Golden Eagles Win Both C-USA Titles: Southern Miss captured the 2018 Conference USA regular season and tournament titles, winning the league race by 2 1/2 games and then collected the tournament title for the second time in three seasons. It was the second time Southern Miss won both C-USA championships in the same season with the other time coming in 2003. Southern Miss won nine of 10 C-USA series this season, including five sweeps to capture 20 or more league games for the third-straight year and the sixth time overall. It also marked the fifth time that it has achieved the regular-season title as well as its fourth tournament crown. Four of the five regular season titles have come under current head coach Scott Berry, while he has led Southern Miss to three of their four tournament titles.

Most League Wins in Back-to-Back Seasons: Over the last two seasons, Southern Miss holds a 48-9 record in league games, marking the most victories in league play ever over a two-season period. With the back-to-back regular-season titles, the Golden Eagles also became the fourth different school – the others were Tulane (97-98), Houston (99-00) and Rice (06-08, 10-15) – to win the league regular-season crown in consecutive seasons. The 94 overall victories over the last two seasons also ranks as the most wins in program history over a two-year span.

In the NCAA Tournament: Southern Miss made its 15th NCAA Tournament appearance by playing in the Fayetteville Regional. After a 1-2 showing, the Golden Eagles are now 20-31 (.392) in NCAA Tournament play. The program has won one regional, one super regional and have appeared in the College World Series once, all three coming during the 2009 campaign.

Third Consecutive Appearance: After a four-year absence from the postseason tournament following the 2011 campaign, the Golden Eagles made their third-straight NCAA appearance in 2018.

C-USA All-Conference Honors: Luke Reynolds earned Conference USA Player and Newcomer of the Year honors, while Nick Sandlin tallied Pitcher of the Year and Scott Berry garnered Coach of the Year accolades for their respective successful seasons. Reynolds, along with Sandlin, were named to the league's First Team, as was Golden Eagle outfielder Matt Wallner. Fellow outfielder Gabe Montenegro earned a spot on the All-Freshman Team. He is the second consecutive Southern Miss player to win the Player of the Year award after Dylan Burdeaux won it the previous season. Reynolds became the first player in C-USA history to win both Player and Newcomer of the Year. Sandlin is the third different Southern Miss hurler (four times total) to be named C-USA Pitcher of the Year. Berry was the first skipper to be named the Keith LeClair Coach of the Year in consecutive years since Rice's Wayne Graham won the award three straight times from 2006-08. This was his third C-USA Coach of the Year honor, making him the third head coach to accomplish that in C-USA history. Southern Miss was the first school to win Player, Pitcher and Coach of the Year awards in the same season since Rice in 2007.

Sandlin Named Semifinalist for Golden Spikes and Dick Howser Awards: Junior right-handed pitcher Nick Sandlin earned a semifinalist spot on both the Golden Spikes Award, presented by USA Baseball, and the Dick Howser Award, for top collegiate baseball player in the country. Sandlin, who made the transition from closer to the team's ace starting pitcher this season, posted a 10-0 record in 15 starts and has fanned 144 batters, while having walked just 18 over 102 1/3 innings. He ranked Top 10 nationally in the following statistical categories including No. 1 in WHIP (0.71), and earned run average (1.06), second in hits allowed by nine innings (4.84), fifth in strikeouts, ninth in strikeouts-to-walk ratio (8.00), 10th in strikeout per 9 innings (12.66) and tied for 10th in victories. Sandlin was chosen as the Perfect Game National Pitcher of the Year for 2018 season - the first Golden Eagle to win that award.

Wallner Named to USA Baseball National Collegiate Team: Southern Miss sophomore outfielder/pitcher Matt Wallner (Forest Lake, Minn.) joins the 24-man USA Baseball Collegiate National Team roster this summer. The reigning national Freshman of the Year by Baseball America, D1Baseball.com and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association, earned a trip to the team's training camp last summer following his freshman campaign that saw him collect a .336 average with 19 home runs and 63 RBI. His homer total ranked No. 1 among freshman a year ago, while his RBI number ranked second. Wallner is the second Southern Miss baseball player asked to play for his country as Tony Phillips played on the 1991 Collegiate National Team that participated in the Pan American Games in Cuba that summer.

Ferriss Trophy Winner: Nick Sandlin collected the 2018 C Spire Ferriss Trophy, May 21, at a luncheon held at the Mississippi Sports Hall of Fame in Jackson. The National Pitcher of the week honors five times during the campaign, as well as capturing the Conference USA weekly honor four times. He is the third Southern Miss player to capture this award, as outfielder Tyler Koelling won the honor in 2011 and pitcher James McMahon earned the accolade in 2015.

Reynolds Finishes Lone Season with .389 Average: Junior Luke Reynolds looked to become the first Southern Miss player since Jarrett Hoffpauir (.405) in 2004 to finish the season leading the squad in hitting with at least a .400 average but finished at .389. Reynolds ended the year ranked nationally in the Top 10 in the following categories: second in both walks (65), walks per game (1.05) and on-base percentage (.551), ninth in slugging percentage (.699) tied for 10th in runs (70). His walk mark also established a single-season school record.

Random Golden Eagle Notes: The pitching staff allowed just 152 walks during the season. The previous last three times Southern Miss allowed fewer than 200 walks in a season were in 2015 (167), 2007 (180) and 1982 (137)...The Golden Eagles were 21-8 at home this season. It was the fourth-straight year that Southern Miss has won at least 20 home games in a season and the 7th time during the nine-year Scott Berry era.

Limiting Walks: The Southern Miss pitching staff limited its walks in games this season, allowing zero or one walk 24 times and three or less 47 times. The squad posted a 39-8 when they give up three or fewer walks in a game.

The Bermuda Triangle: The heart of the Southern Miss batting order - the No. 3, 4 and 5 slots that included Luke Reynolds, Matt Wallner and Hunter Slater - produced 239 hits in 687 at bats for a .348 combined batting average that includes a collective 43 doubles, 2 triples and 43 home runs to go along with 183 RBI. The trio has also registered a combined slugging percentage of .604 and have walked 143 times between the three of them. The three players enjoyed that order in the lineup in 55 of 62 games.

40 Wins: The Golden Eagles have now won 40 or more games, 11 times in their history. USM first won 40 games in 1990. Southern Miss set its school record for victories in 2017 with 50, surpassing the previous best of 47 set in 2003. The Golden Eagles have won 40 or more games in each of the last three seasons.

Walk-Off Victories: Southern Miss had four walk-off wins to its credit this season, two coming over Georgia Southern, one over Rice and one over UL Lafayette. The Golden Eagles collected seven a year ago. Hunter Slater provided a bases-loaded, game-winning single in the 10th inning of the first game of the GSU series for a 4-3 decision, while Matt Wallner belted a two-run homer in the first contest of a doubleheader on the second day of the series for a 3-2 victory. The game-winning home run by Wallner was the first for the Golden Eagles since Taylor Braley collected a game-winning blast against Charlotte in the 2017 Conference USA Tournament at MGM Park in Biloxi. Wallner added a RBI single in the 12th against Rice on March 31, before Bryant Bowen collected a game-winning single in the ninth versus UL Lafayette on April 3.

Golden Eagles Sweep In-State Rivals to Open the Season: Southern Miss enjoyed a three-game sweep of in-state rival Mississippi State to start the season. It was first three-game sweep of an SEC foe on opening weekend since beating Missouri at The Pete, Feb. 15-17, 2013. The Golden Eagles played in three sold out affairs, drawing a school-record 14,906 for the three-game set including a best crowd of 4,988 during Saturday's game. The previous best weekend was against Rice (12,623) in 2007.

Scoring Runs: The Golden Eagles were 30-6 in games decided by five or more runs as they average 8.0 runs per contest in 2018 as opposed to 4.3 for their opponents. The scoring margin of 3.7 was the third best in the country behind only Tennessee Tech (4.2) and national champion Oregon State (3.9).

Boyd, Irby Captaining the 2018 Squad: The two seniors, LeeMarcus Boyd and Mason Irby, were voted by their teammates to captain the 2018 squad. Irby posted a .338 batting average and Boyd finished at .289 a season ago. The captains produced 110 runs and 82 RBIs. Off 157 hits, 38 were doubles, five triples and five home runs. They also tallied 16 stolen bases between the two.



Scott Berry Head Coach 9th Year (343-191-1, .642)

With 17 years of being a part of Southern Miss baseball, including the last eight as its head coach, Scott Berry is fully aware of what it has taken to build the Golden Eagles into one of the top programs in the nation.

In fact, Berry led the Golden Eagles to arguably its best season in the program's 89-year history in 2017 with the school's first-ever 50-win season, another Conference USA regular season crown and the hosting of the school's second regional in its history en route to capturing its 16th-straight season of 30 or more wins as well as their 16th consecutive winning season.

For his accomplishments, Berry was named the C-USA Coach of the Year for the second time in his tenure, and the accolades for his program included the league's Player of the Year (Dylan Burdeaux) – the first in the school's time in the league – Freshman of the Year (Matt Wallner) and Assistant Coach of the Year (Chad Cailet). For the second consecutive year, the Golden Eagles had the most first team all-league selections including Burdeaux, Taylor Braley, Kirk McCarty, Nick Sandlin and Colt Smith. Wallner and Mason Irby enjoyed second-team picks.

Wallner also earned a spot on almost every All-American and Freshman All-American squad and became the first Golden Eagle to capture the Baseball America National Freshman of the Year and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Freshman Hitter of the Year. In all, four different Golden Eagles enjoyed All-America status including Braley, Burdeaux, Nick Sandlin and Wallner. The program also enjoyed their first Academic All-Americans since 2011 with Kirk McCarty (second team) and Sandlin (third team).

Berry added to the Golden Eagles list of accomplishments by turning in his first 40-win season since 2009 during the 2016 campaign, capturing its third Conference USA tournament title and returned to the NCAA postseason after a four-year absence. His resume now includes three Conference USA regular-season crowns, two league tournament titles, four trips to the C-USA tournament championship game, four NCAA tournament regional berths, two C-USA Coach of the Year honors and one regional host berth.

The 2016 team battled for the C-USA regular season title up until the final weekend before snaring their first league tournament title since 2010 by winning four-straight games at Pete Taylor Park, including a 3-2 championship game victory over perennial favorite Rice.

The Golden Eagles enjoyed a league high five first-team all-league selections including first baseman Tim Lynch, center fielder Jake Sandlin, right fielder Dylan Burdeaux, catcher Chuckie Robinson and pitcher Kirk McCarty.

With the C-USA tournament title, the Golden Eagles returned to the NCAA Tournament after a four-year absence making their first appearance in Tallahassee, Fla., in a quarter of a decade since both teams were member of the old Metro Conference.

Berry's squad produced yet a couple more All-America selections as Tim Lynch garnered third-team honors by DIBaseball.com and Nick Sandlin collected Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America accolades.

In 2015, Berry's baseball Golden Eagles tallied a 36-18-1 record. What made 2015 so special for the Golden Eagles included the fact that the team went 4-0 against Southeastern Conference foes, including 2-0 against Ole Miss, while also beating Mississippi State and Alabama in the two schools' only meeting of the year. In addition, Southern Miss also swept Tulane and South Alabama during both of its meetings during the year. The team also won its last 10 league games to capture 19 C-USA contests during the year.

Senior pitcher James McMahon became only the second Golden Eagle to win the Ferriss Award for top collegiate player in the state of Mississippi, marking the second time that the program has won that accolade – both coming under the tutelage of Berry. McMahon, who was also the C-USA Pitcher of the Year, went on to become the school's first All-American since Todd McInnis collected the honor in 2011.

During the season, Golden Eagle pitchers tallied a school-record 10 shutouts, while the offense collected their most home runs (42) since the 2010 campaign.

His 2014 club finished 10 games over .500 and reach the bracket final of the C-USA Tournament, finished 35-25 overall and 19-11 in league play. The 19 wins in C-USA play was the most since the 2005 club tallied 20.

In 2013, the Golden Eagles tied with Rice for the second time in the three seasons as the conference's regular-season champion. The program reached the C-USA title game for the second time under Berry, dropping the contest in 11 innings to Rice at Reckling Park in Houston. The Golden Eagles had previously defeated Rice in the 2010 C-USA title matchup, a victory that sent Southern Miss to the postseason in Berry's first year as head coach. The team finished 30-27 in 2013.

Four players from the 2013 squad earned All-C-USA honors. Senior catcher Chase Fowler, senior pitcher Andrew Pierce and senior infielder Isaac Rodriguez earned first-team accolades while sophomore pitcher/outfielder Mason Robbins garnered second-team honors.

In 2012, a young Southern Miss squad went through growing pains but still captured 32 wins during the campaign.

In 2011, Berry earned C-USA Coach of the Year Honors as he led the program to its ninth-consecutive NCAA postseason and captured a share of the Conference USA regular season title en route to a 39-19 mark and the 2011 NCAA Atlanta Regional.

In Berry's first season as head coach, 2010, he was able to continue the success that he helped build while an assistant. That season, the Golden Eagles compiled a 36-24 record and won their first Conference USA tournament title since 2003 when they defeated nationally-ranked Rice 7-4 in the championship game, a win that earned the program its eighth-straight NCAA Tournament appearance.

Berry's initial success as the top man in the program came on the heels of a magical 2009 season in which Berry, as associate head coach to Corky Palmer, helped lead the program to its first Super Regional. In that round of the postseason, Southern Miss swept Florida in Gainesville and earned an inaugural visit to the College World Series. The team ended with a No. 8 final ranking in three different polls.

Also in 2009, with Berry's guidance, McInnis garnered the school's first major Conference USA postseason award as he was named the C-USA Pitcher of the Year. Prior to his appointment as the Golden Eagles' top man on May 7, 2009, Berry spent the previous six years as the associate head coach and the three seasons prior to that as an assistant coach on the Southern Miss baseball staff.

Berry oversaw the Golden Eagles pitching staff, worked with the catchers, had recruiting responsibilities and assisted with the program's camps and clinics from 2003-2009. Prior to the 2003 season, he served as the team's hitting coach and worked with catchers and outfielders.

After completing an unbelievable four-year stint as the head coach at Meridian Community College from 1997-2000, including two trips to the National Junior College World Series, Berry rejoined his mentor, Corky Palmer, at Southern Miss prior to the 2001 season.

A native of Neosho, Mo., he compiled an impressive record of 185-58, including two seasons of 50 wins or more. During his four-year tenure at Meridian, Berry's squad spent the entire time in the top 10 of the national polls. He had more than 25 players sign NCAA Division I scholarships and had, at that time, nine former players in the professional ranks.

Berry's most successful professional player was Cliff Lee, who studied under Berry at in 1999 and 2000 at Meridian Community College. Lee was honored after his eighth year in the major leagues with the 2008 American League Cy Young Award.

For his efforts, Berry was honored as a three-time Region 23 Coach of the Year, three-time district coach of the year, three-time Louisville Slugger Coach of the Year Award and two-time Diamond Sports ABCA Region Coach of the Year.

On January 24, 2010, MCC recognized Berry's accomplishments and retired his jersey number (40).

In 2000, Meridian finished fifth in the nation with a 46-19 record and took its second trip under Berry to the National Junior College World Series. The program made its first trip under Berry to the college world series in 1998, when they posted a 52-12 record and ended the season as the No. 5 team in the nation.

His first season, 1997, saw his squad ranked as the top team in the country from the preseason poll until the final regular season poll. That team posted a 50-8 record and advanced to the district finals before their season ended. Berry's first stint with Palmer started in 1991, when he was hired as an assistant coach at Meridian. After a six-year tenure as the assistant coach, he took over the reins of the Meridian program when Palmer returned to Southern Miss to join Hill Denson's staff.

For his outstanding service at Meridian, Berry was inducted in the Mississippi Junior College Hall of Fame in the spring of 2014.

He completed his bachelor's degree in secondary education with an emphasis in physical education from Southwest Missouri State University in 1986 and also received his master's degree from SMSU in 1989 with a degree in secondary education with an emphasis in administration.

His collegiate career began at Crowder College, where he was a two-time all-region selection as a catcher and was named the team's most valuable player as a sophomore. Berry was forced to end his playing career early with a back injury. He spent the last two years of his undergraduate tenure as a student assistant at SMSU.

Berry, and his wife, Laura, have two children, Garren, and Kathryn (Kitty Grace). Laura received her bachelor's and master's degrees from Southern Miss in speech communication. He is the son of Marilyn Berry and the late James Berry of Neosho, Mo.
