

CROSS COUNTRY INVITATIONAL

The cross country meet location has been changed from the Vann Hook Golf Course to Tatum Park ... Tatum Park is located on Parkway Blvd just off Veterans Memorial Blvd (Hwy 11) ... If traveling from South (heading north) on I-59, take Exit 60 (South Hattiesburg Exit), exit right and stay right, travel approximately two miles (give or take), pass the Family Y (which is on the right), take the next right (Parkway Blvd) ... Follow the road thru the gates, pass the Fire Station, softball fields, tennis courts and proceed toward the end ... Pavilion is located on right

If traveling from the North (heading south) on I-59, take Exit 60 (South Hattiesburg), exit right and proceed left at stop sign (if you go right you are headed to Purvis) ... Follow same directions as above.

If traveling from Jackson (Hwy 49 South), take I-59 South towards New Orleans ... take Exit 60 (South Hattiesburg), exit right and proceed left (if you go right you are headed to Purvis) ... Follow same directions as above.

If traveling from the Gulf Coast on Hwy 49 North, travel past 98 By-Pass until the second traffic light (W SF Tatum Drive), turn left, go to next light turn left onto Veterans Memorial Blvd (Hwy 11) then take the left onto (Parkway Blvd which is located directly across from Southern Bone and Joint, if you pass that you have gone to far ... Follow the road thru the gates, pass the Fire Station, softball fields, tennis courts and proceed toward the end ... Pavilion is located on right

- ENTRIES** Entries need to be faxed to (601) 266-6595 by Friday, August 31 at 5 p.m. Please do not fax or phone in changes to the roster after the entry deadline. These changes can be made at the meet.
- Entry fees are as follows:
\$75 per University team (\$150 both men and women)
\$50 per High School Team (\$100 both boys and girls)
\$10 University unattached
\$5 High School unattached
\$15 OPEN Men and Women
- Please note there will be a maximum of 12 runners per team. You may add “B”, “C”, etc. teams for an additional team entry fee.
- Checks can be made payable to The University of Southern Mississippi.
- DIRECTIONS** Take I59 North or South and exit on HWY 11 South Hattiesburg (Exit 60). If headed North, exit right and continue right, turns into Veterans Memorial Blvd, go past Family Y located on right, take the next right (Parkway Blvd), continue thru gates and go all the way to end, pavilion is on the right. If headed South, take exit 60, exit right, at end of exit go left and followed directions above. If coming from Coast, travel past the 98 by-pass North until the second light (W SF Tatum Drive), turn left, proceed to next light and turn left onto Veterans Memorial Blvd, take the next left on to Parkway Blvd (across from Southern Bone & Joint), proceed thru gates, go all way to end, pavilion on the right.
