## Stephen Negoesco, USF Director of Soccer



Stephen Negoesco has done everything possible to help college soccer grow into the spectacle that it is today. Negoesco is a coaching legend having recorded 544 NCAA wins, by far the most in NCAA history.

A native of Jutland, New Jersey, who grew up in Romania, Negoesco came to

USF and became the West Coast's first All-American in 1949.

As California's winningest Soccer Coach, Steve Negoesco is the only man who can claim *Eight National Championships*, as both a player and a coach.

In 1950, as playing captain of the USF Dons, his team was NCAA Co-Champs. In 1961, as coach of the Hakoah Junior Team of San Francisco, his team won the National Junior Championship. In 1976, he coached the San Francisco Athletic Club team to the National Open Championship, the Dewar Cup, and coached that same team to the Triple Crown State Championship in 1977. In 1966, 1975, 1976, 1978 and 1980, his University of San Francisco Dons won the NCAA Division I Championships. Through 39 seasons as Head Coach of the Dons, Negoesco owns an amazing record of 544-172. He has taken the USF booters into post-season competition 32 times in his 39 years as head coach.

Steve started the San Francisco Junior Soccer League in 1953, and coached in that league from 1953 through 1966, handling as many as eleven teams in one year. He has also conducted coaching clinics throughout the world.

Steve is a believer in the positive effect soccer can have on youngsters. He is very excited about this camp, for it is an opportunity to work with *boys and girls* and help develop both their soccer skills and their self confidence, along with a healthy attitude toward competition.
