ABOUT CAROLINA BASEBALL



MARK KINGSTON

South Carolina won the NCAA Division I Baseball Championship in 2010 and 2011 at the College World Series. The Gamecocks have made 11 College World Series appearances, including six trips in the last 16 years. In the 11 CWS appearances, the Gamecocks are 32-20 for a .615 winning percentage, which is fifth-best among winning percentage leaders in College World Series history. South Carolina is one of five teams to appear in at least 12 Super Regionals since its inception in 1999 and has played 30 Super Regional games, tied for most in SEC history. The Gamecocks own the second-highest win total in Division I baseball since 2000 (826-357 record) and have 321 SEC wins since 2000, tied for most in the conference since the turn of the century. South Carolina has hosted six NCAA Regionals in the past eight years, including Super Regional hosts in 2000, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2011, 2012 and 2016. The Gamecocks usher in the Mark Kingston era this season, as the new head coach comes to Columbia after three seasons at USF, where he guided the Bulls to a pair of regional appearances, and was on staff at Miami for its 2001 National Championship and at Tulane for its College World Series appearance in 2005.



STADIUM TICKETS, REFUNDS/RESALE

The gameday box office is conveniently located next to Gate 1 at Founders Park and will open one and a half hours prior to game time. Tickets cannot be resold at the Founders Park site. Lost or stolen tickets are not the responsibility of management. Additional tickets can be purchased through the box office if available. Admission is complimentary for children ages 2 and under as long as they do not occupy a seat. There is a NO cash refund policy in effect on all tickets. Management reserves the right to refuse admission. For your convenience, ATMs are located near the ticket office and inside the stadium on both the first and third base sides of the concourse.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

Purses larger than a clutch bag (4.5" x 6.5"), briefcases, backpacks, and cinch bags of any kind, fanny packs, luggage of any kind, computer bags/cases, binocular bags/cases or any bag larger than permissible size (12" x 6" x 12") **[Please see Clear Bag Policy]**

- Coolers, thermoses, cups, bottles, cans, flasks, (exception: 1 sealed bottle of water per person)
- Food of any kind
- Video cameras, tripods, recording devices, detachable camera lenses over 6", selfie sticks
- Weapons/concealed weapons
- Alcoholic beverages
- Containers of any kind
- Aerosol and spray cans
- Umbrellas
- Mace/pepper spray
- Animals (except service animals)
- Laser lights, strobe lights and pointers
- Irritants such as artificial noisemakers
- Fireworks/explosives
- Inflatables (beach balls, etc.)
- Flags and flagpoles, unauthorized banners or posters
- Strollers
- Diaper Bags
- Illegal drugs
- Seat cushions that include pockets, zippers, compartments or covers
- Personal seatbacks with armrests
- Masks of any kind
- Drones

CLEAR BAG POLICY

Fans are encouraged not to bring any type of bags inside Founders Park during baseball games; however, the following outlines bags that are permitted:

- One bag that is clear plastic, vinyl or PVC and does not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"
 - An exception may be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection (Gates 1 & 3)
 - A clear bag shall be clear from the top-to-bottom and up to a 2" trim/ border on the bag is generally acceptable.
 - A logo no larger than 4.5" x 3.4" can be displayed on one side of a permissible bag.
- OR
- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bag (Ziploc bag or similar)
- AND
- Small clutch bags, with or without a handle or strap, that do not exceed 4.5" x 6.5" (approximately the size of a hand)

TOBACCO POLICY

Smoking and the use of all tobacco products is prohibited in all University of South Carolina facilities as well as surrounding property owned, leased, or controlled by the University. These restrictions apply to all areas of Founders Park. Electronic cigarettes are subject to the same rules and restrictions as all other forms of tobacco.

TRASH/RECYCLING

The University conveniently places receptacles for the disposal of trash and other items throughout the parking areas and Founders Park. Recycling receptacles are located at stadium gates and throughout the facility. Please help us keep the area enjoyable by disposing of all trash and recyclable items into appropriate containers.

GAMECOCK FANS CODE OF CONDUCT

Gamecock fans are encouraged to wear garnet and black to the games and enthusiastically support the team. Our goal is to create a championship experience with integrity, while exhibiting good sportsmanship and maintaining a safe and respectful atmosphere for the teams and fans to enjoy. The Gamecock image is not only shaped by our student-athletes, coaches, students, and faculty, but by our great fans.

In the spirit of sportsmanship, Gamecock fans shall:

- Conduct themselves in a manner that represents their University, the Southeastern Conference, and the NCAA with honor, dignity, and respect
- Not use vulgar, abusive, racist, sexist, demeaning, or intimidating language at any time
- Support the players, coaches, and officials in a positive manner
- Treat the visiting team, coaches, and fans with courtesy and respect at all times
- Demonstrate the qualities of civility and sportsmanship at all times
- Not engage in cheers that are vulgar, crass, or demeaning
- Refrain from throwing objects onto the field for any reason
- Not become inebriated or belligerent
- Refrain from entering the playing field at any time, including after the game
- Be a positive role model for those around them by treating others with courtesy and respect
- Noncompliance with the code will result in the fan receiving a Code of Conduct Violation card from Event Management. Individuals issued a second card during the same game will be ejected.

GATES

Gates 1 & 4 will open one and a half hours prior to game time. Gates 2 & 3 will open one hour prior.

POLITICAL MATERIALS & SOLICITATIONS

Distribution of political stickers, brochures, and other promotional items is strictly forbidden on properties owned or being leased by the University. Violations will result in the surrender and disposal of said items by University officials.

VENDORS

Soliciting or vending of any goods or services is strictly prohibited in the lots owned or leased by the Athletics Department on gameday.

PARKING

Parking season passes and public gameday parking are available on a limited basis around Founders Park. See included parking map for reference.

GAME DAY SHUTTLES

For the 2018 baseball season, the baseball shuttle will be operational at Lot B of the Colonial Life Arena parking lot and at the Key Road gravel football parking lot. We strongly recommend that fans use the Key Road gravel football parking lot shuttle over the CLA shuttle for the convenience, spacious parking (650 spaces) and less congestion than at the arena. Please remember that at the arena shuttle, parking will be limited to 50 spaces because of the student demand for parking in this area. There is a high student demand Monday thru Thursday due to classes that last until 7:00PM. The shuttle service for Founders Park will be provided from Lot B to the stadium beginning 2 hours before game time. Round-trip shuttle service (\$3.00/passenger/game) from the Colonial Life Arena and Key Road gravel parking lot will be offered before, during, and up to one hour after each home game. Lot B is located near Colonial Life Arena and is bordered by Blossom, Gadsden, Devine, and Lincoln streets. USC students ride for free with their student ID's.

For GPS purposes, the address for the Key Road gravel parking lot is 1105 Key Road, Columbia, SC, 29201.

HANDICAPPED PARKING

Handicapped parking is sold on a season-long basis in Lot 8 for the 2018 season. Lot 1 has handicapped parking on a limited basis for season parking pass holders and for individual games. Those with disabilities should consider parking in the shuttle lot (Lot B is located at Devine and Lincoln St. near Colonial Life Arena or at the Key Road gravel parking lot) and take the handicapped accessible shuttle to

Founders Park. Parking is free and the shuttle service is \$3.00 per person. In select instances parking rates will increase to \$5.00 dollars per vehicle with complimentary shuttle service included, due to conflicting events held within the vicinity.

HANDICAPPED SEATING

Founders Park is ADA accessible with handicapped and wheelchair seating located along the concourse level.

Persons needing ADA seating on an individual game basis must contact the Athletics Ticket Office at (803) 777-4274. Limited seating is available and sold on a first come first served basis.

RV PARKING

There is no RV Parking in Lot B due to high student demand for parking in this area. There is no overnight RV Parking in any South Carolina controlled parking lots. Limited RV parking around Founders Park can be found through an outside provider.

GUEST SERVICES/USHERS

For any guest services needs, please visit the Guest Services kiosk at the centerfield plaza. For information, event staff/ ushers are located on the concourse level throughout the facility.

LOST AND FOUND

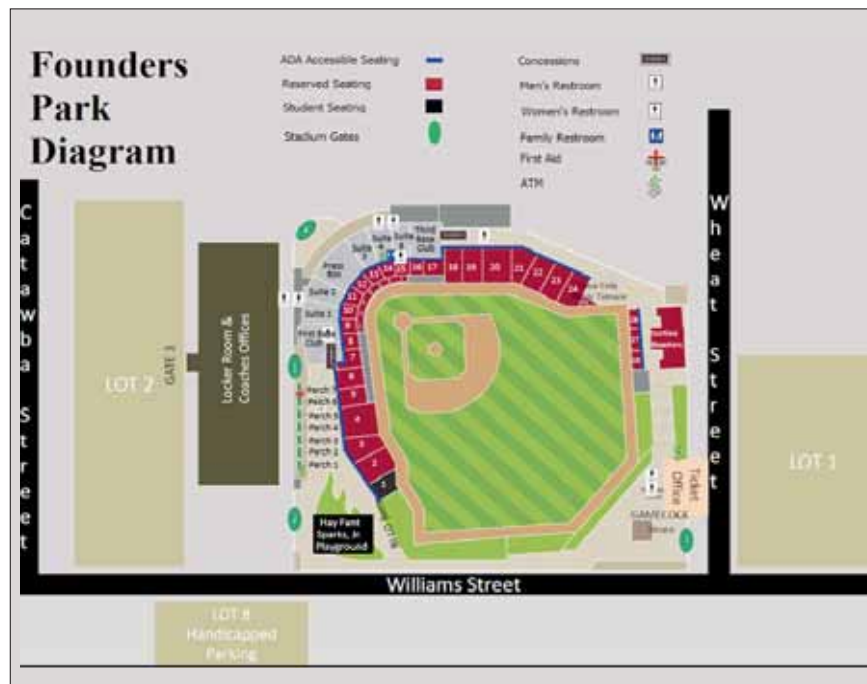
Lost and found for Founders Park will be in the corridor next to the First Aid Station on the main concourse level. Call (803) 777-8506 for assistance.

FIRST AID

The first aid station is located on the main concourse level, adjacent to Sections 5 and 6 on the first base line. If assistance is needed, contact the nearest event staff/ usher for directions to the first aid facility. The medical facility is equipped and staffed as a limited first-aid treatment station. Please be aware of objects leaving the playing field at all times, if necessary seek medical assistance.

FAN HELP TEXT LINE

Report stadium issues, unruly behavior, or requests for help by texting: "USC" <space> issue and location to 69050. Assistance is available one and a half hours before the game and thirty minutes after the game. (Message and Data rates may apply.)



COURTESY ZONE

One of the great features of Founders Park is the ability to view the action from anywhere in the ballpark. The facility is ADA accessible with handicapped and wheelchair seating located along the concourse level. Out of courtesy to season ticket holders, wheelchair patrons and others with mobility issues, a courtesy/no-standing zone has been created for those seated on the last row along the stadium concourse. We appreciate your cooperation in making this seating area accessible at all times.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

In the event that inclement weather approaches Founders Park, public announcements will be made to update fans on the situation. Should a lightning strike occur within 8 miles of the stadium, play will be stopped immediately. Play will resume thirty minutes after the last strike to occur within the 8-mile threat radius. Fans are encouraged to exit the venue and seek shelter in their vehicles during weather delays. All ticket stubs should be kept for re-entry into the ballpark. Updates may also be communicated via radio on 107.5 The Game, or on Gamecock social media platforms. These include @GamecockBaseball and @GamecocksOnline.

PLAYGROUND

The Hay Fant Sparks Jr. Playground is located adjacent to the right field foul line for your family's enjoyment. It includes slides and climbing areas in a shaded area that is lit during the night. Adult supervision is required at all times during playground use.
