### THE TOURNAMENT

Samford will play host to the Samford Thanksgiving Classic this weekend at the Pete Hanna Center. Samford will take on Alabama State Friday at 6 p.m. and South Florida on Saturday at 3 p.m.

Samford enters the tournament with a record of 1-2 after a 66-52 win at Jacksonville State on Tuesday.

Alabama State is currently 1-2 after a 70-67 loss to Kennesaw State on Friday night. South Florida has a record of 3-2 after a 67-49 win at Auburn on Monday.

### THE SERIES WITH THE TOURNAMENT FIELD

Samford and Alabama State will be meeting for the eighth time, with Samford holding a 4-3 advantage in the series. The teams last met on Dec. 12, 2004, with Samford winning by a score of 57-46 in Montgomery.

Samford and South Florida will be meeting for the first time on Saturday.

### SAMFORD AT HOME

In its 13-plus seasons, the Samford women's basketball program has an all-time record of 93-79 in home games.

Entering its fourth season in the Pete Hanna Center, the Bulldogs are 32-8 in their new home. In 10 seasons in Seibert Hall, Samford had a record of 61-71 in that facility.

This weekend's tournament will mark Samford's first home games of the 2010-11 season.

## SAMFORD AGAINST IN-STATE TEAMS

Samford has an all-time record of 31-35 against teams from the state of Alabama, including a 4-3 record against Friday's opponent, Alabama State.

Samford has also played the following in-state teams: Alabama (2-7), Alabama A&M (1-1), Birmingham-Southern (3-1), Jacksonville State (15-13), Troy (6-9) and UAB (0-1).

This season, Samford has two games on its schedule against Alabama teams, and the Bulldogs are 1-0 in those games after winning at Jacksonville State, 66-52 on Tuesday evening.

## SAMFORD AGAINST FLORIDA TEAMS

Samford has an all-time record of 17-23 against teams from the state of Florida, though Saturday's game will mark the first-ever meeting with South Florida.

Saturday's game is the lone game on Samford's 2010 schedule against a Florida team. Samford has also played the following Florida teams: UCF (2-8), Florida Atlantic (6-6), Florida International (0-1), Florida State (0-1), Jacksonville (3-2), Miami (0-1) and Stetson (6-4).

## LONDON AND HILL CLIMBING THE CHARTS

Seniors **Emily London** and **Savannah Hill** currently rank second and fourth, respectively, on Samford's all-time scoring list. London has scored 1,267 points in her Samford career, while Hill has 1,167 career points. The Samford career scoring record is 1,603 held by Alex Munday (2003-07).

## SU LOOKS FOR ANOTHER 20-WIN SEASON

Samford has posted at least 20 wins in each of its last three seasons and four of its last five seasons. Under head coach **Mike Morris**, Samford has posted its only four 20-win seasons and five of the six winning seasons in program history.

## BULLDOGS FACE TOUGH NON-CONFERENCE SCHEDULE

Samford will face one of the toughest schedules in program history. In its non-conference schedule, the Bulldogs will face teams from the Big 12 (Texas Tech), SEC (Vanderbilt and Ole Miss), ACC (Clemson) and Big East (South Florida).

## SOCON PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

In the preseason Southern Conference Coaches and Media polls, Samford was picked as the favorite to win the league. Senior guard **Emily London** was picked as the league's preseason Player of the Year. London and fellow senior **Savannah Hill** were named to the pre-season All-Conference team.

## HEAD COACH MIKE MORRIS

**Ninth Year**

**Record at Samford: 137-100**

**Career Record: 137-100**

Since taking over as the second head coach of Samford women's basketball in 2002, Mike Morris has taken the program to new heights.

Over the last five years, the Bulldogs have posted five of the top-six win totals in school history, including the program's only four 20-win seasons.

The 2009-10 team reach the finals of the Southern Conference Tournament for the first time and earn the program's first-ever national postseason appearance. The team also earned its first national postseason win, with a thrilling, 66-65, win over Ole Miss in the first round of the WNIT at the Pete Hanna Center.

Last season's team tied the school record for wins with a 23-11 overall record and a 14-6 mark in SoCon play.

In 2008-09, the Bulldogs set a school record for conference wins with a 16-4 league record in their first year in the SoCon. The team finished with an overall record of 22-7.

After the season, Morris was named the 2009 SoCon Coach of the Year. The award marked the second Coach of the Year award for Morris, as he was named the Ohio Valley Conference Coach of the Year in 2006.

The 2007-08 Bulldogs set a school record for most wins in a season, posting a 23-9 overall record and a 15-5 record in the OVC. The Bulldogs also posted their first-ever wins over Southeastern Conference (Alabama) and Big 12 (Missouri) opponents, and reached the semifinals of the OVC Tournament for a third year in a row.

The 2006-07 season was another winning one with a record of 18-13 and another trip to the OVC semifinals.

In the 2005-06 season, Samford posted its first 20-win season, finishing with a 21-8 overall record, and the Bulldogs were 15-5 in OVC play. For the first time since joining the league in 2003, the team reached the semifinals of the OVC Tournament.

Morris has increased the team's win total in six of his eight seasons as head coach. In his first season (2002-03), the team won seven games, up from three the previous season. In his second season (2003-04), the Bulldogs posted 10 wins, only the second time in school history that the team posted double-digit wins. The 2004-05 squad won 13 games, and the 2005-06 team won 21 games. In 2007-08, the Bulldogs achieved another program record with 23 wins, up from 18 in 2006-07. The 2009-10 team tied the record for wins, earning 23 on the season.

Morris is in his 18th season overall at Samford, spending nine seasons as an assistant coach on the men's staff. While working with the men's team, Morris served as the team's top recruiter and directed Samford's summer basketball camps. He was on the bench for both Samford Atlantic Sun Championship seasons and NCAA Tournament appearances.

Before his arrival at Samford in 1994, Morris served for three years as an assistant coach under veteran coach Lenny Acuff at Belhaven College. He coached at Belhaven for two seasons before joining Acuff's staff in 1993 at Berry College in Rome, Ga.

In his first year at Belhaven, the Blazers finished with the most wins in nine years, compiling a 17-16 record. The next year, Belhaven went 18-15 and hosted the first round of the NAIA District Playoffs for the first time in 20 years.

Morris played basketball for two seasons at the University of Alabama at Huntsville [UAH], where he was chosen team captain and team MVP his senior season. While at UAH, Morris was the NCAA Division II national champion in free-throw percentage, making 92.1 percent from the line. He played his first two seasons at Jefferson State Junior College in Birmingham.

The Holly Pond, Ala., native earned a B.A. in psychology from Belhaven College in 1992. He has completed 24 hours toward his master's degree in administration from Jacksonville State.

Morris is married to the former Melanie Nix of Huntsville, Ala. They have a son, Peyton, 17, and a daughter, Paige, 14.
