Aztec Softball Set to Co-Host Campbell/Cartier Classic, Highlighted by Sunday's "Pink Game" vs. No. 12/8 UCLA

The San Diego State softball team opens the home portion of its schedule this weekend when it co-hosts the 22nd annual Campbell/Cartier Classic at SDSU Softball Stadium.

This year's classic features 10 teams, including two ranked foes (No. 7/9 Washington and No. 12/8 UCLA) and three others that are receiving votes in either poll (Aztecs, Notre Dame and Oregon State). The 10 teams will play a combined 25 games over the two fields (also at USD Softball Complex) over the three-day tournament.

SDSU (3-3), which is receiving votes in the ESPN.com/USA Softball poll, is scheduled to play five contests over the three days, including its annual "Pink Game" against the Bruins (5-0) at 2 p.m. Sunday. During the UCLA game, San Diego State will assist in raising breast cancer awareness by wearing pink visors and pink uniforms, the latter which will be available to bid on in a silent auction during the game. "Swing for Life," a non-profit organization dedicated to raising money to contribute to on-going and ground-breaking research in the fight against breast cancer, will also be on hand to answer questions, hand out pamphlets and sell merchandise that will help the fight against breast cancer.

The Aztecs kick off the classic Friday with games against (rv/rv) Notre Dame (2 p.m. PT) and (rv/-) Oregon State (7 p.m. PT). On Saturday, San Diego State meets Central Florida (1 p.m. PT) and UC Davis (3:30 p.m. PT), before the "Pink Game" against UCLA on Sunday.

The tournament is named after Susanne Campbell and Karin Cartier, who lost their lives during the 1991 softball season in a single-car accident that took place in Rosarito, Mexico. It left a lasting mark on teammates, coaches and the program. To pay tribute to Campbell and Cartier, the Aztec softball team renamed the SDSU Spring Classic in 1994 to the Campbell/Cartier Classic in memory of their friendship and fine athletic ability.

HEAD COACH | 16TH SEASON | CS FULLERTON, 1983

- As a player, Van Wyk earned All-America honors and won the Broderick Award, given to the best player in the nation, in 1981 after going 35-1 with a 0.18 ERA. The victories remain a school single-season record and .972 winning percentage was an NCAA Division I record until 2001. Her phenomenal season included four no-hitters, six one-hitters, back-to-back perfect games, 26 shutouts and 270 strikeouts.
- Is the school's all-time winningest coach with 512 career victories, including a program-best 44 wins in 2008
- Earned her third Mountain West Conference Coach of the Year award in 2008 after leading the Aztecs to a 15-5 mark in league play. She also won the award in 2002 and 2006.
- Has led SDSU to seven NCAA tournament appearances (2001, 2003, 2006, 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011)
- Guided San Diego State to its fourth MWC regular season title in 2008 with a 15-5 record. The team's other championships came in 2002, 2003 and 2006.
- Coached her fourth All-American in 2011 in Bailey Micetich. Micetich was an Easton Third-Team All-American.
- Has coached 49 all-conference selections, seven MWC Pitchers of the Year, five MWC Freshmen of the Year and 93 conference player/pitcher of the week winners

22nd Annual Campbell/Cartier Classic Info

The San Diego State University Campbell/Cartier Classic is an annual event held in the memory of former Aztec softball players Susanne Campbell and Karin Cartier. Campbell and Cartier lost their lives during the 1991 softball season in a single-car accident that took place in Rosarito, Mexico. It left a lasting mark on teammates, coaches and the program.

Campbell, a three-year starting catcher, was in her senior year. She had a .344 batting average, was an all-Western Athletic Conference selection and led the Aztecs in many offensive and defensive categories. She also set several single-season and career records and is among the top softball athletes to wear an SDSU uniform.

Cartier, a transfer pitcher from Hawai'i, had an excellent 1991 season at SDSU. She was emerging as a top pitcher and great hitter. Along with Campbell, Cartier was one of the strongest Aztecs in the weight room and possessed good leadership abilities and Division I playing experience.

To pay tribute to Susanne Campbell and Karin Cartier, the San Diego State softball team renamed the SDSU Spring Classic in 1994 to the Campbell/Cartier Classic in memory of their friendship and fine athletic ability. The 2012 tournament will be the 22nd annual classic.

Last Weekend With the Aztecs

Last weekend, SDSU went 3-3 at the Kajikawa Classic, playing a 2011 NCAA tournament team in five of the six games. San Diego State picked up wins over Portland State (7-3), Utah (14-2) and rv/No. 23 Georgia Tech (3-2), while its losses came against rv/rv Texas Tech (5-4), No. 14/9 Tennessee (6-5) and No. 16/11 Oregon (5-4).

A Look at Notre Dame

Eight seniors, however, departed from last year's team that had combined for 773 of 1,453 at-bats last year, as well as 270 of 480 hits, 52 of 82 doubles, seven of 12 triples, 31 of 52 home runs, 186 of 291 RBI and a combined .349 batting average.

The top returners for the Fighting Irish, which is receiving votes in both national polls, are Alexa Maldonado (.413, 4 HR,

25 RBI), Dani Miller (.333, 11 HR, 37 RBI), Amy Buntin (.316, 3 HR, 16 RBI) and pitcher Laura Winter (25-4, 2.42 ERA, 179.1 IP).

Friday's game will be the first-ever meeting between SDSU and Notre Dame.

Scouting Oregon State

Oregon State is coming off a 3-2 weekend at the Kajikawa Classic in Tempe, Ariz., where it picked up impressive wins against Brigham Young (22-5), Idaho State (16-3) and Nebraska (11-3). The Beavers (3-2) lost games to Georgia Tech (9-8) and McNeese State (3-2).

OSU hit .368 as a team last weekend led by Dani Gilmore's .533 (8-for-15) mark. Hanna Bouska (.471) and Desiree Beltran (.467) also hit above .400 for Oregon State, while Beltran, Lea Cavestany, Ally Kutz and Paige Hall had two homers apiece. Marina Demore led a pitching staff that combined for a 4.20 ERA by going 1-1 with a 3.23 ERA over 13 innings, while limiting the opposition to a .204 batting average.

SDSU leads the all-time series between the two schools, 12-8, including a 4-1 win at home in the last meeting on March 22, 2010. Current senior Felicia Reifschneider (San Diego/Mission Bay HS) was 3-for-4 in that game, while junior Kristin May (Corona, Calif.) was 1-for-3. Senior Bailey Micetich (Woodland, Calif.) started the game in the circle and allowed one unearned run on two hits over 2 1/3 innings.

A Glance at Central Florida

At 4-0, Central Florida is off to its second-best start in program history. At the National Collegiate Softball Invitational in Clermont, Fla., last weekend, the Knights defeated Ohio State (2-1), Florida A&M (9-1, 5 inn.), Bethune Cookman (10-4) and Chattanooga (6-2).

UCF hit .310 last weekend, led by Marissa Menendez' .455 (5-for-9) mark. Farrah Sullivan was 5-for-12 (.417) with a team-high six RBIs, while Natalie Land hit .308 (4-for-13) with a team-best five runs. Central Florida posted a 1.62 ERA, with Ali Schmidt (1-0, 0.00 ERA, 8.0 IP) and Mackenzie Audas (2-0, 1.50 ERA, 14.0 IP) leading the way.

San Diego State leads the all-time series, 2-0, after knocking off the Knights, 5-1, last Feb. 12 in Los Angeles, Calif. Current sophomore Lorena Klopp (San Diego/Steele Canyon HS) had a bases loaded double to pace the offense, while senior Bailey Micetich (Woodland, Calif.) got the win after allowing one run on seven hits and two walks over seven innings. She struck out seven.

Discussing UC Davis

UC Davis comes to San Diego riding the momentum of a 2-1 win over No. 8/12 Stanford on Feb. 15. It was the program's first victory over a nationally ranked school since 2009. The Aggies (2-4) have won two straight after losing their first four games.

UCD is led offensively by Heather Zimmerman's .417 batting average. Rachel Miller (.357, HR, 3 RBI) is the only other player with an average above .300 as the team is collectively hitting .185. The pitching staff has combined to go 2-4 with a 2.83 ERA. Jessica Thweatt (2-1, 2.26 ERA, 21.2 IP) and Justine Vela (0-2, 2.72 ERA, 18.0 IP) have been the team's top-two pitchers.

SDSU leads the all-time series, 4-0. The two schools last met on March 7, 2009, when San Diego State won, 1-0. The Aztecs managed only three hits in the game, but current senior Bailey Micetich (Woodland, Calif.) tossed a complete game two-hit shutout with nine strikeouts against just one walk.

Previewing No. 12/8 UCLA

UCLA is a perfect 5-0 after defeating Loyola Marymount, 24-2, on Tuesday. So far this season, the Bruins, who are ranked 12th by NFCA/USA Today and eighth by ESPN.com/USA Softball, have outscored their opposition, 59-7, over the five games with three of the wins coming against then No. 13/18 Kentucky.

UCLA is collectively hitting .465 and has three players with at least a .500 average - Dani Yudin (.643, 2 HR, 14 RBI), Samantha Camuso (.571, 2 HR, 9 RBI) and Katie Schroeder (.500, 1 HR, 6 RBI). Kellie Fox and B.B. Bates are each hitting .474, while Andrea Harrison (.400) has a team-high three home runs. The pitching staff has been just as good, combining to go 5-0 with a 1.40 ERA. Jessica Hall (1-0, 0.00 ERA, 13.0 IP), Ally Carda (3-0, 2.33 ERA, 12.0 IP) and Destiny Rodino (1-0, 2.80 ERA, 5.0 IP) have also kept their opponents to a .127 batting average.

San Diego State is still looking for its first-ever win against the Bruins, going 0-51 since records have been kept (1980) at SDSU.

Aztecs Receiving Votes in the ESPN.com/USA Softball Poll

SDSU is still receiving votes in the latest ESPN.com/USA Softball poll after going 3-3 last weekend at the Kajikawa Classic, including a 2-3 mark against 2011 NCAA tournament teams. All three of San Diego State's losses were by one run and all were against teams who were either ranked (two) or receiving votes (one).

The Aztecs did drop three votes to three after having six in the preseason poll. The three votes are tied with Mississippi State for the 36th most in the nation, trailing No. 25 North Carolina (35 points) by 32 points. LSU leads the receiving votes group with 26, followed by Notre Dame (24), South Florida (21), Syracuse (20), Florida State (19), Auburn (18) and Brigham Young (18), Ohio State (9), Hawaii (6), Tulsa (4), SDSU (3) and the Bulldogs (3), and Virginia Tech (1).

San Diego State dropped all six of its votes in the USA Today/NFCA national poll.

SDSU Softball Picked to Win the MW Regular Season Title

The San Diego State softball team has been picked to win the 2012 Mountain West regular season title in a preseason poll released Feb. 7. The preseason poll was voted on by the league's five head coaches.

ish second with 13 points and the other first-place vote, while Boise State (9 points), New Mexico (8) and Colorado State (4) rounded out the preseason poll.

SDSU returns five starters and three pitchers from last year's squad, including two-time all-MW pitcher Bailey Micetich (Woodland, Calif.), last year's MW Freshman of the Year Hayley Miles (Antelope, Calif.) and two-time Louisville Slugger/NFCA All-West Region pick Justeen Maeva (San Diego/Mira Mesa HS).

Website Names Bailey Micetich MW Preseason POY

San Diego State senior Bailey Micetich (Woodland, Calif.) was named the pre-season Mountain West Pitcher of the Year by the website CollegeSportsMadness.com, the site announced Jan. 9.

Micetich also was picked as a first-team all-conference selection by the website and was joined by sophomore Hayley Miles (Antelope, Calif.). Additionally, the Aztecs had three on the second team, including senior Justeen Maeva (San Diego/Mira Mesa HS), sophomore Lorena Klopp (San Diego/Steele Canyon HS) and sophomore Katie Mathis (Grass Valley, Calif.).

A two-time all-MW selection, Micetich went 20-12 last season with a 1.85 ERA over 174 1/3 innings. She struck out 164 against 36 walks, while limiting the opposition to a .243 average. Micetich was named the MW Pitcher of the Week three times and was chosen as an Easton NCAA Division I All-America third-team pick. Micetich ranked among the SDSU single-season bests in six categories, including wins (tied for sixth), appearances (tied for seventh) and strikeouts (ninth).

A centerfielder, Miles was named the Mountain West Freshman of the Year in 2011 after batting .344 with five home runs and 29 RBIs. One of only two players to start all 55 games last year, Miles led the Aztecs in hits (54, tied), doubles (11, tied), walks (22), times hit by a pitch (5), on-base percentage (.440) and stolen bases (nine). Miles ranked among the school's single-season top 10 leaders in nine categories with top-five marks in slugging percentage (fourth, .548), extra-base hits (fourth, 19), OPS percentage (OBP+SLG) (tied-fourth, .988), and times hit by a pitch (tied-fifth, 5).

Klopp, who played most of the season in left field, smashed four school records in her first season, including slugging percentage (.633), extra-base hits (25), RBIs (48) and home runs (15). The 15 homers in one season are just two shy of the school's career record of 17 set by Erryn Gutjahr (1996-99) and tied by Megan McDonald (2005-08). Klopp, who batted .259, added 10 doubles and 93 total bases, the fourth most in single-season history.

A first baseman, Maeva led the team with a .348 average last season to go along with seven homers and 39 RBIs en route to being named a second-team Louisville Slugger/NFCA All-West Region selection. Maeva's 54 hits tied Miles for the most on the team, and she was second in homers, RBIs, and on-base percentage (.420).

Mathis, meanwhile, batted .400 (8-for-20) in a season that was limited due to injuries (31 games, five games started). She also drew three walks for a .478 on-base percentage. Mathis added 14 runs, two stolen bases and was perfect in the field in 16 chances.

Durazo Inducted into Aztec Hall of Fame

Former San Diego State softball pitching great Sandra Durazo was inducted into the Aztec Hall of Fame on Dec. 3. Durazo, who joined three other SDSU athletes and an NAIA baseball national championship team, is the second softball player to make the school's Hall of Fame (Trish Mang - 1994).

Over her four-year career from 1998-2001, Durazo went 87-53 with a 1.82 ERA. She struck out 543 batters over 879 innings and held opponents to a .240 batting average. She led San Diego State in ERA and wins in all four of her seasons, and led the team in strikeouts three times.

A two-time all-Mountain West selection (2000-01) and 2001 MW Pitcher of the Year, Durazo had a magnificent senior season en route to earning first-team NFCA All-West Region honors. In 2001, Durazo was 30-15 with a 1.53 ERA over a remarkable 297 1/3 innings. She struck out 203, and had 35 complete games and 10 shutouts, while limiting her opponents to a .217 batting average.

Durazo capped her career by leading the Aztecs to their first-ever NCAA tournament appearance in 2001, which ended with a loss in the regional championship (one game short of the Women's College World Series). Durazo started all five games in the 2001 NCAA tournament, going 3-2 with two shutouts. She left the regional championship game in the fourth inning to a standing ovation, having pitched 107 1/3 consecutive innings.

A two-time Academic all-MW selection (2000-01) and nine-time conference pitcher/player of the week, Durazo still owns five career school records and four season marks. Durazo's career records include wins (87), appearances (165), games started (116), complete games (95) and innings pitched (879.0), while her season records (set in 2001) include wins (30, tied), games started (40), complete games (35) and innings pitched (297.1).

Season tickets are \$100 for adults, \$60 for seniors (55 and up) and \$60 for youths (3-14). Additionally, SDSU faculty/staff and military discounted passes are available via phone ((619) 283-7378) only. Tournament passes are \$25 each and are available at GoAztecs.com. Single-game tickets are \$6 and \$10 for tournament days (children 2 and younger do not require a ticket). All San Diego State students with a valid Red ID get one free ticket on the day of a game. Additional fees will be charged for some tickets, regardless of where they are purchased.
