#### Offensive Player of the Week

*Timo Pitter, Creighton, Jr., M/F*

Pitter posted four points during the Bluejays' 2-0 week that put them back on top of the BIG EAST standings with one game left in the regular season. The junior assisted on the game-winning goal and tallied the insurance marker in Wednesday's 2-0 win over No. 24 Marquette, and added a helper on Saturday's game-winner at DePaul.



#### Defensive Player of the Week

*Jared Rist, Georgetown, Sr., M/D*

Rist led the Hoyas to a pair of shutouts last week, both 1-0 decisions against No. 9/12 Xavier at home and at St. John's. The senior led a GU defense that surrendered 14 shots in the two games, with just five making it on goal. He also contributed an assist on the game-winner over the Red Storm Saturday.



#### Goalkeeper of the Week

*Eric Dick, Butler, R-Fr., GK*

Dick finished with 11 saves during a 1-0-1 week that saw the Bulldogs stay alive for the final berth to the BIG EAST Tournament thanks to Sunday's win over visiting Providence. On Wednesday Dick played all 110 minutes of a scoreless tie with Seton Hall, making six saves in the draw. On Senior Day against the Friars Sunday, Dick entered the game in the first half and played the final 80:18 with five saves and earned the victory in a 2-0 result.



#### Rookie of the Week

*Walker Andriot, Xavier, R-Fr., D*

Andriot finished a cross into the box from Will Walker at the 5:51 mark to put Xavier ahead 1-0 in Saturday's eventual 3-0 victory over Villanova. It was a critical three points for the Musketeers who are tied for second in the standings with Providence entering the final weekend of the regular season. ## BIG EAST News & Notes

### DOWN TO THE WIRE

Not one to shy away from drama, the BIG EAST comes right down to the final days of the regular season to fully determine its six teams that will advance to the BIG EAST Tournament presented by New York Life. Just like last weekend, there is something at stake in all five games set for Thursday and Friday.

### PIRATES, BULLDOGS STAY ALIVE

Seton Hall and Butler needed good results last weekend to keep their BIG EAST Tournament chances alive, and both came through. The Pirates played a wild 3-3 draw with No. 24 Marquette Saturday night in a windy, cold and wet South Orange to stay in the hunt, while the Bulldogs upset No. 11/8 Providence 2-0 Sunday afternoon at a sun-splashed Butler Bowl.

### THE LAST BERTH

Three teams are in contention for the last berth to the BIG EAST Tournament. Marquette joins Butler and Seton Hall as teams still mathematically alive. The Golden Eagles had a chance to knock out the Pirates on Saturday night with a win in their head-to-head matchup.

### SOME SEEDS ARE KNOWN

While there's a great deal of shuffling that can still happen amongst the top four seeds to the BIG EAST Tournament, Villanova is on the other end of the spectrum. The Wildcats are locked in as the No. 5 seed and will go on the road next Tuesday, Nov. 11, for the First Round with a destination TBD. In addition, whichever team of Butler, Marquette or Seton Hall that qualifies for the tournament will be the No. 6 seed.

### WHAT'S AT STAKE - SHU @ STJ, Thu., 7:30 p.m.

Seton Hall visits St. John's in the renewal of the teams' rivalry across the Hudson River Thursday night for a 7:30 p.m. start on the BIG EAST Digital Network. With two ties last week, the Pirates stayed alive for the BIG EAST Tournament. They don't completely control their own destiny, and can only remain alive for the conference tournament with a win. A tie or a loss would eliminate the Pirates. St. John's chances at making the postseason were dashed with Saturday's 1-0 loss at Georgetown.

### WHAT'S AT STAKE - GU @ VU, Fri., 2 p.m.

After a brief stumble in the middle of BIG EAST play, Georgetown has won three straight entering Friday afternoon's tilt at Villanova. The Wildcats are already locked in as the No. 5 seed, but a victory here over the Hoyas would guarantee a rematch between the two next week in Washington, D.C., in the First Round. A tie would lock the Hoyas in as either the No. 3 or 4 seed. A win could put GU in as the No. 2 seed if Butler beats or ties with Xavier.

### WHAT'S AT STAKE - BU @ XU, Fri., 7 p.m.

Of the three teams still fighting for the last berth, Butler is the one that fully controls its destiny. A victory would give the Bulldogs the tournament's No. 6 seed and a date with somebody next Tuesday in the First Round on the road. Coach Paul Snape's crew will have the benefit of knowing Seton Hall's result entering the game, and they own the head-to-head tiebreaker with Marquette, which puts further pressure on the Golden Eagles.

This is also a big game for the Musketeers, who are tied for second with Providence two points behind Creighton. A victory would assure XU of a top-two seed, while a loss could drop the Musketeers into the No. 4 slot depending on the GU/VU result.

### WHAT'S AT STAKE - PC @ CU, Fri., 8 p.m.

It's very clear for both teams when Providence heads to Omaha for Friday night's clash at Creighton. The winner is the No. 1 seed; the loser could fall all the way to the No. 4 line (once again, depending on the GU/VU and BU/XU results). Picked fifth in the Preseason Coaches' Poll, a win here would get the Friars that much closer to returning to the BIG EAST Championship game for the second straight season. The Jays advanced to last year's BIG EAST First Round as the No. 5 seed but fell at the Friars.

### WHAT'S AT STAKE - DPU @ MU, Fri., 8:05 p.m.

Kicking off last could be a benefit for Marquette, which will know how SHU/STJ ended the night before. But the Golden Eagles will also be doing their share of scoreboard watching Friday night. MU will be big Xavier fans (temporarily, at least) and root for the Musketeers to knock off or draw with Butler. Either way, MU also has to take care of business on the field. Should XU open the door for the Golden Eagles, their only path to the BIG EAST Tournament is three points.

### RPI UPDATE

Monday came and like clockwork there was another set of NCAA RPI data to digest. Georgetown moved up to No. 3, a season best for any BIG EAST team, while Creighton checked in at 10, Providence 14 and Xavier 18. Marquette is next at No. 46, followed by Butler (54), Seton Hall (66), St. John's (69), Villanova (80) and DePaul (131).

### LYON A SENIOR CLASS FINALIST

Marquette senior keeper Charlie Lyon, also the 2013-14 BIG EAST Men's Scholar-Athlete of the Year and a first-team Capital One Academic All-America pick by CoSIDA, was named one of 10 national finalists for the Senior CLASS Award on Oct. 21. Nationwide fan voting helps determine the winner, and fans can vote for up to three student-athletes once per day. ### FOUR NAMED TO HERMANN WATCH LIST

Georgetown's Brandon Allen and Joshua Yaro, Marquette's C. Nortey and St. John's Tim Parker were named to the Hermann Trophy Watch List in early August. The Hoyas are one of just four men's teams with multiple players recognized.

### MU HOPES FOR BACK-TO-BACK CROWNS

Marquette captured its first BIG EAST Tournament championship in 2013, and the Golden Eagles are aiming to be the conference's first repeat titlist since Connecticut won in 2004 and '05. MU opened a 2-0 first-half lead on Providence before hanging on for a 3-2 win last season.

### HALF MADE THE POSTSEASON

In 2013 five of 10 BIG EAST competed in the NCAA Tournament. Marquette earned the league's automatic berth, with Creighton, Georgetown, Providence and St. John's

earning at-large invitations. Currently the BIG EAST has sent at least five teams to the NCAA Tournament for 13 straight years.

### THREE STRAIGHT YEARS AT PPL PARK

The BIG EAST Men's Soccer Championship presented by New York Life returns to PPL Park for the third straight year in 2014. After first-round matches on campus sites Nov. 11, the semifinals and championship play out in suburban Philadelphia Nov. 14 and 16.

Championship tickets, which are on sale now, include free parking for the weekend. They can be purchased online at [pplpark.com](http://pplpark.com), over the phone at 1-800-298-4200 and in person at the PPL Park box office.

### GU, MU NAMED CO-FAVORITES

Georgetown and Marquette, which tied for the 2013 BIG EAST regular-season crown, tied atop the 2014 Preseason Coaches' Poll announced Aug. 19. The Hoyas and Golden Eagles both accrued 75 points, with GU taking five first-place votes and MU four. Creighton placed third with 63 points and the last first-place vote. St. John's and Providence rounded out the top five.
