Siena College Coaching Staff

HEAD COACH BILL LAJEUNESSE

Bill begins his second season as head softball coach at Siena College in 2012 after spending four seasons serving as the lead assistant coach for the program. He oversaw a turnaround from a 14-37 record in 2010 to a 20-25 mark last season, a winning percentage improvement of nearly 170 points. "Coach Laj" has over ten years of coaching at the local level in high school and the travel ball circuit.



ASSISTANT COACH ABBY ARCENEUX

Abby enters her second season as an assistant coach at Siena after serving as an assistant at Union College for three years and the pitching coach at Cornell. In her first season, Arceneaux oversaw a pitching staff whose ERA dropped nearly a full run from 2010 (4.62) to 2011 (3.64). Under her tutelage, the Saints also saw a 31-strikeout increase (from 171 to 202) despite playing six fewer games.



ASSISTANT COACH STACEY SIMPSON

Stacey begins her eighth year on the Siena staff. A 1996 graduate of Shenendehowa HS, Stacey went on to play outfield at American International College. Stacey is also a hitting instructor with Hayner Brothers.



ASSISTANT COACH SEAN BRADKE

Sean enters his first season on the softball coaching staff. He will primarily be working with the outfielders and also serves as the diving coach for the Siena Saints.



In addition to the coaching staff the 2012 Siena Softball team will be instructors at the clinic.

DIRECTIONS TO CAMPUS

From the North— Take Exit 5 (NY 155) off the Northway (I-87). Left on NY 155 to US 9. Right on US 9 for two miles. Turn east off of US 9 onto Spring Street Road. Take a left onto Turchi Road. Marcelle Athletic Complex is at the end of the driveway.

From the South – Take Exit 23 (I-787) off the New York Thruway. Follow I-787 to I-90 West. Take Exit 6 (US 9 North to Loudonville, first exit off I-90). Follow US 9 north approximately two miles. Turn east off of US 9 onto Spring Street Road. Take a left onto Turchi Road. Marcelle Athletic Complex is at the end of the driveway.

From the East off the Massachusetts Turnpike – Take the New York Thruway to Exit B-1 (I-90 West). Follow I-90 to Exit 6 (US 9 North to Loudonville). Follow US 9 north approximately two miles. Turn east off of US 9 onto Spring Street Road. Take a left onto Turchi Road. Marcelle Athletic Complex is at the end of the driveway.

From the West – Take Exit 24 (Northway I-87) off the New York Thruway. Follow I-87 North to Exit 5 (NY 155). Left on US 155 to US 9. Right on US 9 for two miles. Turn east off of US 9 onto Spring Street Road. Take a left onto Turchi Road. Marcelle Athletic Complex is at the end of the driveway.

Clinic Description

We are offering two clinics this winter: the first is open to players of all ages (participants will be grouped by age/skill level so that everyone receives appropriate instruction); and the second is open to high school-aged players only.

All participants will receive 1 ½ hours of instruction on defensive skills at the position or positions of their choice. Beginning pitchers will learn basic fundamentals and mechanics, and advanced pitchers will learn mechanics for specific pitches. Position players will focus on techniques of throwing and fielding, along with skills specific to their defensive position.

Participants will also receive 1 ½ hours of instruction for offensive skills. Techniques for hitting, bunting, slapping, and base running will be presented.

Registration and check-in will begin 30 minutes prior on the day of the clinic, but pre-registration is encouraged.
