 20. They repeated the feat on January 9 when Trim finished with 24 and Frye 22, again on February 2 at Quinnipiac when both scored 23, and on February 16 when Trim poured in a career-high 31 and Frye added 21.

**Chairmen of the Boards:** When junior forward Jarrid Frye grabbed 15 rebounds in the win over Lehigh, it marked the first time since February 7, 2002 that a Pioneer had grabbed as many as 15 rebounds. On that night, Tim Welch had 18 boards against LIU. Kibwe Trim went him one better on February 9 when he ripped down 16 against Mount St. Mary's.

**Free Throws-R-Us:** The Pioneers went to the line a season-high 36 times against Army on December 5, making 29 of them (81%). Army took just ten tries during the game. The next game, SHU outshot Lehigh from the line 32-10. Sacred Heart has attempted more free throws than the opponent in 17 of the 24 games this season. The Pioneers are fourth in the conference in free throw percentage at 70.1 percent and have attempted more free throws than anyone else in the NEC.

**You Can Go Home Again:** In his return to Chestnut Hill, junior guard Tavio Hobson recorded a career-high 14 points, six assists and three steals against his former team. Hobson was a walk-on player at BC for two seasons before transferring to Sacred Heart. After the game he was warmly received by his former teammates and head coach Al Skinner. Hobson is currently second in the NEC with 2.4 steals per game and assists at 4.6 per outing.

**You Can Go Home Again- Part 2:** Sophomore guard Drew Shubik had a strong game in his return to central Pennsylvania in a game at St. Francis (PA). Shubik, who grew up about 45 minutes from the home of the Red Flash, finished the game with a season-high 16 points in front of a large contingent of family and friends.

**Seeing Double:** Senior center Kibwe Trim recorded the first double-double of the 2005-06 season for the Pioneers on December 3 at Boston College and now leads the team and Northeast Conference with 12. He has 15 for his career. He finished the game BC with 16 points and ten rebounds before fouling out with 6:35 left in the game. He followed up that performance by recording double-doubles in the next three games as well. Jarrid Frye jumped on the bandwagon with 23 points and 15 boards against Lehigh. It was the first time the Pioneers had two players record double-doubles in the same game since the 2001 season.

**Long Time Between:** The Sacred Heart victory on the road Albany was one day short of one year since its previous road win. Prior to that, the Pioneers hadn't won on the road since November 22, 2004 at Army.

**Pioneers vs. Ranked Opponents:** Sacred Heart is 0-10 against teams ranked in the top 25 since becoming Division I at the start of the 1999-2000 season.

**Pesky Pioneers:** The Pioneers have been a difficult opponent for a couple of marquee programs over recent seasons. This season, the Pioneers lost to both URI and Miami by just six points and were within shouting distance of Boston College before falling 77-66.

Last year, SHU had halftime leads against Penn State of the Big Ten, and the University of Connecticut. The Pioneers would finally fall to the Nittany Lions 69-61, and to UConn 73-55 but made both teams work for the win. In games that turned a lot of heads in 2003-04, the Pioneers lost to Boston College by a single bucket and had a lead with five minutes to play, and then dropped a 77-72 decision at Marquette and were within a basket into the final minute.

**Early Signings:** The Pioneers have received National Letters of Intent from Windsor High senior guard Ryan Litke and Xavier High School point guard Chauncey Hardy. The pair of highly-regarded Connecticut recruits will give the Pioneers some talented back court players starting in 2006. Hardy, who stands six feet, was named First

Team All-State by the Connecticut High School Coaches Association, *The Hartford Courant* and the *New Haven Register*. He helped Xavier to a 24-3 record, the SCC Championship, and to the semi-finals of the State Championship.

**Also In the Wings:** Sophomore center Jaff Salovski transferred to Sacred Heart from the University of Massachusetts this summer and will sit out the 2005-06 season under the NCAA transfer rules. The 6'10, 260 -pound post man had career highs of 21 points and nine boards against Xavier for the Minutemen last season.

**On the Air and Web:** All men's basketball games will be available on the radio and the World Wide Web. WHRT 91.5 FM will carry the entire schedule and WICC 600 AM will broadcast 16 of the team's games. Every game will also be streamed live on the internet through Sacred Heart University's website, SacredHeartPioneers.com. Jeff Holtz will call the play-by-play, while SHU Assistant Athletic Director, Gene Gumbs, will provide color commentary and analysis. The broadcasts begin 20 minutes prior to the scheduled kickoff for the Dave Bike Coach's Show, player interviews, and a preview of the upcoming game. The basketball games are part of a 60-game package the athletic communications office has planned for 2005-06. In addition to men's basketball, every football game will be broadcast as well as selected women's basketball, men's ice hockey, softball and baseball games.

**History:** This is the **41st season** of Pioneer men's basketball. SHU's first year of competition was the 1965-66 season under coach Don Feeley, who guided the program for 13 seasons before current coach Dave Bike took over. The Pioneers carry an overall record of **666 wins and 492 losses for a .575 winning percentage**. The Pioneers played in eight NCAA Division II Tournaments (the last one in 1983-84) and won the national title in 1986. Sacred Heart joined the NCAA Division I ranks for the 1999-00 season, making this their six season of Division I competition.

### **FDU Clinches Share of Regular Season Crown**

With just one week remaining in the regular season, few things are for certain in the NEC standings other than Fairleigh Dickinson has already clinched a share of the conference regular season crown and is on the cusp of earning its first outright NEC title since 1985-86. With a 13-2 league mark, FDU needs just one victory in its last three games or one loss apiece by Monmouth and CCSU to claim the top seed in the upcoming NEC Tournament.

### **Playoff Picture Still Muddled (aka "Break Out The Tiebreakers")**

As the regular season heads into the home stretch, the tightly knit NEC standings make it difficult to project the eventual matchups that will comprise the league's postseason tournament that begins with quarterfinal round play on Thursday, March 2. What we do know is that Fairleigh Dickinson (13-2), Monmouth (10-5), CCSU (10-5), Mount St. Mary's (9-6) and Robert Morris (9-7) have clinched berths in the eight-team NEC Tournament field. Of those teams, only FDU has guaranteed itself a first round home game. That leaves five teams - St. Francis (NY) (7-8), Long Island (7-8), Sacred Heart (7-9), Quinnipiac (6-9) and Wagner (4-11) - vying for the final three spots.

### **Peeples' Leads FDU To 68-64 Win Over UW-Green Bay In eBay BracketBuster Pool Game**

The NEC's first-ever participant in the eBay BracketBuster series, Fairleigh Dickinson came up big on Saturday, earning a 68-64 win over host UW-Green Bay. After a 10-0 run over a three-minute span enabled the Phoenix to tie the game at 64-64, junior forward **Michael Peeples** stole an inbounds pass and drove in for a layup to give the Knights a two-point lead with 3.8 seconds to play. UW-Green Bay tried to float the next inbounds pass over the head of Peeples, who was fouled as he leaped up and grabbed the ball at half court. Peeples sank both free throws with two seconds to secure the victory. The Knights were led by senior forward **Gordon Klaiber's** 16 second-half points and junior center **Andrea Crosariol's** double-double of 16 points and 15 rebounds.

### **FDU At Home On Road**

Fairleigh Dickinson has won six straight road games, the longest such streak since Monmouth claimed six consecutive victories away from Boylan Gymnasium in 2002-03. The Knights will put that streak on the line on Monday against second place Monmouth, the third road game in five days for the club.

### **Odds & Ends**

St. Francis (NY) is the league's hottest team this side of Fairleigh Dickinson. The Terriers went 4-0 in their recently concluded homestand and have now won six straight at the Pope Center to pull into a sixth place tie with Long Island...Wagner snapped a seven-game losing skid on Saturday, rallying from 14 down at halftime to earn a 64-60 win over Quinnipiac. With the victory, the Seahawks remained mathematically alive in the NEC playoff race...Sacred Heart has dropped seven of eight to fall to eighth place with a 7-9 conference record...CCSU, FDU and St. Francis (NY) have all won six straight at home...Monmouth will finish with its sixth straight winning record in league play...Mount St. Mary's has now won four straight games at Knott Arena, its longest homecourt win streak since 1998. A mathematics graduate of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology and MBA from Indiana University in 1983, Sagarin has applied his unique ranking system to college football, college basketball, Major League Baseball, pro football, pro basketball, pro hockey, volleyball, nascar, soccer and several other sports. Sagarin's college basketball rankings have proven their value to the NCAA tournament selection committee. Since 1984, Sagarin has supplied the committee — at its request — with his latest rankings at the beginning of the tournament selection process and with regular updates until the selections have been finalized. Sagarin's rankings form the basis of Play to Win, a unique game of skill and sports knowledge. # The RPI (Rating Percentage Index) is a measure of strength of schedule and how a team does against that schedule. It does not consider things like margin of victory or where a game is played, only whether or not a team won. It is used by the NCAA as one of their factors in deciding which teams to invite to the NCAA tournament and where to seed them. It was created and is maintained by the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Committee. They have always placed a premium on schedule strength when selecting teams for the tournament, so they wanted a relatively simple way to measure that and the RPI was born. Collegerpi.com is an independent duplication of those ratings.
