## **TEAM CAMPS**

(limited to teams of players in grades 7–12)

**Session 1: June 11–12**

**Session 2: June 13–14**

**Session 3: June 22–23**

**Session 4: June 29–30**

**\$90/player per session**

**\$200 team deposit per session plus \$50 team fee**

**Check-in: one hour before your team's first game**

**Additional day is \$45/player**

- Each team will play in three or four games per day on one of six on-campus courts.
- Games are officiated by AHSAA referees.
- Each camper receives a T-shirt.
- One all-you-care-to-eat meal is provided each day in the Samford cafeteria.
- Parents and friends are welcome to observe.
- A certified athletic trainer is on-site.

## **FACILITIES**

Bulldog Hoop Team Camp is held on campus in the state-of-the-art Pete Hanna Center and Seibert Hall. Six full-length courts are available for competition. The camp also may use alternative gym sites as needed.
