### NEWS AND NOTES Through games of Wednesday, Dec. 27

- San Diego State will open its home portion of its Mountain West schedule on Saturday night when it plays host to Utah State on Steve Fisher Court at Viejas Arena. The game will stream exclusively on ESPN3 beginning at 7 p.m. PT. Ted Leitner will provide the details on radio (101.5 KGB, XTRA 1360, FOX Sports IE 1350) in Southern California and on the iHeart Radio app.
- The Aztecs are looking to rid themselves of the aftertaste of Wednesday's 82-69 road loss at Wyoming. SDSU led at halftime, 40-37, and was up, 48-43, in the opening minutes of the second half. The Cowboys, however, shot 55.2 percent from the floor after halftime, helped by a 7-for-12 effort from behind the three-point arc to emerge victorious.
- San Diego State played the game at Wyoming without the services of junior **Jeremy Hemsley** due to an illness. The guard went through warm-ups, but found himself in the locker room by the time the game started. Hemsley entered the contest having started 60 of 80 career games played and a career scoring average of 11.9.
- Senior **Malik Pope** led the Aztecs with one of his best performances of his career. The forward and team co-captain scored a season-high 21 points on a personal-best 10 made field goals and was 10-for-18 on his two-point field-goal attempts (.556). Pope also added nine rebounds, one blocked shot and one steal in 35 minutes.
- Junior **Devin Watson** broke out of a shooting slump to contribute 13 points in Laramie. The guard from Oceanside was 4-for-8 from the floor, including a 3-for-4 effort from three-point distance, after he entered the game having made just six of his 29 field-goal attempts (2-14 3FG) in his previous three games. Watson also contributed a team-high four assists.
- Freshman **Matt Mitchell** continued his strong start to his college career, reaching double figures in scoring for the eighth time in nine games after he finished with 11 points. Averaging 11.3 points for the season, Mitchell has been a reliable threat from downtown, knocking down a team-best 23 treys. On Wednesday at Wyoming, he made a trio of three-pointers (3-6 3FG), marking the third straight game he has made three from behind the arc. After starting his career by missing his first 10 three-point attempts, Mitchell has responded by making 23 of his last 51 (.451).
- Redshirt freshman **Jalen McDaniels** made his first career start vs. the Cowboys. The forward finished with six points, a team-high 10 rebounds, one assist and one steal in 27 minutes. McDaniels has three double-digit rebounding performances in his last four outings and is averaging 9.0 rebounds during that span. He also has two double-doubles during this time period, including a 15-point, 10-rebound effort in last week's win vs. then-No. 12/15 Gonzaga.
- San Diego State will look to get back to win column against a program it has never lost to since it joined the Mountain West ahead of the 2013-14 campaign. The Aztecs are 9-0 vs. Utah State since it became a member of the league and have outscored the Aggies at home by 69 points in four games (17.3-point average margin of victory).
- The Aztecs have yet to lose two games in a row and have responded from their previous three losses with victories. Twice this season, the game immediately after a loss occurred at home, while the other took place within city limits (at San Diego).
- SDSU is 9-3 overall vs. Utah State and 4-1 in Cox/Viejas Arena. Last year's final meeting was the one of the closest of the Mountain West era when the Aztecs used a late 10-0 run to help them escape the confines of Dee Glen Smith Spectrum with the 66-62 victory. In that game, **Trey Kell** put up 21 points and seven rebounds, and Hemsley added 13 points.

# San Diego State Aztecs

- The Aztecs have won at least 19 games 12 straight years, which is tied for the 10th-longest active streak in the nation.
- San Diego State has advanced to postseason play in 11 of the last 12 seasons (2006 NCAA, 2007-09 NIT, 2010-15 NCAA, 2016 NIT).

**Trends:**

- SDSU is 11th nationally in winning percentage since the beginning of 2010-11, trailing Gonzaga, Wichita St., Kansas, Kentucky, Duke, Ariz., L'ville, Saint Mary's, UNC and Villanova.
- San Diego State has won 60 straight games when shooting 50 percent or better from the field.

# - Wooden Legacy (Titan Gym; Fullerton, Calif.), \* - Mountain West game, + - MW Championship (Thomas & Mack Center; Las Vegas, Nev.)

### SERIES HISTORY VS. UTAH STATE

- The Aztecs lead the all-time series, 9-3, having won all nine meetings with Utah State as a member of the Mountain West.
- Prior to the 2013-14 season, Utah State's first year in the MW, the teams had not met since Nov. 24, 1998, when Utah State earned a 63-60 win at what was then known as Cox Arena (now Viejas Arena).
- In SDSU's nine victories during the Mountain West era, San Diego State has averaged only 9.7 turnovers. Utah State, on the other hand, has averaged 13.9 turnovers.
- In the last nine meetings, San Diego State has held the Aggies to 38.6-percent shooting from the floor.
- The series started on Dec. 17, 1962, with Utah State registering a 101-57 victory in Logan.

### GONE-ZAGA

- San Diego State's win vs. then No. 12/15 Gonzaga snapped the Bulldog's 12-game road winning streak, which was the longest among all Division I schools.
- It was also the highest-ranked AP Top 25 team the Aztecs had defeated since Jan. 14, 2012, when they downed No. 12 UNLV, and it was the highest-ranked non-conference AP Top 25 foe they had beaten since they won at No. 11 Gonzaga on Nov. 16, 2010.

### SDSU VS. THE AP TOP 25

- SDSU is 8-8 over the last five seasons vs. teams ranked in the AP Top 25 Poll.
- In home games vs. teams ranked in the AP poll, the Aztecs are 6-2 in their last eight.
- San Diego State is 2-2 over the last four seasons on the road vs. AP-ranked teams

### BALANCED SCORING

- San Diego State currently has four players averaging double figures in scoring (Devin Watson - 13.1, Malik Pope - 13.0, Trey Kell - 11.9, Matt Mitchell - 11.3). The Aztecs have not finished a season with four double-digit scorers since the 2010-11 campaign (Kawhi Leonard - 15.5, Malcolm Thomas - 11.4, D.J. Gay - 10.3, Billy White - 10.3). That team won the Mountain West championship, advanced to the Sweet 16 and finished with a 34-3 record.

### SECRET SOCIETY

- Malik Pope is one of 12 players nationally that is averaging at least 13.0 points and 7.0 rebounds, while shooting at least 52.0 percent

from the floor and 40.0 percent from three (min. 20 3FGA), through Dec. 27 games.

- Pope is the only one of the 12 who plays west of the state of Texas.

### MATT MITCH3LL

■ Matt Mitchell has 23 three-pointers to his credit and that comes after an 0-for-10 start from behind the arc to begin his college career. Among true freshmen nationally, standing at least 6-6, his season total is tied for the fifth most nationally (first out West), through Dec. 27 games.

### CRASHING THE BOARDS

■ Jalen McDaniels' 13-rebound effort vs. Sacramento State occurred in the freshman's fifth game of his career. It marked the fastest double-figure rebounding performance to start a career since Skylar Spencer accomplished the feat in his fifth game in 2012-13.

■ McDaniels' two double-digit rebounding efforts in his first nine games of his career is the best performance by a freshman since Kawhi Leonard had three in his first nine games back in 2009-10.

### CASHING IN

■ The Aztecs are shooting 74.0 percent from the free-throw line, which would surpass the Division I school record of 72.8 (2005-06).

■ SDSU is 205-for-277 from the line compared to its foe's effort of 133-for-183.

### LOTS OF HEAD SHAKING

■ SDSU has made its living on the defensive end and this season the Aztecs have left their opponents shaking their heads after shots. San Diego State is limiting its foes to 39.5-percent shooting. That would rank just outside of the top 5 in SDSU Division I history.

■ The Aztecs are holding opponents to 30.8-percent shooting from three-point distance. That ranks fourth in Division I school history.

### THREE AMIGOS

■ Devin Watson's 26-point, 5-steal effort at San Diego put him in a select group in recent SDSU history. The junior joined Jason Richey (Dec. 3, 1996) and Jamaal Franklin (Dec. 30, 2011) as the only players to put up at least 25 points and five steals in a single game.

■ At the end of the night in Linda Vista, Watson was the ninth Division I player to accomplish the feat this season.

### QUICKER TEMPO

■ San Diego State ranks 70th nationally in adjusted tempo, according to KenPom.com (through Dec. 27). That number is a huge improvement over the last several seasons when the Aztecs ranked 309th last year (2016-17) and 321st the season before (2015-16). Since 2007-08, SDSU's average ranking in adjusted tempo has been 263rd nationally.

### PART OF THE LEGACY

■ Devin Watson and Trey Kell etched their names in the Wooden Legacy record book with their all-tournament team appointment. Watson in three games averaged a team-best 17.0 points, while adding 3.0 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 1.3 steals. Kell, meanwhile, averaged 14.3 points, 4.7 rebounds, 3.3 assists and 1.7 steals. Combined, they were 20-for-26 from the free-throw line.

■ Jalen McDaniels (7.0 ppg, 7.3 rpg), Matt Mitchell (12.0 ppg, 4.7 rpg) and Malik Pope (6.7 ppg, 4.3 rpg) were named to the Wooden Legacy honorable mention list.

### QUIETING UGA

■ SDSU defeated Georgia in the semifinals of the Wooden Legacy and in the process, picked up its first win over a current SEC school since Dec. 21, 1985, when it beat Florida in Las Vegas.

■ SDSU rallied from a 12-point first-half deficit to earn the hard-fought 75-68 victory 18 hours after beating Sacramento State.

■ The win marked the Aztecs' third vs. a current SEC school. They also defeated Missouri in San Diego on Dec. 21, 1978.

### TOURNAMENT SUCCESS

■ San Diego State, which won the 2016 Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic last season, has experienced success in 8-team tournament events. SDSU is 15-3 in those type of events since the start of the 2008-09 campaign after going 2-1 at the 2017 Wooden Legacy.

■ During the current run, Aztecs have played for the title all six times, winning the 2009 Great Alaska Shootout, the 2013 Wooden Legacy and the 2016 Diamond Head Classic. SDSU fell short in the '12 Diamond Head, the '14 Maui Invitational and the '17 Wooden.

■ Next season, the Aztecs will be part of the 2018 Maui Invitational field that includes Arizona, Auburn, Duke, Gonzaga, Illinois, Iowa State and Xavier.

### NEW TO YOU, BUT NOT TO SDSU

■ Although new to head coaching at SDSU, Brian Dutcher is no stranger to the university or the program. The 19th-year Aztec coach experienced 386 victories and 10 Mountain West titles while atop Montezuma Mesa in the 18 seasons with Steve Fisher at the wheel.

■ In those 18 years, Dutcher also helped the Aztecs to 13 postseason tournaments, including eight NCAA appearances and a pair of Sweet 16 berths (2011, 2014).

### ALL-AROUND PERFORMANCE

■ Jeremy Hemsley turned in 10 points, six assists and three steals, while committing just one turnover in 22 minutes vs. San Diego Christian. He is the 11th Aztec to have at least that stat line in a game since at least 1996-97, and the first to do so since Chase Tapley vs. Bryant on Nov. 11, 2011.

■ He is the second Aztec to accomplish the feat while playing less than 30 minutes, joining Chad Nelson, who did it on Jan. 25, 1997, in 25 minutes vs. Hawai'i.

## STAR-STUDED COMPANY

- Matt Mitchell received the starting nod for Brian Dutcher, making him the first true freshman since Jeremy Hemsley to start in their debut. Hemsley was later named Mountain West Freshman of the Year and is a two-time all-conference selection. Prior to Hemsley, Trey Kell earned the nod in his first game at SDSU and has become a two-time all-MW performer.
- Mitchell is just the 15th freshman to start a season-opening game with Dutcher on the bench, dating back to the 1988-89 campaign, and the 10th while Dutcher has been at SDSU. The others are Juwan Howard, Jalen Rose, Chris Webber, Jerod Ward, Albert White, Bradley Jackson, Steve Sir, Brandon Heath, Richie Williams, D.J. Gay, Tim Shelton, Kawhi Leonard, Kell and Hemsley.

## HEMSLEY CLOSING IN ON A GRAND

- Jeremy Hemsley is quickly closing in on 1,000 points for his career. In 80 career games, the junior has scored 948 points. Once he hits the milestone, he will be the 32nd member of the Aztecs' 1,000-point club and the first since Trey Kell (Feb. 12, 2017).

## HIGH-END EXPERIENCE

- The Aztecs welcomed six new players to the roster, but two came loaded with high-level experience in Devin Watson and Kameron Rooks. The childhood friends from North San Diego County transferred to SDSU from a pair of Bay Area schools (Watson - San Francisco; Rooks - California).
- Watson brought 61 career games, including 47 starts, with him to the table, while Rooks saw action in 83 games (20 starts) and played in the NCAA tournament (2016) and the NIT (2017).

## POINTS ON POINTS ON POINTS

- San Diego State scored 98 points in the exhibition vs. UCSD. The Aztecs scored more than that once last season (100 vs. Savannah State). Outside of that, SDSU scored more than 80 points three other times (San Diego Christian, vs. Tulsa, vs. Boise State) in 2016-17.
- So far this season, the Aztecs have hit the 75-point plateau seven times.
- The last three seasons, the Aztecs have averaged 61.8 points per game in 2014-15, 68.6 in 2015-16, and 68.5 in 2016-17.
- The school record for points per game for an entire season is 86.9, which occurred in SDSU's first season as a Division I member (1970-71). San Diego State is currently averaging 77.5 points.

## AZTEC STAPLE: DEFENSE

- SDSU has been one of the elite defensive teams in the nation over the last few seasons and this year they returned six letterwinners off a team that finished eighth in the nation in field-goal percentage defense and 15th in scoring defense. Both were tops in the MW.
- According to KenPom.com, SDSU ranks 30th defensive adjusted efficiency and 55th in defensive effective field-goal percentage (through Dec. 27 games).
- 2013-14 ranks: 2nd in scoring defense, 6th in scoring margin, 8th in field-goal percentage defense.
- 2014-15 ranks: 2nd in scoring defense, 7th in field-goal percentage defense, 24th in blocked shots.
- 2015-16 ranks: 1st in field-goal percentage defense, 3rd in scoring defense, 10th in blocked shots.
- 2016-17 ranks: 8th in field-goal percentage defense, 15th in scoring defense, 34th in blocked shots.

## TOUGH OUT AT HOME

- SDSU has been one of the hardest teams to beat at home since the start of the 2005-06 campaign.

■ Included in that stretch are victories at Kansas, at Arizona, at Gonzaga, at New Mexico (four times), at UNLV (nine times), at California, at Utah State (twice), at Utah and at USC. Also included are neutral court victories over UCLA, California (twice), Marquette, Creighton, Georgia, New Mexico, BYU (twice), Oklahoma, Pittsburgh and St. John's.

### STREAKING THROUGH CALIFORNIA

- SDSU had won 47 straight games vs. teams from the state of California, a streak that dated to Dec. 2, 2009, before falling at Fresno State, 59-57, on Jan. 3, 2015.
- The Aztecs are now 65-7 in their last 72 vs. California schools and 53-2 in their last 55 vs. non-league California teams (53-1 in last 54 in games played indoors).
- San Diego State has also beaten seven Pac-12 schools during this remarkable run.
- The 47-game winning streak vs. California schools was the longest active streak in the country ahead of second-place BYU (22 straight vs. Colorado teams) and Pittsburgh (22 straight vs. Pennsylvania teams).

### NICE RUN

- San Diego State is a member of the California State University system and it had won 22 straight home games against CSU schools dating to the 2000-01 campaign. The streak ended on Feb. 22, 2017, when Fresno State earned a 63-55 victory. Prior to the defeat, the Aztecs' last loss to a Cal State school at home happened back on Jan. 5, 2000, against Cal State Fullerton.
- SDSU has also won 22 consecutive non-conference games vs. its fellow CSU institutions. The Aztecs have not suffered a loss since Nov. 27, 2000, at Fresno State (WAC).

### PRETTY GOOD WHEN LOW ON TIME

- The Aztecs have been good at preparing when short on time. When there is less than 24 hours to prepare, SDSU is 18-2 in its last 20 regular-season tries.

### ATOP THE MOUNTAIN

- Since the beginning of the Mountain West in 1999-00, San Diego State has the most men's basketball championships than any other current member of the league, which is a remarkable feat considering the Aztecs went 0-14 in league play the first season (1999-2000) and 4-10 the second year (2000-01). Here is the list of current Mountain West schools with their regular-season championships (includes ties) and tournament championships: 1. San Diego State 10, 2. New Mexico 8, t-3. UNLV 3, t-3. Wyoming 3, 5. Nevada 2, t-6. Air Force 1, t-6. Colorado State 1, t-6. Boise State 1, t-6. Fresno State 1.

### AZTECS PICKED SECOND IN MW PRESEASON POLL/KELL NAMED PRESEASON ALL-MW

- SDSU was picked to finish second in the Mountain West media poll. It marked the 13th consecutive year in which San Diego State was picked to finish in the top four of the MW preseason poll and the fourth year in a row that it has been selected either first or second.
- SDSU earned 229 points and two first-place votes and trailed only Nevada (257 points; 19 first-place votes). The Aztecs, however, were ahead of third-place Boise State (211; 2), fourth-place Fresno State (188) and fifth-place Colorado State (154). The remaining first-place tally went to UNLV, which was predicted to finish sixth (138). The rest of the poll: Wyoming (7th; 133), Utah State (8th; 102), New Mexico (9th; 93), San José State (10th; 41), Air Force (11th; 38).
- Trey Kell was named a preseason all-Mountain West selection at the conference's media summit in Las Vegas in October. With the recognition, he became just the third Aztec to be named to the preseason team multiple times in MW history, joining Brandon Heath (2005-06, 2006-07) and Winston Shepard (2014-15, 2015-16).

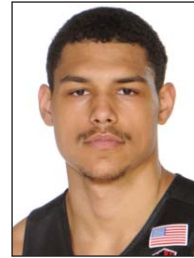

# BRIAN DUTCHER

Head Coach

1st Season • 19th Season Overall at SDSU • Minnesota, 1982

Brian Dutcher, a long-time San Diego State men's basketball assistant coach, is entering his first season as head coach following Steve Fisher's retirement announcement on April 11, 2017. Dutcher, who was on Montezuma Mesa for all of Fisher's 18 seasons, held the title of associate head coach/head coach in waiting the previous six years and is the program's 15th head coach.

Over the course of his time at San Diego State, Dutcher helped the Aztecs reach the postseason 13 times, including eight trips to the NCAA tournament, win a conference-best 10 Mountain West titles and record 12 seasons of at least 20 victories.

Since 2008-09, Dutcher and SDSU twice advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 (2011, 2014) and NIT semifinal round (2009, 2016), won at least 25 games seven times and captured seven MW championships (five regular season, two tournament).

Dutcher arrived at SDSU shortly after Fisher was hired on March 26, 1999. In his first year in "America's Finest City," the Aztecs won only five games, but improved upon their win total from the season before. After that, San Diego State posted a 14-14 record in 2000-01, before winning the 2002 MW Championship, earning an NCAA tournament bid and finishing with a 21-12 record. The 2002-03 campaign saw SDSU receive an NIT invitation, which culminated in the program's first Division I postseason victory.

After helping attract the first McDonald's All-American to the 2002-03 squad, Dutcher assisted in securing the signatures of future starters and all-league performers Brandon Heath and Marcus Slaughter. The duo started their first two seasons on The Mesa, leading to the 2005-06 season that produced the school's first Mountain West regular-season and tournament title sweep.

The Aztecs advanced to the NCAA tournament and ultimately won a then-school-record 24 games. That appearance led to a string of 10 consecutive postseason berths.

From the 2006-07 campaign through 2008-09, San Diego State registered 20 or more wins and went to three straight NITs. In 2009, the Aztecs advanced to the NIT semifinals and broke the previous school record with 26 victories.

The run to the NIT semifinals was a springboard to the most successful run in SDSU basketball history. Led by future NBA first-round draft pick and NBA champion Kawhi Leonard, the 2009-10 Aztecs won the MW Championship, advanced to the NCAA tournament and fell four points shy of moving on to the second round before finishing with a 25-9 record.

The NCAA experience from the 2009-10 squad proved fruitful in 2010-11 when it returned all five starters, including Leonard, and a freshman named Jamaal Franklin, who would turn out to be a future MW Player of the Year and NBA draft selection. With Dutcher on staff, SDSU won its first 20 games of the year, shared the MW regular-season title and captured the MW tournament crown. The Aztecs moved on to the NCAA tournament as a No. 2 seed and won the program's first Division I NCAA tournament game. San Diego State, which was ranked as high as No. 4 and received first-place votes at one point in the season, advanced to the Sweet 16 and fell to the eventual national champion, finishing with a school-record 34 wins, a mark that still stands today. The Aztecs' also found themselves in the final top-25 polls, ranking sixth in the AP and 11th in the USA Today Coaches Poll.

Five months after SDSU's record-setting 2010-11 campaign, the University elevated Dutcher from associate head coach to associate head coach/head coach in waiting.

In his first season with his new title, Dutcher and the Aztecs advanced to the 2011-12 NCAA tournament as an at-large team and recorded 26 wins. The next season, SDSU was again an at-large selection to the 2013 NCAA tournament, moved on to the round of 32 for the second time in three years and finished with 23 victories.

Another NCAA Sweet 16 run was in the cards in Dutcher's third season as the head coach in waiting. The Aztecs opened the season by winning 21 of their first 22 games, including 20 in a row at one point, and were led by seniors Xavier Thames, who would become an NBA draft pick, and Josh Davis. SDSU won the program's second outright Mountain West regular-season title and later swept through two games in Spokane, Washington, to secure its second Sweet 16 appearance in four seasons. San Diego State compiled 31 wins and finished the season ranked 13th in the AP and 12th in the Coaches after rising to as high as fifth nationally in both polls.

The 2014-15 campaign saw the Aztecs spend their fifth straight season in the top 25. In the process of winning 27 games, San Diego State grabbed its second straight MW regular-season crown and earned an at-large invitation to the NCAA tournament where they defeated St. John's in the round of 64. One season later, the Aztecs found themselves in the NIT after winning the MW by three games with a 16-2 record. Nevertheless, San Diego State won three games and qualified for the NIT national semifinals, eventually logging 28 victories.

More recently, San Diego State completed the 2016-17 slate with a 19-14 record despite experiencing a rash of injuries. The 2016 Hawaiian Airlines Diamond Head Classic champions will enter 2017-18 as one of 12 teams to have won at least 19 games in 12 consecutive seasons.

Before Dutcher arrived at San Diego State, he served as assistant coach and later associate head coach at Michigan under Fisher. He spent 10 seasons on the Wolverine staff, establishing himself as one of the nation's top assistant coaches. His first year in Ann Arbor was 1989 and resulted in a national title for Michigan as he assisted then-interim head coach Fisher on the bench.

The Bloomington, Minn., native led UM's recruiting efforts in 1990-91 when the Wolverines inked Juwan Howard, Ray Jackson, Jimmy King, Jalen Rose and Chris Webber. The "Fab Five" is considered perhaps the best recruiting class in NCAA history. Dutcher helped lead that group to nearly 100 wins, two berths in the NCAA championship game and a regional final over a four-year period. He was also on the Michigan staff for an NIT championship (1997).

Dutcher's recruiting prowess, however, was demonstrated by more than just the "Fab Five" haul. Michigan had the nation's top-ranked recruiting class in 1993-94 and in 1994-95, with a group that included Maurice Taylor and Jerod Ward. The accomplishment marked the first time that a university had the nation's top class in consecutive years, according to recruiting analyst Bob Gibbons.

Dutcher was born Oct. 30, 1959, in Alpena, Mich. He attended Jefferson High School in Bloomington, Minn., and went on to earn a bachelor's degree in physical education from Minnesota in 1982. While an undergraduate, he worked for his father, then-Gopher head coach Jim Dutcher. He then spent one season in the prep ranks at Apple Valley (Minn.) High School before becoming a graduate assistant at Illinois, where he earned his master's degree in physical education and athletic administration.

While in Champaign, Dutcher helped Lou Henson lead the Illini to a Big Ten championship, two appearances in the Sweet 16 and one regional final.

Dutcher's first full-time coaching job came at South Dakota State, where he spent three seasons helping turn around the Division II program before departing in 1988 for Michigan.

His final season in Ann Arbor ended with the Wolverines claiming the first-ever Big Ten Tournament championship.
