Noting the Golden Eagles

- Southern Miss is currently enjoying its 100th football season - having competed for the first time in 1912. The Golden Eagles have posted an all-time record of 578-414-27, which is the 38th best among Division I FBS teams in terms of winning percentage (.580).
- Jay Hopson, the 21st person to guide the program at Southern Miss as its head coach, is in his first season. Hopson coached under the legendary Jeff Bower twice at Southern Miss, working as an assistant coach from 2001-03 and then from 2005-07.
- Through the first 10 games, the Golden Eagles are averaging 80.0 offensive plays per contest (800 total) compared to 55.7 per game (557) for their opponents, bettering them by 24.3 more plays per contest.
- The Golden Eagles have tallied scoring drives (TDs or FGs) of 10 or more plays 23 times this season. Southern Miss had just eight double-digit scoring drives all of last season.
- The team has four 90-plus yard drives this season including two against Charlotte and one last week at Old Dominion. That includes a 99-yard drive against the 49ers and a 93-yard last weekend at ODU.
- The 99-yard scoring drive for the Golden Eagles was the first since the opening drive at Navy on Oct. 8, 2011.
- With senior QB Nick Mullens sitting out last weekend due to injury, freshman Keon Howard made his first career start in his first action as a Golden Eagle at ODU. He is the 10th Southern Miss player since the start of the 2008 season to start at quarterback. He is also just the sixth true freshman to every start at the position in the school's history as the last was Nick Mullens in 2013.
- Mullens had a 25-game starting streak at QB snapped in the contest, while center Cameron Tom started for his current team-high 45th consecutive time.
- Ito Smith went over the 1,000-yard mark for the season, finishing with 97 yards and now has 1,081 on the season. He is the fourth player to rush for over 1,000 yards in more than one season during their career with the others being Damion Fletcher (2006, 2007, 2008, 2009), Derrick Nix (1998, 1999, 2002) and Ben Garry (1976, 1977).
- Defensive back D'Nerius Antoine, who has the team's lead in tackles this season with 66, paced the team with seven tackles in the contest - the fourth time he has led the squad in that category this season.

The North Texas Series

- This will be the 11th meeting between the Golden Eagles and Mean Green with the Golden Eagles leading 6-4 in the series (see complete series on page 4).
- Southern Miss has won the last two games in the series and five of the last six contests, winning 49-14 in Hattiesburg last season (see page 3 for recap and stats for that game).
- The Golden Eagles are 2-2 in games played in Denton, winning the last trip there, 30-20, during the 2014 campaign.

Versus Conference USA

- The Golden Eagles currently are competing in their 21st season in Conference USA.
- Southern Miss holds an all-time mark of 95-60 in Conference USA contests, including a 49-28 mark at home, while compiling a 46-32 ledger on the road.
- In its first 20 seasons of C-USA play, Southern Miss has enjoyed 16 seasons of winning marks as well as one year of finishing at .500.

Top 10 Statistical Measures

- The Golden Eagles enjoy top 10 national rankings in the following categories through 11 weeks of the regular season: No. 2 in 3rd defensive down conversions (.244/30-or-123), No. 3 in first downs allowed (138) and seventh in passing yards allowed (166.6 pg).
- Parker Shaunfield's 92.3 percent field goals made (12-for-13) is tied for 7th in country with three other FBS kickers.
- Dylan Bradley is tied for fourth in blocked kicks this season as he has tallied a pair this season including one against Marshall.

Jay Hopson

Head Football Coach | First Season - 5-5 (.500)

Jay Hopson, a 24-year coaching veteran on the collegiate level and twice previously a member of the Golden Eagle coaching staff, became the school's 21st head football coach this spring as the program embarks on its 100th playing season this fall.

A native of Vicksburg, Miss., Hopson returns to Southern Miss after a successful four-year stint as the head coach at Alcorn State. During his tenure there, Hopson led the Braves to a 32-17 record and consecutive Southwestern Athletic Conference championships the last two seasons. Alcorn State also recorded at least nine victories in each of the last three seasons, including a 10-3 mark in 2014 and following this season, Hopson led the Braves to the inaugural Celebration Bowl, a postseason football bowl featuring two standout programs from Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU).

His team also captured the SBN Black College Championship in 2014.

Prior to his arrival at Lorman, Hopson worked as linebackers coach for two seasons at Michigan (2008-09) and worked as defensive coordinator at Memphis during the 2010 and 2011 campaigns.

Hopson returns to Southern Miss after working as an assistant coach for the Golden Eagles from 2001-03 (defensive backs) and then again from 2005-07 (linebackers, defensive coordinator).

Hopson's defensive units led Conference USA in scoring defense each of his three seasons as defensive coordinator. In 2006, the Golden Eagles led C-USA in third down defense and red zone defense while his 2005 unit led the league in turnovers forced per game as well as led the nation in fumbles gained.

During his first stint with the Golden Eagles, the defensive unit led the nation in fewest passing touchdowns allowed and finished fourth nationally in pass efficiency defense in 2002. Southern Miss led C-USA and finished fifth nationally in pass defense during the 2003 season and each year during that stretch, Southern Miss ranked in the Top 15 nationally in scoring defense.

Hopson spent 2004 at his alma mater, the University of Mississippi, as defensive backs coach and was the program's recruiting coordinator. The Rebels' pass defense improved from 109th nationally in 2003 to 49th during the 2004 campaign.

Hopson's coaching experience also includes positions at Marshall (1996-2000) and Delta State (1993) as defensive backs coach. He was a member of the Herds' 1996 NCAA I-AA National Championship staff and coached the team to four straight Mid-American Conference championships. Hopson also held defensive graduate assistant positions at the Florida (1995), LSU (1994) and Tulane (1992). He helped the Gators to the Southeastern Conference championship and played for the national championship in the Fiesta Bowl.

He earned four-year letters and received the 1991 John Howard Vaught Award as a player at Ole Miss. A CoSIDA Academic All-American, Hopson graduated from Ole Miss with a bachelor's degree in business administration (1992) and received a master's of health in physical education and recreation from Delta State (1994).

Hopson and his wife, Michelle, have two daughters, Virginia and Hannah.

Last Time Out Versus North Texas

Southern Miss 49, North Texas 14 Oct. 24, 2015

HATTIESBURG, Miss. - Something about North Texas just seems to bring out the best in Southern Miss junior quarterback Nick Mullens.

Mullens threw for 325 yards and four touchdowns while rushing for a fifth score Saturday night as the Golden Eagles won their opening Conference USA football game for the first time since 2010 with a 49-14 victory over North Texas before 26,430 at M.M. Roberts Stadium.

A week after throwing for 447 yards against Nebraska, Mullens picked up where he left off in Lincoln.

He connected with senior Mike Thomas on three touchdowns, including a pair of 5-yard scores and a 62-yard flea-flicker, had a 3-yard score to senior Casey Martin and did not throw an interception for a third consecutive game.

He also collected his second rushing touchdown of the season on a 4-yard keeper.

Mullens passed for 300-plus yards for a third consecutive week and the eighth time in his career. It marked the second time this season that he had thrown four touchdowns in a game, topped only by a five-touchdown pass game against UAB in 2013. His five-scores-accounted-for Saturday were only topped by six-accounted-for in that same game with the Blazers.

Mullens, who came in Saturday ranked fifth nationally in total passing yards and eighth in passing yards per game, lit up the Mean Green for a second consecutive season. Last year, He threw for 305 yards and two scores in a 30-20 victory in Denton, Texas.

Ito Smith averaged 10.6 yards every time he touched the football. The sophomore running back had 84 yards rushing on nine carries and 85 yards receiving on seven catches. He scored his third touchdown of the season on a 4-yard run to open the fourth quarter.

All told, Southern Miss piled up 573 yards total offense, including 248 yards rushing.

Thomas, who had 11 catches on the season, grabbed seven passes Saturday for a career-high 155 yards and a best-ever three touchdown catches. He topped the 100-yard receiving mark for a second consecutive week after catching five passes for 121 yards against Nebraska.

North Texas boasted a 100-yard rusher (136 yards, Jeffrey Wilson) and 100-yard receiver (136 yards, Carlos Harris), but the Golden Eagles held the Mean Green scoreless until the fourth quarter.

The Golden Eagles stopped a North Texas scoring threat with an end-zone interception by Cornell Armstrong and recorded nine tackles for loss, including five sacks.

The five sacks gave USM 13 sacks after five games. Last year, the Golden Eagles logged 14 sacks in 12 games in 2014.

USM led 21-0 at halftime on Mullens' passes to Thomas and Martin and his scoring run.

The Golden Eagles made it 28-0 midway through the third quarter on a 5-yard pass to Thomas, and then tacked on another score a few minutes later when senior running back Jalen Richard lateralled back to Mullens, who found Thomas wide open behind the defense.

Harris scored on a 23-yard touchdown pass from Andrew McNulty on the second play of the final quarter to get North Texas within 35-7, but Smith scored on a 4-yard run and senior running back Justice Hayes on a 2-yarder to push the lead to 49-7 with 6:35 to play.

Willy Ivery scored on a 3-yard run with 4:03 to play, but it was not nearly enough to allow the Mean Green to extend its losing streak to five games and nine consecutive losses on the road.

A Proud Bowl History

The Southern Miss football program captured its 68th winning campaign in 2015, snapping a three-season losing streak. When the most recent winning streak was broken in 2012, the Golden Eagles had the fourth-longest season winning streak at 18, behind only Florida State, Florida and Virginia Tech. Five Time C-USA Champions

Southern Miss, which won its third division title last season, lost in the C-USA championship game at WKU, 45-28. The Golden Eagles are 1-2 in C-USA championship games. They captured their first league title contest and the school's fifth overall league crown - more than any other school in the conference - when they beat Houston, 49-28, in 2011. The school's other C-USA titles have come in the inaugural season of 1996 as well as the 1997, 1999 and 2003 campaigns. The league divisional setup began during 2005 and also marked the first year for a league championship game. The Golden Eagles have won two East Division crowns in C-USA (2006, 2011), and captured their first West title last season after moving to that division during the 2014 campaign.

Overtime Anyone?

Southern Miss has been involved in 10 overtime games since the rule went into effect prior to the 1996 season and the Golden Eagles are 4-6 overall, after losing a 38-31 double OT game at UCF in 2012. Pro Traditions

Southern Miss, which has a reputation in training and producing professional talent over the years, has a long list of former players that have reached the National Football League including the likes of Ray Guy, Brett Favre, Sammy Winder, Michael Boley and Jamie Collins. Southern Miss has had at least one player drafted in 12 of the last 16 NFL drafts, including wide receiver Mike Thomas, who was taken in the sixth round last April by the Los Angeles Rams and defensive back Kalan Reed, who was the last player chosen in the NFL Draft's seventh round by the Tennessee Titans. Since 1942, 120 players have been drafted by the NFL, AFL or AAFC, which including a school-best four on nine different occasions.

Another Player in the Pro Football Hall of Fame

Southern Miss is one of only four schools to have multiple former players elected into the Pro Football Hall of Fame from 2014 through 2016. Ray Guy (1970-72) earned selection in 2014 as the first ever punter to get elected. Former Golden Eagle quarterback Brett Favre (1987-90) was inducted in early August. Bower Academic Excellence Center Announced

In the summer of the 2015, the Department of Athletics, in conjunction with the Southern Miss Athletic Foundation, announced the launch of the Bower Academic Excellence Center Campaign. The \$2 million capital campaign will fund a new student-athlete academic center named in honor of longtime Golden Eagle football coach Jeff Bower. As the second-winningest coach in the program's history with 119 victories over 17 seasons and Conference USA's first Coach of the Decade, Bower established a very strong record of success on the field while placing an even greater emphasis on his student-athletes' success in the classroom. In addition to the program's graduation rate, numerous former Golden Eagles earned Academic All-Conference and Academic All-American honors. Also, the Bower family's emphasis on academics has been demonstrated by their scholarship endowment, which currently ranks as the Southern Miss Athletic Foundation's largest endowment. The project is expected to break ground during the football season.

Here Comes The Judge

Junior running back Ito Smith returned this season to the Golden Eagles as their featured player in the backfield after rushing for a team-best 1,128 yards in 2015. It was the first time a Golden Eagle running back ran for over 1,000 yards since Damion Fletcher tallied 1,015 yards his senior campaign in 2009. In fact, Smith and Jalen Richard (1,098) each rushed for over 1,000 yards, marking the first time a pair of Golden Eagles achieved that feat since 1981.

Smith now is one of four Golden Eagles to rush for over 1,000 yards in multiple seasons after reaching that number last weekend at ODU. Damion Fletcher (2006,2007, 2008, 2009) did it four times, while Derrick Nix did it three times (1998, 1999, 2002) and Ben Garry (1976, 1977) twice.

Smith has 2,745 yards in 36 games for a 76.2 per game average. He had six 100-yard rushing games in 2015, and now has 13 for his career which puts him in fourth-place. He opened the season by tallying a career-high 173 yards on a career-best 36 carries at Kentucky. He added 128 yards on eight carries and notched the longest Southern Miss run in this 41-year history of M.M. Roberts Stadium with an 86-yard touchdown run against Savannah State. Smith has rushed for over 100 yards in five games this season and currently ranks No. 17 in the nation in with 1,081 rushing yards. He has now scored at least one TD in some fashion in each of his last 15 games after picking up a rushing touchdown against Charlotte last weekend.

Ito Moving Up in All-Purpose Yards as well

Ito Smith also registered the second-best season in terms of all-purpose yards in 2015, tallying 1,876 (1,128 rush, 515 receiving, 233 kickoff returns). He has now tallied 4,115 all-purpose yards overall and moved into fourth place on the all-time Southern Miss chart with 108 all-purpose yards last weekend at ODU, bypassing former running back Ben Garry (1974-77), who had 4,071 yards in this category. In two-plus seasons, Smith is averaging 114.3 all-purpose yards per game for Southern Miss. He registered a game-high 213 all-purpose yards in the opener at Kentucky. He added 148 all-purpose yards against Troy and 141 versus UTEP and had 183 versus Marshall.

George Payne Returns to the Field

Junior George Payne returned to running back in 2016 for the Golden Eagles after missing last season with an injury. Payne has notched 880 career rushing yards over two seasons and has eight rushing scores to his credit. Payne recorded his first 100-yard rushing game against Kentucky with 16 carries for 100 yards for the Golden Eagles and followed that with 116 yards against Savannah State.

The Watch List Kid

Senior quarterback Nick Mullens has reaped the rewards of a stellar junior season. In a year in which he threw for single-season school records for passing yards (4,476) and touchdowns passes (38) as the school went over the 7,000-total offensive yard mark last season for the first time with 7,133. Mullens is the defending C-USA Offensive Player of the Year and earned the same honor in this preseason, becoming the first Golden Eagle to win that award.

Mullens Becomes All-Time Passing Yard Record Holder at School

After starting the final six games of the 2013 season, Nick Mullens returned as the team's signal caller in 2014 by starting in 10 of 12 games, missing only two contests with a foot injury. He started in every game a season ago and had a 25-straight game streak snapped last weekend when he missed the ODU game due to injury. In his career, Mullens has a school-record 34, 200-plus throwing contests in 39 career starts (18-21). Against Rice earlier this season, Mullens shattered the school record for passing yards for a game with 591 yards on 25-of-36 attempts (with four touchdown passes), breezing past Austin Davis' previous school record of 461 yards set also versus Rice in 2008. now has three of the top four passing games in Golden Eagle history. Mullens also went over the 10,000-yard passing mark in the contest after hitting Allenzae Stagers with his 81-yard touchdown pass early in the third quarter.

He was the fifth true freshman at the school to ever get a start at quarterback in 2013, and now has thrown 82 career touchdown passes, ranking in second place on the school charts behind Austin Davis' 83. His career 269.2 yards per game passing currently ranks as the best for that category by any Golden Eagle QB, ahead of Davis who tallied 242.0 per game.

He became the school's record holder for career passing yards against Marshall with 300 yards in the contest, racing past Davis' previous best total of 10,892. He currently has 11,306 in his career.

Mullens left the Charlotte game in the third quarter with an injury.

Mullens Throws for 300 Yards More than any other Golden Eagle

With his 591 yards thrown against Rice, Mullens threw for over the 300-yard plateau for the 17th time in his career. Against Rice in 2015, Mullens tied a school record with five touchdown passes, of which he had already accomplished once in his career (UAB, 2013), all coming in the first half. He now has thrown at least three TD passes in 14 games in his career, including at least four TD passes in seven different games during his career and five TD contests twice.

He broke then Davis' single-season record for both passing yards and touchdown passes during the ODU contest (11/21/15) last season.

Mullens also needs 60 completions and 55 attempts to become the school's all-time leader in those categories as well.

Freshman Keon Howard Makes First Start at QB at ODU

Freshman Keon Howard made his first career start in his first action as a Golden Eagle at ODU last weekend. He is the 10th Southern Miss player since the start of the 2008 season to start at quarterback. He is also just the sixth true freshman to every start at the position in the school's history, with Mullens being the last in 2013.

Howard's 98 rushing yards is the most ever by a Golden Eagle freshman playing in their first game, surpassing Damion Fletcher, who notched 89 at Florida to start the 2006 campaign.

Spreading the Love Again

There were 16 players that have caught at least one pass last season. Five different receivers caught at least 30 passes a year ago including a school-record 80 by then senior Casey Martin, followed by 71 from current Los Angeles Ram Mike Thomas, along with 55 from D.J. Thompson, 49 from Ito Smith and 30 from Jalen Richard. In the first 10 games of this season, 15 different players have caught passes for the Golden Eagles. Allenzae Staggers leads the way with 46 catches, while Smith is second with 35 and Thompson is third at 31.

Part of the New Receiving Crew

Junior transfers Isaiah Jones (Milton, Fla.) and Allenzae Staggers (Woodville, Miss.) have been looked to step into the receivers position for the Golden Eagles this fall. Both attended East Mississippi Community College and were part of the Netflix original series "Last Chance U" a season ago. Jones grabbed 19 passes for 239 yards and two touchdowns, while Staggers tallied 37 receptions for 477 yards and five scores. Both have enjoyed solid starts to their Golden Eagle careers. Jones caught a 71-yard touchdown pass against Kentucky and then added a 65-yard scoring grab against Savannah State. Staggers registered the first punt return for a touchdown since 2011 for Southern Miss when he returned one for 75 yards for a score against Savannah State and added a 16-yard touchdown pass versus Troy.

The duo are among the team leaders in receiving this season. Staggers has 46 catches for 831 yards and six scores, while Jones has 20 catches for 331 yards and two receiving touchdowns.

Staggers Breaks Southern Miss Single Game Receiving Record

Against Rice, Allenzae Staggers caught six passes for a school-record 292 receiving yards (surpassing Kendrick Lee's 260 against Houston on Nov. 9, 1996). His catches included touchdown receptions of 75, 81 and 93 yards. It was the first three TD receiving game for the program since Mike Thomas had that number against North Texas in 2015. Those scoring catches were the first three he made in the contest. According to ESPN Stats and Info, he is the first college player in 10 years to catch three 75-plus yard touchdowns in the same game. He also garnered an ESPN helmet sticker for his performance against the Owls, marking the first time that has happened for a Golden Eagle since 2013. His other catches included grabs of 19, 16 and eight yards for a 48.7 reception average. His receiving total for the game also ranks second all-time in Conference USA. The 93-yard reception marked the third longest pass play in Southern Miss history.

Against Marshall, he caught a season-high seven passes for 99 yards and a touchdown.

Explosive Plays

Southern Miss registered plays of at least 20 yards for a total of 109 offensive explosive plays last season. The Golden Eagles had 30 rushing plays of 20 or more yards and 79 passing plays. If you add in kick returns (23), punt returns (two) and interception returns (seven), the number jumped to 142 for the year. Fifteen of the top 19 offensive plays, of which all were at least 47 yards, were touchdowns.

The Golden Eagles have 51 offensive plays of 20-plus yards in 2016, including nine of 65 yards or more of which eight have been for touchdowns. The overall number is 74 with 17 touchdowns (which includes a pair of picks and a punt return).

Working Up Front

Through the first 10 games, Southern Miss has been stable on the offensive line as seven different players have gotten the call up front on offense. Seniors Cameron Tom (C), along with freshman Ty Pollard (RT) have each started every game this season.

The Golden Eagles have gone with the same starting five in each of the last four games with Cameron and Pollard getting starting nods, along with Wil Freeman (LT), Brandon Farmer (LG) and Oliver Bates (RG).

Farmer has nine starts this season, while Freeman has six and Bates has started in each of the last five games, once at left guard and the last four at right guard.

That group totals 137 starts combined.

Tom leads the offensive line with 45 consecutive starts. Redshirt freshmen Ty Pollard, the son of assistant coach and former Golden Eagle Lytrel Pollard, has started at right tackle in all nine games.

Limiting the Opposition's Yards

The Golden Eagles have outgained their foes in nine of 10 games this season. They recorded this feat in its first six games, before LSU held them to its fewest total yards since the Alabama game in 2014 with 242. The previous week, despite losing 55-32 at UTSA, the Golden Eagles outgained the home squad, 557-532. The Golden Eagles also tallied a school-record 702 yards against Rice. Southern Miss' defense is limiting the opposition to 333.9 yards per game which ranks No. 18 in the FBS in total defense and first in Conference USA.

Bradley Anchors Defensive Line

Dylan Bradley ranks second on the team in tackles through 10 games this season with 56. He registered 3.5 sacks against Rice, which ranks as the second most in a game by a Golden Eagle and the most since Jamie Collins tallied three against UAB in 2012. Bradley holds team bests of 14.0 TFLs and 7.0 sacks for 50 yards this season. He opened the season with a game-high seven tackles of which one was for a sack, to go along with two tackles for loss, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery at Kentucky. Bradley registered 45 tackles a year ago, of which 12.5 were for loss, which was second on the team, to go along with a team-best 6.5 sacks. Bradley played in all 14 games, including 12 starts for the program in 2015.

Parker Headlining Linebackers

Senior Elijah Parker is in his final season with the program after tallying 47 stops (30 solos) in 2015. He notched 7.5 tackles for loss for 35 yards while registering a sack to go along with three forced fumbles and a blocked field goal attempt late in the Nebraska game. He ranked second on the team in forced fumbles. He has opened 2016 with 37 tackles, including 6.0 for loss and 2.5 sacks. Parker tallied a career-best seven tackles at LSU and versus Marshall.

Leading Tackler Back

Senior D'Nerius Antoine led the squad in tackles in his first season with the program a year ago. Antoine had 103 stops, which included 7.5 tackles for loss, 1.5 sacks, five pass breakups, two interceptions, four forced fumbles and one fumble recovery. Against Nebraska, Antoine tallied his first interception of the year, while adding a force and recovery of a fumble on his way to a team-high eight tackles against the Huskers.

Antoine leads the team again this in tackles with 66, to go along with 2.0 tackles for loss and five pass breakups. He notched a career-high 12 tackles against Charlotte earlier this month.

Thigpen Holds Solid First Year as Starter

Junior defensive lineman Xavier Thigpen enjoyed a stellar first start at UK by blocking a punt on the game's first possession, while also registering a forced fumble and a fumble recovery in the contest. In 10 games now as a starter, he has 24 tackles, including 9.5 for loss. Four of those TFLs came against Troy for a total of 23 yards lost. He notched the most TFLs in a game since Jamie Collins had that many against UAB on Nov. 3, 2012.

Mikell Snags Two Picks; Breaks School Record in Process

Junior back Curtis Mikell tallied his first two career interceptions at UTEP, becoming the first Golden Eagle to pick off two passes in the same game since Marquese Wheaton did it against SMU on Oct. 22, 2011. His second pick was returned for 100 yards and a touchdown, tying the school record for longest interception return (Kendrick Presley vs. Memphis, 11/26/11). He followed that outing with a career-high tying eight solo tackles against Rice.

Mikell collected his first career start at ODU.

Shaunfield Kicking Them Straight for Field Goals

Redshirt sophomore Parker Shaunfield made his first 12 field goal attempts to start the season, before missing a 41-yard attempt in the third quarter against Marshall. He continued his streak of extra point makes to 36-straight this season and 58 consecutive overall for his career. His 12 field goal made streak was the longest since Danny Hrapmann had 17-straight makes stretching from 2009 through 2010. He missed last week's contest with an injury.

Sarrazin Leading the Golden Eagle Punting Game

Senior Tyler Sarrazin holds down the punting chores for the fourth consecutive campaign in 2016. He has posted a career average of 40.5 yards per boot for 197 punts during his career. He also has accomplished himself as a passer as well, hitting 2-of-4 career passing on special teams with one touchdown throw to Xavier Thigpen last fall at Rice. He has also rushed for a touchdown during his career.

Game Recaps

Game 9: Charlotte 38, at Southern Miss 27 (Nov. 5, 2016)

HATTIESBURG, Miss. - A week after a dominating defensive performance, Southern Miss saw Charlotte rush for more than 300 yards on its way to defeating the Golden Eagles 38-27 before 28,347.

Not only did the Golden Eagles lose for the third time in four games, but they saw both of their top two quarterbacks, sent wobbling to the sideline.

Southern Miss lost starting quarterback Nick Mullens in the third quarter and back-up Parker Adamson on its final offensive possession as the Golden Eagles lost for the third time in its last four games and for the second time in four home games.

Mullens and Adamson combined to throw for 404 yards and two touchdowns, as USM outgained Charlotte 498 total yards to 439 yards.

But Charlotte picked off Mullens twice and intercepted emergency quarterback Tez Parks a play after Adamson was helped to the sidelines with two minutes left to play.

The 49ers also blocked a punt and recovered it for a touchdown to take a 38-14 late in the third quarter.

For the fourth time in their last five games, the Golden Eagles failed to come up with a turnover. Southern Miss has just one takeaway over that stretch, an interception against LSU.

Neither Mullens nor Adamson were on the field at game's end due to injury.

Charlotte running back Kalif Phillips, who had come into the game averaging 79.7 yards a game, punished the Golden Eagles for 183 yards on 29 carries, including a 72-yard ramble on Charlotte's first offensive snap of the game that set up the 49ers' first score.

Phillips' backup, Robert Washington, added 94 yards on just six carries, including a 58-yard touchdown burst. All told, the 49ers ran for 303 yards just a week after the Golden Eagles had limited Marshall to just 60 yards rushing on the same field.

Charlotte quarterback Hasaan Klugh, who completed 11 of 24 passes for 127 yards and a touchdown, also ran for a touchdown for a sixth consecutive game, a 7-yard scamper around left end to give the 49ers a 7-0 lead.

Mullens, who completed 19 of 25 passes for 249 yards, threw a 3-yard touchdown pass to Corey Robertson and an 83-yard scoring pass to Chase Whitehead to give Southern Miss a 14-7 lead after one quarter.

Washington broke free up the middle on his long run to tie the game 92 seconds into the second quarter, and the 49ers took the lead for good with a pair of touchdowns just 71 seconds apart right before halftime.

Game 10: at Old Dominion 51, Southern Miss 35 (Nov. 12, 2016)

NORFOLK, Va. - Three turnovers on the first three possessions of the game put Southern Miss in a 21-0 hole Saturday afternoon at Ballard Stadium, and the Golden Eagles could not recover in dropping a 51-35 loss to Old Dominion.

True freshman Keon Howard started for the first time in his Southern Miss career, stepping in for injured starter Nick Mullens and backup Parker Adamson. He is just the sixth-ever Golden Eagle true freshman to start at the position.

Howard showed glimpses, passing for 230 yards and a touchdown, while rushing for 98 yards and a score. But he also lost four fumbles, was intercepted once and was tackled in the end zone for a safety.

For the fifth time in six games, the Golden Eagles did not record a takeaway.

Ito Smith rushed for 97 yards and a season-high three touchdowns. Smith, who has scored at least once in 15 consecutive games, has run for 1,081 yards through 10 games, giving him consecutive, 1,000-yard rushing seasons.

Turnovers doomed the Golden Eagles, with the giveaways continually setting up ODU's offense on short fields.

Howard fumbled on the first two possessions, and the Monarchs capitalized on both, with running back Ray Lawry capping both drives with 2-yard runs to put ODU up 14-0.

After Howard was intercepted when his pass went through the hands of receiver Isaiah Jones, the Monarchs turned the gift into a 3-yard scoring run by Jeremy Cox for a 21-0 lead after a quarter.

Howard sparked the Golden Eagles' first scoring drive with his legs, capping it with a 2-yard run, to pull Southern Miss within 28-7.

But ODU quarterback David Washington ended the half with touchdown tosses of 5 yards to Jonathan Duhart and 39 yards to Travis Fulgham to put the Monarchs ahead 35-7 at halftime.

Cox ripped off a 67-yard scoring run early in the third quarter, but Southern Miss fought back, scoring on short runs by Smith on three, consecutive possession to pull within 42-28 with 10 minutes to play.

But Howard was caught in the end zone for safety, and then fumbled away Southern Miss' next possession at his own 7-yard line, where Rashaad Coward picked up the loose ball and returned it for a touchdown.
