Playing Site:

All matches are played on the campus of USF at Negroesco Stadium, on the corner of Turk and Parker at the Koret Health and Recreation Center.

Practice Opportunity:

Availability and field conditions permitting, the stadium field will be available for training sessions upon request the day prior to competition. To reserve a time or for any other assistance, please contact Lorraine Gan at (415) 422-2924 at least two weeks prior to the scheduled competition.

Parking:
