WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW...

SETTING THE STAGE

THE HALL WILL LOOK TO CLOSE THE SEASON ON A HIGH NOTE AND EXTEND THEIR RECENT DOMINANCE OVER RIVAL VILLANOVA WHEN THE 2015 CAMPAIGN COMES TO A CLOSE ON FRIDAY. SETON HALL HAS NOT LOST TO THE WILDCATS SINCE 2009 (L, 3-1)- BUILDING A FIVE-GAME UNBEATEN STREAK IN THE SERIES. SINCE 2010, SHU HAS OUT-SCORED VU, 11-TO-0, WHILE POSTING A 4-0-1 RECORD IN THE FIVE MEETINGS. VILLANOVA'S LAST TRIP TO SOUTH ORANGE CAME IN 2013, ALSO ON SETON HALL SENIOR DAY, AND THE PIRATES CRUISED TO A 5-0 WIN.

CLASS OF 2016

SETON HALL WILL BID FAREWELL TO AN ACCOMPLISHED GROUP OF SENIORS ON FRIDAY AS MELISSA BLEVINS, AMANDA GULLI, EMILY HANSINGER AND D'YONNA RILEY WILL ALL PLAY THEIR FINAL GAMES IN A PIRATE UNIFORM. A ST. BONAVENTURE TRANSFER, GULLI HAS SPENT THE LAST THREE SEASONS AT SHU AND RANKED AS THE TEAM'S LEADING SCORER IN EACH OF THE LAST TWO; INCLUDING A CAREER-BEST FOUR GOALS (8 PTS) IN 2015. CO-CAPTAINS HANSINGER AND RILEY HAVE BEEN MAINSTAYS AT THE BACK FOR THE HALL THROUGHOUT THEIR TIME IN BLUE & WHITE, COMBINING TO APPEAR IN OVER 120 MATCHES. AN OUTSIDE BACK WITH A PENCHANT FOR GETTING FORWARD, RILEY HAS RECORDED AT LEAST A POINT IN ALL FOUR OF HER COLLEGIATE SEASONS AND SCORED THE GAME-WINNING GOAL IN A VICTORY AT MARIST TO KICK-OFF THE RICK STAINTON ERA LAST FALL. HANSINGER HAS BEEN AN ANCHOR IN THE MIDDLE OF THE BACK LINE WHILE BLEVINS HAS MADE OVER 55 APPEARANCES OF HER OWN AND DID NOT MISS A SINGLE MATCH DURING HER SOPHOMORE AND JUNIOR SEASONS.

BACK ON THE INTERNATIONAL STAGE

SETON HALL FRESHMAN EVA GONZALEZ WILL RETURN TO THE TEAM ON THURSDAY NIGHT AFTER ANOTHER TRIP TO TRAIN AND PLAY WITH THE MEXICO U20 NATIONAL SIDE IN ADVANCE OF THE U20 CONCACAF CHAMPIONSHIP TO BE HELD IN HONDURAS FROM DECEMBER 3-13. TIED FOR THE TEAM-LEAD IN ASSISTS, GONZALEZ HAS WORN THE CAPTAIN'S ARMBAND FOR THE U20 SQUAD AND ALSO PREVIOUSLY MISSED A LARGE PORTION OF PRESEASON TRAINING AS WELL AS THE NON-CONFERENCE FINALE DUE TO INTERNATIONAL DUTY. THE MESQUITE, TEXAS NATIVE PREVIOUSLY HELPED THE MEXICO U17 SIDE TO ITS FIRST-EVER CONCACAF GOLD CUP TITLE IN 2013, ALSO APPEARED FOR THE U20'S AT THE WOMEN'S NTC INVITATIONAL HOSTED BY U.S. SOCCER IN JUNE. NICKNAMED "MOUSE," GONZALEZ APPEARED AS A SUB IN THE PIRATES' FIRST TWO MATCHES AFTER RECORDING NEARLY 60 POINTS AS A SENIOR CAPTAIN FOR A BISHOP LYNCH TEAM THAT WON A STATE TITLE IN HER FINAL SEASON

CLOSE CALLS

SUNDAY'S 1-0 SETBACK AGAINST PROVIDENCE WAS THE SIXTH MATCH IN THE LAST SEVEN THAT THE PIRATES HAVE SEEN DECIDED BY A SINGLE GOAL OR LESS AND MARKED THE 10TH SUCH RESULT IN THE LAST 12 MATCHES. DURING THE TWO SEASONS SINCE HEAD COACH RICK STAINTON TOOK THE HELM, 11 OF SHU'S 17 BIG EAST MATCHES HAVE EITHER BEEN DECIDED BY ONE GOAL OR ENDED IN A DRAW. THE PIRATES HAVE ALSO SURRENDERED A SINGLE GOAL OR RECORDED A CLEAN SHEET IN 10 OF THOSE MATCHES.

GOALKEEPING CAROUSEL

A FORMER STANDOUT GOALKEEPER HIMSELF; HEAD COACH RICK STAINTON HAS SEEN A SERIES OF FACTORS FORCE HIM TO EMPLOY FOUR DIFFERENT STARTING GOALKEEPERS THROUGHOUT THE SEASON. OF THE THREE GOALKEEPERS REMAINING ON THE ROSTER, SOPHOMORE LAURA DRAMIS MADE THE MOST RECENT START, THE FIRST OF HER CAREER, MAKING SIX STOPS WHILE LIMITING THE FRIARS TO A SINGLE GOAL. FRESHMAN ANNA MACLEAN HAS IMPRESSED BY MAKING 56 SAVES IN 10 APPEARANCES WHILE LAST SEASON'S REGULAR STARTER ILLISSA BLACKSHEAR HAS BEEN LIMITED TO JUST SEVEN APPEARANCES. ONLY ONE OTHER BIG EAST TEAM HAS EMPLOYED AS MANY AS THREE KEEPERS (BUTLER) AND NO OTHER TEAM IN THE CONFERENCE HAS HAD MORE THAN TWO EARN A START

BLACKSHEAR AMONG BIG EAST BEST

WHEN AVAILABLE, THE JUNIOR BLACKSHEAR HAS RATED AMONG THE CONFERENCE LEADERS IN SEVERAL CATEGORIES AND HAS TWICE BEEN NAMED BIG EAST GOALKEEPER OF THE WEEK DESPITE LIMITED PLAYING TIME. THE WEST ORANGE NATIVE'S 1.12 GOALS AGAINST AVERAGE IS SIXTH-BEST IN THE LEAGUE AND SHE ALSO SITS SECOND IN THE CONFERENCE WITH AN .800 SAVE PERCENTAGE. BLACKSHEAR FINISHED SECOND IN THE LEAGUE IN HER FIRST FULL SEASON AS A STARTER LAST YEAR AND ENTERS THE FINALE AVERAGING 4.00 STOPS PER MATCH (FIFTH, BIG EAST).

CRUNCH TIME

THE PIRATES HAVE BEEN CREDITED WITH NINE GOALS ON THE SEASON - SIX OF WHICH HAVE COME IN THE 70TH MINUTE OR LATER. AGAINST CREIGHTON, D'YONNA RILEY BAGGED THE SECOND GOAL OF HER CAREER AND HER FIRST SINCE THE 2014 SEASON OPENER WITH AN 86TH MINUTE EQUALIZER THAT SENT THE CONTEST WITH THE BLUEJAYS INTO EXTRA TIME. THE GAME-WINNING SCORE AGAINST MARQUETTE IN THE HOME MATCH PRIOR WAS TALLIED IN THE 81ST MINUTE.

MASH UNIT

THE PIRATES HAVE EXPERIENCED THEIR SHARE OF INJURY WOES THIS SEASON, A TREND THAT HAS FORCED HEAD COACH RICK STAINTON TO EMPLOY A MULTITUDE OF DIFFERENT STARTING LINEUPS INCLUDING SIX IN SIX BIG EAST MATCHES HEADING INTO THE CONTEST WITH BUTLER. SARAH FIORINO, WHO STARTED THE FIRST 10 MATCHES, MELISSA BLEVINS, CATHY CHUKUKA, EMILY RIMDZIUS, SOPHIA DUFFY, ANDREA PALERMO AND ILLISSA BLACKSHEAR HAVE ALL BEEN FORCED OUT OF ACTION AT SOME POINT THIS SEASON. JUNIOR FORWARD SARAH CORTES HAS BEEN SIDELINED FOR THE ENTIRE 2015 CAMPAIGN.

MAIER THE MAESTRO

SETON HALL'S WINNING GOAL AGAINST ALBANY STARTED WITH A CORNER KICK FROM JUNIOR FRANKIE MAIER - SOMETHING THAT HAS PROVEN TO BE A DANGEROUS WEAPON FOR THE HALL THIS SEASON. MAIER HAS SENT IN THREE CORNERS THAT HAVE DIRECTLY LED TO GOALS AND RANKS SECOND ON THE TEAM WITH FOUR POINTS. MAIER ENTERED THE YEAR WITH FOUR CAREER POINTS AFTER APPEARING IN ALL 36 OF THE TEAM'S MATCHES OVER HER FIRST TWO SEASONS IN SOUTH ORANGE.

WELCOME ABOARD

FOLLOWING HIS FIRST FULL SEASON AT THE HELM IN SOUTH ORANGE, STAINTON INKED A CLASS OF 11 DECORATED NEWCOMERS THAT IS SET TO MAKE AN IMMEDIATE IMPACT. CANADIAN GOALKEEPER ANNA MACLEAN STARTED THE FIRST THREE MATCHES OF THE SEASON WHILE THE CLASS ALSO INCLUDED REINFORCEMENTS THROUGHOUT THE LINEUP INCLUDING THREE DEFENDERS, THREE MIDFIELDERS AND FOUR FORWARDS. ALL 11 FRESHMEN HAVE SEEN GAME ACTION.

HEAD COACH RICK STAINTON

RICK STAINTON WAS APPOINTED THE THIRD HEAD COACH IN PROGRAM HISTORY FOLLOWING THE 2013 SEASON, RETURNING TO SETON HALL AFTER PREVIOUSLY SERVING AS AN ASSISTANT COACH FOR THE PIRATES FOR TWO SEASONS.

IN HIS FIRST SEASON ON THE SIDELINES FOR THE HALL, THE STAINTON-LED PIRATES VAULTED BACK INTO THE NSCAA NORTHEAST REGIONAL POLL FOR THE FIRST TIME SINCE AUGUST 2012 WHEN STAINTON WAS ON STAFF AS AN ASSISTANT. THE PIRATES WENT ON TO ESTABLISH THEMSELVES AS A STOUT DEFENSIVE UNIT, POSTING SIX CLEAN SHEETS IN 18 OUTINGS AND SURRENDERED ONE GOAL OR LESS 13 TIMES - INCLUDING EIGHT OF NINE NON-CONFERENCE MATCHES.

NO STRANGER TO SOUTH ORANGE, STAINTON MADE HIS WAY BACK TO THE HALL WHERE HE WAS CHARGED WITH DIRECTING THE PROGRAM'S RECRUITING, TRAINING AND IN-MATCH STRATEGY AS WELL AS OVERSEEING THE TEAM'S BUDGET IN HIS TIME AS AN ASSISTANT UNDER FORMER HEAD COACH KAZBEK TAMI. DURING HIS FIRST SEASON ON STAFF, THE PIRATES POSTED THEIR LARGEST WIN TOTAL SINCE THE TURN OF THE MILLENNIUM, RECORDING NINE VICTORIES AND EARNING A HOME MATCH IN THE FIRST ROUND OF THE BIG EAST TOURNAMENT. THE MATCH PROVED TO BE A MEMORABLE ONE AS SETON HALL SCORED THE SECOND POSTSEASON WIN IN SCHOOL HISTORY AND THE FIRST VIA SHUTOUT WITH A 1-0 DEFEAT OF ST. JOHN'S.

FOLLOWING A 2012 SEASON IN WHICH SETON HALL REGISTERED SEVEN MORE VICTORIES, FIVE OF WHICH WERE OF THE SHUTOUT VARIETY; STAINTON TOOK OVER AS THE HEAD WOMEN'S SOCCER COACH AT FAIRLEIGH DICKINSON UNIVERSITY.

DURING HIS BRIEF STINT IN TEANECK, STAINTON LED THE KNIGHTS TO ONE OF THE MOST SUCCESSFUL SEASONS IN THE HISTORY OF A YOUNG PROGRAM. HE TOOK OVER A SQUAD WHOSE SENIOR CLASS HAD REGISTERED ONLY 11 WINS IN THE PREVIOUS THREE YEARS AND ENGINEERED A RAPID TURNAROUND, GUIDING THE KNIGHTS TO AN 8-8-4 RECORD THAT INCLUDED A 4-1-3 MARK IN NORTHEAST CONFERENCE (NEC) PLAY AND THE #2-SEED IN THE CONFERENCE TOURNAMENT.

A SEASONED PROFESSIONAL WITH EXTENSIVE COACHING EXPERIENCE AT A VARIETY OF LEVELS, STAINTON HOLDS A UNITED STATES SOCCER FEDERATION (USSF) "A" LICENSE AND A NATIONAL SOCCER COACHES ASSOCIATION OF AMERICA (NSCAA) PREMIER DIPLOMA, AS WELL AS A NSCAA NATIONAL GOALKEEPING DIPLOMA.

HIS COACHING RÉSUMÉ IS AN IMPRESSIVE ONE, AND FEATURES A STRETCH IN WHICH HE WAS ONSTAFF FOR THE GARDEN STATE-BASED WOMEN'S PROFESSIONAL SIDE SKY BLUE FC.
