Gymkhana Games & Swap Meet start at 1pm

- **Entries:** \$20 per class, pre entries ONLY.
- Entries maybe mailed, emailed or faxed in by February 7th.
- **Horse Rental:** \$5 per class. *You may request a horse for your class, but Lion Hill Farm will make the ultimate decisions on horse assignments.*
- **Sign up as a team or as in individual.** Your team should be made up of a, b and c riders according to the class descriptions below. If you are unable to find enough team members you will be awarded a rider from the Sacred Heart University Equestrian Team.
 - *A Riders = proficient at walk, trot, canter and jumping.*
 - *B Riders = proficient at walk, trot and canter.*
 - *C Riders = proficient at walk trot.*

Class Descriptions

1. **Musical Stalls:** (A, B, C) - Ground poles to form stalls. There will be one less ground pole than horse and rider. Music will be played, when the music stops everyone must find a stall. The rider who cannot find a stall is out and another stall is removed this continues until there is one rider left.
2. **Turtle Race** (A, B, C) – one rider from each team will be asked to walk then trot. Each rider will trot as slow as he/she can go without breaking. The object is to go so slow that you force the rider behind you to pass you.
3. **Egg and Spoon Relay** (A,B,C) Each rider will ride to one end of the ring and back to the starting point with an egg & spoon in one hand. The team with the least amount of broken eggs at the end of the race wins.

4. **Sit-A-Buck (A, B)** - A rider will put a dollar bill underneath both legs and walk until both dollar bills fall. Winner receives 1/2 the prize money.
5. **Break- N- Out -“Simon Says”** - (A,B,C) riders will play Simon Says.
6. **Pony Express Relay-** (A,B,C) Each rider delivers a piece of mail to the mailbox and picks up a piece of mail, hands it off to the second rider who will deliver the mail back to the mail box. This relay will continue until all riders have received or delivered the mail.
7. **Rabbit Race** (A, B, C)– one rider from each team will be asked to walk then trot. Each rider will trot as fast as he/she can go without breaking into a canter. The object is to pass the person in front of you. If you are passed you are out, if you canter you are out, if you are on the wrong diagonal you are out.
8. **Team Scavenger Hunt - (A, B, C) no horses.** Teams will be provided with a list of clues and asked to find items on the property. First team with all or the most items in the allotted time wins.
9. **Team Trivia Challenge** – (A, B,C) **no horses.**
