Last Time Out: Outfielder Gabe Montenegro drove in a career-high four runs with a pair of two-run singles as the Golden Eagles overcame Southern 12-1 Tuesday night at Pete Taylor Park. Fifteenth-ranked Southern Miss scored 10 runs or more in a game for the eighth time this season as it won its seventh consecutive game. The Golden Eagles broke open a scoreless game in the sixth inning on one-out singles by Matt Wallner and Hunter Slater and consecutive two-out walks to Cole Donaldson, Mason Irby and LeeMarcus Boyd. After the Jaguars (6-13) cut the lead to 2-1 in the top of the seventh inning on a run-scoring single by Javeyan Williams, the Golden Eagles bunched four hits and three more walks to take an 8-1 lead. Donaldson and Daniel Keating each had an RBI-single, Boyd knocked in another on a fielder's choice and a fourth scored on a throwing error on a force play at the plate. Montenegro capped the six-run rally with a two-run single. Southern Miss added four more runs in the eighth inning, including Erick Hoard's first home run as a Golden Eagle, Fred Franklin's sacrifice fly and Montenegro's second two-run single. Jacob Weirich (3-0) picked the win, striking out two in his scoreless sixth inning.

Walk-Off Victories: Southern Miss has two walk-off wins this season, both over Georgia Southern earlier this month. The Golden Eagles collected a total of seven a year ago. Hunter Slater provided a bases-loaded game-winning single in the 10th inning of the first game for a 4-3 decision, while Matt Wallner belted a two-run opposite field homer in the first contest of a doubleheader on the second day of the series for a 3-2 victory. The game-winning home run by Wallner was the first for the Golden Eagles since Taylor Braley belted a game-winning blast against Charlotte in the 2017 Conference USA Tournament at MGM Park in Biloxi. That game, which finished 6-5, allowed the Golden Eagles to play Charlotte again later in the day for the bracket championship which they won.

Random Golden Eagle Notes: Southern Miss has currently won seven-straight games as well as eight consecutive C-USA home games and 14-straight league games dating back to last season by winning the first two contests to start the conference schedule...Southern Miss has captured their last three leagues home series and 12 of their last 13, dating back to the 2015 campaign...The series finale with UTSA was rained out, marking only the second time since joining C-USA that the Golden Eagles lost a league home game due to weather. The only other time this happened was against Memphis during the 2000 season. It was the first time Southern Miss lost a league game since the final game of the Louisiana Tech series was washed out in 2015.

Strong Pitching in March: In the month of March, the Golden Eagle pitching staff has accumulated an 9-2 record with a 2.73 earned run average and have fanned 105 and walked only 29 in 99 innings of work.

Scoring Runs: With its 12-1 victory over Southern, the Golden Eagles are now 9-0 in games decided by five or more runs as they average 8.9 runs per contest in 2018.

Wallner Getting it Done at Plate and on Mound: Sophomore Matt Wallner, who did not hit a home run over his first 13 games this season, now has three over the last six games, including a solo shot in the opening game of the UTSA series. Wallner, who has also served as the team's closer, threw a successful ninth in the nightcap last Saturday to earn his third save of the year.

Golden Eagles Sweep In-State Rivals to Open the Season: Southern Miss enjoyed a three-game sweep of in-state rival Mississippi State as the Golden Eagles outscored the Bulldogs 23-6 in the series. It was the fourth-straight season that the Golden Eagles recorded a three-game sweep of its first opponent and first three-game sweep of an SEC foe on opening weekend since beating Missouri at The Pete, Feb. 15-17, 2013. The Golden Eagles played in three sold out affairs, drawing a school-record 14,906 for the three-game set including a best crowd of 4,988 on Saturday. The previous best weekend was against Rice (12,623) in 2007.

Mister 300: Southern Miss ninth-year coach Scott Berry registered his 300th career victory in the season opener last Friday, despite not dressing out in the game. Berry had to sit out the first two games, following a two-game suspension handed out in the NCAA Regional final in Hattiesburg last June. He also posted a 185-58 mark in four seasons at the helm of the Meridian (Miss.) Community College program.

Preseason All-American Honors: Both junior Nick Sandlin and sophomore Matt Wallner earned a slew of preseason awards. The first of the many preseason accolades for the pair came from Collegiate Baseball placing them on the Pre-season All-American second team. Perfect Game then placed Sandlin on the first-team preseason squad and Wallner on the second-team as a utility player. The website D1 baseball honored the duo again as each were tabbed with preseason first-team All-American honors. The pair swept the preseason C-USA individual awards as Sandlin was named the preseason Pitcher of Year and Wallner the preseason Player of the Year, while outfielder Mason Irby also earned a place on the preseason All-League team. The pair's last accolade was made by the NCBWA as First-Team preseason All-Americans. Wallner garnished two more preseason nominations from Baseball America and was named to the Golden Spikes Award Watch List as a utility player.

Boyd, Irby Captaining the 2018 Squad: The two seniors, LeeMarcus Boyd and Mason Irby, were voted by their teammates to captain the 2018 squad. Irby posted a .338 batting average and Boyd finished at .289 a season ago. The captains produced 110 runs and 82 RBIs. Off 157 hits, 38 were doubles, five triples and five home runs. 16 bases were stolen between the two.

Eagles Capture C-USA Regular Season Crown No. 4: Southern Miss captured the 2017 Conference USA regular season crown, winning the league race by six games. It marked the fourth time that it has achieved that milestone. The Golden Eagles first won the crown in 2003 and tied with Rice for the title in the 2011 and 2013 campaigns. Three of the regular season titles have come under current head coach Scott Berry.

Come Up Just Short in C-USA Baseball Championship: After dropping its first game of the C-USA Baseball Championship to UTSA, 9-2, the Golden Eagles rallied for four straight victories - with wins over LA Tech, UTSA and twice over Charlotte - before reaching the title game for the seventh time in its 22-year history of the league, losing on a hit in the ninth, 5-4, to Rice. The last five C-USA championships the Golden Eagles have been in were against the Owls. It was only the second time in the school's C-USA history that it was the No. 1 seed in the event (2003 was the other).

2017 Season Notes: The Golden Eagles finished the year by winning 20 of their final 24 games...That included a school-record 14-game winning streak to end the regular season...Scored a school-record 544, which led the nation in 2017...Totaled the most strikeouts by a pitching staff in its history in a season with 583, besting the previous total of 524 in 1995...Recorded a 24-7 home record and an 11-4 C-USA home record, the best home record in C-USA. While at home, the Golden Eagles outscored its opponents 263-145 last spring.

40 Wins: The Golden Eagles have now won 40 or more games 10 times in their history. USM first won 40 games in 1990. Southern Miss set its school record for victories in 2017 with 50, surpassing the previous best of 47 set in 2003.

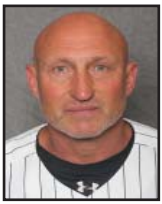
Wallner Led All Frosh in Homers in 2017: Freshman Matt Wallner had the most home runs of any freshman in the country and ranks second in the nation in RBI, behind only Braden Shewmake of Texas A&M. Wallner posted 19 home runs and 63 RBI last season, which are both Southern Miss freshman records. For his efforts, Wallner was named to a multitude of postseason awards including the **Baseball America** Freshman of the Year and the NCBWA Freshman Hitter of the Year.

Same Name, Different Person: Once again in 2018 Southern Miss had a Cody Carroll on the roster. Don't be confused, though, as this was not the Carroll from Mt. Juliet, Tenn., who lettered for the program from 2013-15 as a pitcher and currently plays in the New York Yankees farm system. Instead, this Carroll - also a pitcher - is a right-hander from Mount Dora, Fla., at Eustis HS.

Players Drafted: Southern Miss had four players taken in the 2017 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft, marking the most in a season since 2014. Here is a list of the players chosen and the clubs they were taken by:

Scott Berry Head Coach 9th Year (314-177-1, .639)

With 17 years of being a part of Southern Miss baseball, including the last eight as its head coach, Scott Berry is fully aware of what it has taken to build the Golden Eagles into one of the top programs in the nation.

In fact, Berry led the Golden Eagles to arguably its best season in the program's 89-year history in 2017 with the school's first-ever 50-win season, another Conference USA regular season crown and the hosting of the school's second regional in its history en route to capturing its 16th-straight season of 30 or more wins as well as their 16th consecutive winning season.

For his accomplishments, Berry was named the C-USA Coach of the Year for the second time in his tenure, and the accolades for his program included the league's Player of the Year (Dylan Burdeaux) – the first in the school's time in the league – Freshman of the Year (Matt Wallner) and Assistant Coach of the Year (Chad Caillet). For the second consecutive year, the Golden Eagles had the most first team all-league selections including Burdeaux, Taylor Braley, Kirk McCarty, Nick Sandlin and Colt Smith. Wallner and Mason Irby enjoyed second-team picks.

Wallner also earned a spot on almost every All-American and Freshman All-American squad and became the first Golden Eagle to capture the Baseball America National Freshman of the Year and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association Freshman Hitter of the Year. In all, four different Golden Eagles enjoyed All-America status including Braley, Burdeaux, Nick Sandlin and Wallner. The program also enjoyed their first Academic All-Americans since 2011 with Kirk McCarty (second team) and Sandlin (third team).

Berry added to the Golden Eagles list of accomplishments by turning in his first 40-win season since 2009 during the 2016 campaign, capturing its third Conference USA tournament title and returned to the NCAA postseason after a four-year absence. His resume now includes three Conference USA regular-season crowns, two league tournament titles, four trips to the C-USA tournament championship game, four NCAA tournament regional berths, two C-USA Coach of the Year honors and one regional host berth.

The 2016 team battled for the C-USA regular season title up until the final weekend before snaring their first league tournament title since 2010 by winning four-straight games at Pete Taylor Park, including a 3-2 championship game victory over perennial favorite Rice.

The Golden Eagles enjoyed a league high five first-team all-league selections including first baseman Tim Lynch, center fielder Jake Sandlin, right fielder Dylan Burdeaux, catcher Chuckie Robinson and pitcher Kirk McCarty.

With the C-USA tournament title, the Golden Eagles returned to the NCAA Tournament after a four-year absence making their first appearance in Tallahassee, Fla., in a quarter of a decade since both teams were member of the old Metro Conference.

Berry's squad produced yet a couple more All-America selections as Tim Lynch garnered third-team honors by DIBaseball.com and Nick Sandlin collected Louisville Slugger Freshman All-America accolades.

In 2015, Berry's baseball Golden Eagles tallied a 36-18-1 record. What made 2015 so special for the Golden Eagles included the fact that the team went 4-0 against Southeastern Conference foes, including 2-0 against Ole Miss, while also beating Mississippi State and Alabama in the two schools' only meeting of the year. In addition, Southern Miss also swept Tulane and South Alabama during both of its meetings during the year. The team also won its last 10 league games to capture 19 C-USA contests during the year.

Senior pitcher James McMahon became only the second Golden Eagle to win the Ferriss Award for top collegiate player in the state of Mississippi, marking the second time that the program has won that accolade – both coming under the tutelage of Berry. McMahon, who was also the C-USA Pitcher of the Year, went on to become the school's first All-American since Todd McInnis collected the honor in 2011.

During the season, Golden Eagle pitchers tallied a school-record 10 shutouts, while the offense collected their most home runs (42) since the 2010 campaign.

His 2014 club finished 10 games over .500 and reach the bracket final of the C-USA Tournament, finished 35-25 overall and 19-11 in league play. The 19 wins in C-USA play was the most since the 2005 club tallied 20.

In 2013, the Golden Eagles tied with Rice for the second time in the three seasons as the conference's regular-season champion. The program reached the C-USA title game for the second time under Berry, dropping the contest in 11 innings to Rice at Reckling Park in Houston. The Golden Eagles had previously defeated Rice in the 2010 C-USA title matchup, a victory that sent Southern Miss to the postseason in Berry's first year as head coach. The team finished 30-27 in 2013.

Four players from the 2013 squad earned All-C-USA honors. Senior catcher Chase Fowler, senior pitcher Andrew Pierce and senior infielder Isaac Rodriguez earned first-team accolades while sophomore pitcher/outfielder Mason Robbins garnered second-team honors.

In 2012, a young Southern Miss squad went through growing pains but still captured 32 wins during the campaign.

In 2011, Berry earned C-USA Coach of the Year Honors as he led the program to its ninth-consecutive NCAA postseason and captured a share of the Conference USA regular season title en route to a 39-19 mark and the 2011 NCAA Atlanta Regional.

In Berry's first season as head coach, 2010, he was able to continue the success that he helped build while an assistant. That season, the Golden Eagles compiled a 36-24 record and won their first Conference USA tournament title since 2003 when they defeated nationally-ranked Rice 7-4 in the championship game, a win that earned the program its eighth-straight NCAA Tournament appearance.

Berry's initial success as the top man in the program came on the heels of a magical 2009 season in which Berry, as associate head coach to Corky Palmer, helped lead the program to its first Super Regional. In that round of the postseason, Southern Miss swept Florida in Gainesville and earned an inaugural visit to the College World Series. The team ended with a No. 8 final ranking in three different polls.

Also in 2009, with Berry's guidance, McInnis garnered the school's first major Conference USA postseason award as he was named the C-USA Pitcher of the Year. Prior to his appointment as the Golden Eagles' top man on May 7, 2009, Berry spent the previous six years as the associate head coach and the three seasons prior to that as an assistant coach on the Southern Miss baseball staff.

Berry oversaw the Golden Eagles pitching staff, worked with the catchers, had recruiting responsibilities and assisted with the program's camps and clinics from 2003-2009. Prior to the 2003 season, he served as the team's hitting coach and worked with catchers and outfielders.

After completing an unbelievable four-year stint as the head coach at Meridian Community College from 1997-2000, including two trips to the National Junior College World Series, Berry rejoined his mentor, Corky Palmer, at Southern Miss prior to the 2001 season.

A native of Neosho, Mo., he compiled an impressive record of 185-58, including two seasons of 50 wins or more. During his four-year tenure at Meridian, Berry's squad spent the entire time in the top 10 of the national polls. He had more than 25 players sign NCAA Division I scholarships and had, at that time, nine former players in the professional ranks.

Berry's most successful professional player was Cliff Lee, who studied under Berry at in 1999 and 2000 at Meridian Community College. Lee was honored after his eighth year in the major leagues with the 2008 American League Cy Young Award.

For his efforts, Berry was honored as a three-time Region 23 Coach of the Year, three-time district coach of the year, three-time Louisville Slugger Coach of the Year Award and two-time Diamond Sports ABCA Region Coach of the Year.

On January 24, 2010, MCC recognized Berry's accomplishments and retired his jersey number (40).

In 2000, Meridian finished fifth in the nation with a 46-19 record and took its second trip under Berry to the National Junior College World Series. The program made its first trip under Berry to the college world series in 1998, when they posted a 52-12 record and ended the season as the No. 5 team in the nation.

His first season, 1997, saw his squad ranked as the top team in the country from the preseason poll until the final regular season poll. That team posted a 50-8 record and advanced to the district finals before their season ended. Berry's first stint with Palmer started in 1991, when he was hired as an assistant coach at Meridian. After a six-year tenure as the assistant coach, he took over the reins of the Meridian program when Palmer returned to Southern Miss to join Hill Denson's staff.

For his outstanding service at Meridian, Berry was inducted in the Mississippi Junior College Hall of Fame in the spring of 2014.

He completed his bachelor's degree in secondary education with an emphasis in physical education from Southwest Missouri State University in 1986 and also received his master's degree from SMSU in 1989 with a degree in secondary education with an emphasis in administration.

His collegiate career began at Crowder College, where he was a two-time all-region selection as a catcher and was named the team's most valuable player as a sophomore.
