Camp Dates

The 2012 Siena Baseball Camp will run Monday, July 2nd through Friday, July 6th.

Camp Items

Camp will run from 8:30 until 4:30 PM daily.

Drop off times

All campers are to be dropped off in front of Marcelle Athletic Complex (parking lot W) by 8:30 am daily.

Pick up times

Campers shall be picked up at the following locations:

Campers may be picked up at the northeast corner of parking lot U (on the right side of Turchi Road) **or** at the Western end of parking lot V (next to the Alumni Recreation Center, by the Siena logo on the building). Parents may park in lot U but **Not** lot V.

On Friday July 8th- All campers will be playing in the “Ragball Tournament” on the main field and softball fields. There will be a closing awards ceremony on the main baseball field beginning at approximately 4:00 pm. Parents are encouraged to attend both the tournament which will be after lunch at approximately 1:15 pm, and the

Awards Ceremony. All campers will be picked up in front of the MAC (Parking lot W) after the closing ceremony at the main field.

Injury & Medication Policy

All injuries will be reported to and attended to by the Siena Athletic Training Staff. If your child requires the administration of any medications please be sure to leave the medication with the Athletic Training Staff. They will administer the medication at the prescribed time(s).

Rain Policy

Camp will be held rain or shine. We will try to remain outside as long as possible. If conditions force us inside, camp will be held in the Alumni Recreation Center. Campers are not allowed to wear spikes inside, so please make sure you child has a pair of sneakers, just in case.

Teams, Leagues, etc.

The following divisions have *tentatively* been established for games and played in the afternoon.

Rookie League	Turf Field Area

Majors 1 & 2	Softball Field
Majors 1 & 2	Main Baseball Field

The number of teams in each league will depend on enrollment. Some players may be moved up or down, as dictated by enrollment numbers.

Early Dismissal Policy

In the event you child must leave camp early you are required to sign your child out. ALL EARLY DISMISSALS will be done by the Athletic Training Staff in the Training Room at the rear of the Alumni Recreation Center (ARC). A written note is also required for early dismissal. Upon return, campers must first report to the Training room to sign back in before rejoining their respective counselors. Campers old enough to drive must follow the same procedures and have a written note from home.

What to Bring.....

Campers should bring the following every day:

1. Baseball glove
2. Baseball hat
3. Spikes & sneakers
4. Bat (suggested)

****All items should be labeled** with your child's name.

In addition, on Thursday (July 7) we may have sliding instruction. All campers should bring a towel and a change of clothing, as we will be sliding on watered down plastic.

We will inform the campers on Wednesday.

Lunch policy

Lunch will be served daily in Serra Hall (Cafeteria). Lunch is served buffet style and each camper is allowed unlimited trips. Campers will have between 45 minutes to 1 hour to eat.

****No Campers** are allowed to leave the Cafeteria **unless** accompanied by a counselor.
