Meet Coach Sutherland



Two-time regional Coach of the Year and four-time conference Coach of the Year Jeanne Sutherland was named head coach of the SMU women's golf team in the spring of 2011. Sutherland, who had spent 15 years at the helm of the Texas A&M women's golf program, had spent the three previous years as head professional at Vail (Colo.) Golf Club.

At A&M, Sutherland transformed the Aggie program into one of the nation's elite, becoming a mainstay in the top 25 national rankings and reaching postseason play in 13 of her 15 years as head coach. Prior to Sutherland's arrival at A&M, the Aggies had not won a tournament in seven years, but once she took the reins, the Aggies captured 13 tournament crowns and three Big 12 Conference titles.

A native of Dubuque, Iowa, Sutherland played college golf at the University of Northern Iowa, where she earned All-America honors as a sophomore after placing third at the AIAW Division II National Championships and leading the team to a third-place finish. In 1983, she placed 13th at nationals and paced the team to a fifth-place performance.

Remembering Earl Stewart, Jr.

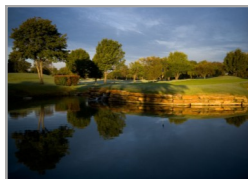
The great tradition of SMU Women's golf originated with Earl Stewart, Jr. In 1975, Coach Stewart started the Women's Golf program and coached until his retirement in 1986. He produced an AIAW National Championship Team, two National Champions in Kyle O'Brien-Stevens and Amy Benz, and six All-Americans. He also coached the successful men's team, counting the late Payne Stewart '79, as one of his top players.



Coach Stewart was born and raised in Dallas and became a nationally renowned golf competitor, teacher and coach. As an amateur, he won the 1946 Texas PGA Championship and three other PGA Tour tournaments. As a part-time tour event player, he edged Arnold Palmer to win the Dallas Open- forerunner to the Byron Nelson Classic. Coach Stewart also became the only host professional to have won a PGA Tour tournament on his home course.

The Earl Stewart Lady Mustang and Reunion Invitational is held every year in memory of the gentleman who put SMU Women's Golf on the national map.

About the Course



The renowned Dallas Athletic Club is home to the SMU women's and men's golf teams.

The Jack Nicklaus Gold Course stretches over 7,000 yards and plays to a par 72, with 419 Bermuda fairways and Bentgrass greens. Natural features, including eight lakes and many mature trees, are combined with modern design techniques to provide golfers with views of the newly designed SMU golf facilities, a variety of scenes and interesting golf shots. Gold Course popular attractions include the stone bridge on Nos. 10 and 11. The Gold Course notable tournaments include the 1997 USGA Mid-Amateur Championship, 1998 AJGA Boys Championship, and the 2002 TSWGA Championship.
