**ROTATION**

- > Junior right-hander Jorge Fernandez (0-1, 2.16) will get the start vs. UC Santa Barbara in the series opener. It will be just the fourth start of the year for Fernandez, who suffered his first loss of the season last week at UNLV.
- > Senior lefty Brett Dominic Purpura (6-0, 2.85) will get the call for Saturday's game against the Gauchos.
- > Sunday's starter is TBA.

**PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

- > Junior right fielder David Hensley was named the Mountain West Player of the Week for his performance in four games during the week of April 9-16.
- > Over those four games he hit .647 (11-for-17) with a double, triple, home run, six RBI and seven runs scored.
- > He recorded at least three hits on three of SDSU's four contests last week.
- > Hensley was also selected the Madness Mountain West Player of the week by *CollegeSportsMadness.com*.

**TREJO DOES IT ALL**

- > Alan Trejo has been stellar both at the plate and on the mound in 2017.
- > Over the last six games he is hitting .520 (13-for-25) with a double, home run, seven RBI and eight runs scored
- > He recorded his first win on the mound in the victory over Nevada on April 9, tossing two late scoreless innings.
- > He had an 18-game hitting streak end in the April 2 game vs. San Jose State.
- > During that streak he hit .311 (28-for-90) with six doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI and 19 runs scored.
- > His double in the sixth inning vs. UCLA on April 4 drove home the tying and winning runs in the Aztecs' 5-4 victory.
- > Trejo leads the team in runs scored (37), doubles (12) and stolen bases (9).
- > He has also made 10 appearances on the mound this season and is 1-1 with one save and a 1.38 ERA.

**BROWN STAYS CONSISTENT**

- > Third baseman Andrew Brown continues to be one of the Aztecs' most consistent offensive players.
- > In the final two contests at UNLV last weekend, he had four hits including two doubles and a home run with six RBI.
- > He had a nine-game hitting streak end on April 8 vs. Nevada. During that streak he went 14-for-38 (.368) with a double, triple, nine RBI and five runs scored.
- > He had a seven-game hitting streak earlier in the season that ended in the series finale vs. Cal Poly on March 5.
- > During that streak he batted .355 (11-for-31) with two doubles, a home run, six RBI and five runs scored.

**ADKISON MAKES HIS MARK**

- > Outfielder Tyler Adkison was named a second team Perfect Game/Rawlings Midseason All-American. He has also been added to the 40-player watch list for the Golden Spikes Award, presented to the top amateur player in the country.
- > He has hit safely in seven of the last eight games with two doubles and four home runs.
- > He hit his team-leading 11th home run of the season in the contest at UC Riverside on Tuesday (April 18).
- > He was one of the hottest hitters in the nation over a 10-game span from March 11-26.
- > In those 10 contests, he batted .649 (24-for-37) with four doubles, a triple, six home runs, 23 RBI and 16 runs scored.
- > His slugging percentage over that span was 1.297 and he had a .723 on-base mark in those games.
- > Adkison set an SDSU record by reaching base 15 consecutive times (via either a hit or walk) from March 18 to March 25. In those four games, he had four singles, three doubles, a triple, 2 HR and five walks.
- > His 10 consecutive hits over that span was also a new SDSU record.
- > In the contest at Nevada on March 11, he hit two home runs. The last time an Aztec had two homers in a game prior to that was when Adkison hit a pair at Air Force on March 20, 2016.

**VERDON GETS ON BASE**

- > First baseman Jordan Verdon has reached base safely (via hit, walk or hit by pitch) in each of SDSU's last 25 contests.
- > He ranks among the top 10 in the nation in triples and sacrifice flies.
- > He has hit safely in seven of the past eight contests, going 13-for-30 (.433) with a double, triple, six RBI and six runs scored.
- > He had a seven-game hitting streak end on March 21 in the game against Long Beach State. During that streak he hit .345 (10-for-29) with a home run, seven RBI and six runs scored.
- > Verdon had a personal season-best eight-game streak earlier in the year.
- > During that streak he went 13-for-37 (.351) with a double, two triples, five RBI and six runs scored.
- > He has not committed an error this season after 38 games (388 chances).

**CALABUIG HEATING UP**

- > Outfielder Chase Calabuig has hit safely in 12 of SDSU's last 13 games.
- > He has the team's longest current hitting streak at eight games.
- > During that streak he is hitting .412 (14-for-34) with a double, two home runs, six RBI and six runs scored.
- > Over SDSU's past 11 games he is hitting .400 (18-for-45) with three doubles and two home runs.
- > He had a career-high four hits in the contest at UC Riverside on Tuesday (April 18).

**ERICKSON PROVIDES RELIEF**

- > Junior left-hander Jacob Erickson has been impressive out of the bullpen this season as a middle reliever.
- > He tossed one perfect inning at UC Riverside on Tuesday (April 18), recording two strikeouts.
- > Despite surrendering three earned runs last week in two appearances at UNLV, his ERA stands at 1.97.
- > He has walked six and struck out 17 over 32.0 innings.
- > He picked up his fourth win of the year on April 2 vs. San Jose State.
- > Three of his victories have come in relief with the other in a start at Long Beach State.
- > Erickson has been involved in three of the Aztecs' four shutout wins in 2017.

**SHEEHAN HITS AWAY**

- > After redshirting during the 2016 season, senior Danny Sheehan has returned for his final year and claimed the starting shortstop role he held in 2015.
- > He currently appears on 75-player the watch list for the Brooks Wallace Award presented to the nation's top shortstop.
- > In last weekend's final two games at UNLV (April 15-16), he went 5-for-10 with three doubles, a home run, four RBI and five runs scored.
- > On Tuesday at UC Riverside, he had a hit, walk and scored a pair of runs.
- > He had a 13-game hitting streak end on April 3 vs. San Francisco and he has now hit safely in 19 of the last 22 contests.
- > During his 13-game hitting streak, he went 18-for-46 (.391) with six doubles, nine RBI and 10 runs scored.
- > Sheehan has been hit by pitch 13 times this season to bring his career total to 26. That ranks seventh on the SDSU all-time top 20 in that category.

**NEVAREZ COMES THROUGH**

- > In SDSU's last five games, catcher Dean Nevarez is hitting .600 (9-for-15) with three doubles, a triple, home run, 10 RBI and eight runs scored.
- > His RBI single in the eighth inning on April 9 vs. Nevada tied the contest, and he would score the winning run later in the inning.
- > He is hitting .378 in conference play with 18 RBI in the 15 games (10 starts) in which he has appeared.
- > Nevarez's first two home runs this season came in the series finale against UNLV in San Diego on March 19.
- > He is the second Aztec to homer twice in a game this season as Tyler Adkison accomplished the feat against Nevada in Reno on March 11.

**SAYLOR STANDS TALL ON THE MOUND**

- > Senior right-hander CJ Saylor has recorded nine saves along with a win this season as the Aztecs' closer.
- > He threw one scoreless inning on Tuesday at UC Riverside as he struck out three of the four batters he faced.
- > The last seven outs he has recorded (and eight of nine) have been via the strikeout.
- > His latest save came on Friday (April 7) when he pitched a perfect ninth inning in the 6-3 win over Nevada.
- > Saylor's ERA now stands at 1.64 and opponents are hitting .182 against him.
- > He has recorded 17 strikeouts and one walk in his last 9.1 innings pitched.

**PURPURA IMPRESSIVE**

- > Senior left-hander Dominic Purpura picked up his sixth win of the season against no defeats on April 15 at UNLV.
- > In that contest he allowed one run on five hits with a walk and four strikeouts in seven innings.
- > He recorded his fifth win of the year against no defeats in the 7-3 win over San Jose State on Saturday, April 1.
- > In that contest turned in SDSU's first complete game of the year as he allowed three runs (one earned) on nine hits with a walk and two strikeouts.
- > His six strikeouts in his first appearance of the year vs. Pacific on Feb. 19 also tied his SDSU career high.

**BIBLE RETURNS**

- > In the contest at Long Beach State on March 21, sophomore outfielder Chad Bible made just his second appearance since beginning chemotherapy treatment for Hodgkin's lymphoma that was diagnosed in January.
- > As a pinch hitter in the bottom of the eighth in the contest vs. Long Beach State March 21, he doubled down the right field line to drive home SDSU's final run in the victory over LBSU.
- > Bible started in left field in each of SDSU's first five contests this season, going 6-for-20 with a double and an RBI.
- > He also made a pinch-hitting appearance on March 7 vs. USC and is now batting .318 in the seven games he has played.

**PITCHING LEADS THE WAY**

- > Over the past 16 games, the SDSU pitching staff has posted a 12-4 record with a 2.76 earned run average.
- > Opponents have hit .241 over those 16 contests.
- > Included in that run are a shutout victory and two one-run wins.

**PLAYER OF THE WEEK I**

- > Junior outfielder Tyler Adkison was named the Mountain West Player of the Week for his performance in SDSU's four games during the week of March 14-20.
- > In the contest at USD (March 14) and three-games vs. UNLV (March 17-19), he batted .688 (11-for-16) with three doubles, three home runs and 11 RBI.
- > He compiled a 1.438 slugging percentage and a .737 on-base average in the four games.
- > His homers came in three different contests and he struck out only once in 19 plate appearances.
- > Adkison was also named the Madness Mountain West Player of the Week by *CollegeSportsMadness.com*.

**PLAYER OF THE WEEK II**

- > Outfielder Tyler Adkison made it back-to-back Mountain West Player of the Week awards when he earned the honor for games played March 20-26.
- > In SDSU's four games that week, Adkison (Culver City, Calif., Mater Dei HS) hit .538 with a triple, home run, seven walks and seven RBI.
- > He compiled a 1.048 slugging percentage and a .700 on-base mark.

**PITCHER OF THE WEEK**

- > Senior lefty Brett Seeburger earned his first conference Pitcher of the Week award for his performance in the second game of Saturday's (March 25) doubleheader at Fresno State.
- > In that contest, he tossed a one hit shutout over eight innings, allowing just an infield single and facing one batter over the minimum.
- > Seeburger retired the first 14 batters he faced before allowing a two-out infield single in the bottom of the fifth inning. He went on to retire the next 10 batters through the eighth inning.
- > Over his eight innings of work, he struck out a season-high seven batters and did not allow a walk.
- > For his effort Seeburger was also selected a National Player of the Week by *Collegiate Baseball* and the Madness Mountain West Baseball Player of the Week by *CollegeSportsMadness.com*.

**AZTECS AMONG THE NATIONAL LEADERS**

**AZTECS DEFEAT NO. 7 CAL STATE FULLERTON**

- > On Tuesday, Feb. 21, the Aztecs did something they had not done since 1977: win a game at Cal State Fullerton as they defeated the Titans, 5-4, at Goodwin Field.
- > Since claiming a win in 1977, SDSU had played 15 contests in Fullerton without a victory.
- > Freshman Hayden Petrovick picked up the win with three late scoreless innings and senior CJ Saylor notched his first save of the year.

**SUMMER HONORS**

- > Fifteen of SDSU's 19 returning players played summer baseball in 2016 in order to hone their talents, and three of them came away with various honors.
- > Brett Seeburger was named a Second Team Summer Collegiate Baseball All-American by Perfect Game after going 5-1 with a 1.01 earned run average for the Brazos Valley Bombers in the Texas Collegiate League.
- > Chase Calabuig (Dodge City A's) was a first-team all-Jayhawk League honoree and the league's Hitter of the Year.
- > Hunter Stratton was named to the Great West League South All-Star Team as a member of the Marysville Gold Sox.

**NEW STAFF**

- > The Aztecs have made just one staff change for the 2017 season with the addition of former SDSU player Brandon Decker as Director of Player Personnel.
- > Decker was an infielder and outfielder at San Diego state for four seasons (2007-10) before going on to play professional baseball for two years.
- > For the past two seasons, he has been at USD serving as Torero baseball's Director of Player Personnel.

**PRESEASON ALL-CONFERENCE**

- > Senior left-handed pitcher Dominic Purpura was tabbed to the Preseason All-Mountain West team in a vote of the league's coaches.
- > Purpura had an overall record of 4-2 with a 3.25 earned run average, leading the Aztecs in innings pitched at 69.1.

**DRAFTED AZTECS**

- > Three current members of the SDSU squad have been drafted by Major League clubs.
- > That trio includes junior pitcher CJ Saylor (33rd rd. in 2012, Los Angeles Dodgers) along with junior outfielder Denzil Chapman (32nd rd. in 2014, Oakland A's) and sophomore first baseman Jordan Verdon (24th rd. in 2015, New York Mets).

**AZTECS PICKED FOURTH**

- > San Diego State was picked to finish fourth in the Mountain West in the annual poll of the league's head coaches.

**AZTEC NOTES**

- > After opening the season with a 3-4 record, San Diego State is 24-7 in its last 31 contests.
- > The Aztecs have not lost more than two games in a row this season and that has occurred on two occasions (Feb. 24 and 25 vs. Tennessee and Seton Hall; March 26 and 28 at Fresno State and at USC).
- > SDSU saw its longest win streak of the season (six games) end on April 8 against Nevada.
- > Over the last 16 contests, the Aztecs are hitting .332 to .241 by opponent. They also have a team ERA of 2.76 while opponents' ERA is 7.25.
- > The Aztecs are 22-0 when leading after six innings, 24-1 when leading after seven and 27-0 when leading after eight.
- > SDSU has committed 27 errors in its first 38 contests for a .982 fielding percentage. The team record for fielding percentage in a season is .978 set during the 2013 campaign.
- > Logan Boyer has allowed no runs on just two hits with 11 strikeouts over his last eight relief appearances (10.1 innings). He tossed a perfect sixth innings and picked up his first win in the victory against UCLA on April 4.
- > Andrew Brown is hitting .429 (21-for-49) with runners in scoring position while Danny Sheehan is at .425 (17-for-40).
- > Junior David Hensley's 17 career sacrifice bunts tie him for 11th on the SDSU career top 20 in that category.
- > Sophomore Jordan Verdon's 11 career sacrifice flies tie him for 12th on the SDSU career top 20 list.
- > Dominic Purpura's 2.32 earned run average in league games leads the conference this week.
